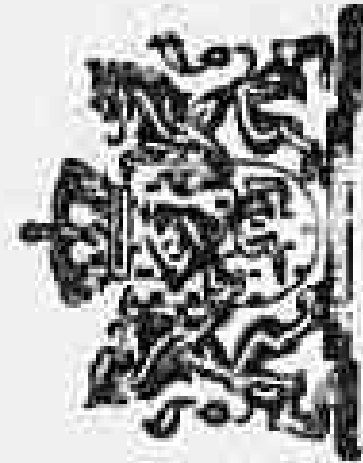

The Royal Netherlands Mission to the Displaced Persons Subcommission, Allied Control Commission, Central Mediterranean Force, has been charged by the Netherlands Government in London to arrange for the protection and maintenance of Netherlands nationals in Italy. It is expected that some fifty Netherlands subjects will be found living in Rome, when that city is occupied by the Allied Forces. Mr. D. G. E. Middelburg, Netherlands Consul-General, head of the said Mission, intends to proceed to Rome as soon as possible, in order to make arrangements for the care of the Netherlands community.
2. For the event that some time elapses between the occupation and Mr. Middelburg's arrival, it is requested that the appropriate Allied Military Government Officer would establish contact with the Netherlands emergency committee in Rome, the so called Juliana Fund, discuss with them the needs of the Netherlands community and make the necessary arrangements to provide them with cash and rations.

It would be greatly appreciated, if the Finance Officer, Rome, would make advances of AM-lire to the said committee, sufficient for the needs of the Netherlands community at the above rates; these advances to

5. The Royal Netherlands Mission further expresses the hope that to Netherlands civilians in Rome the same food rations will be made available as to American and British civilians.-
