6. (a) The main criticism of FERRACORTE has been its location in a valley drainage area and that its residents are subjected to deep wet winters and malaria. Although there has been a high rate of malaria, it is not of a malignant type and no fatalities have occurred since it is here.
- (b) The camp was constructed to quarter internees in family as well as single units in partitioned huts and bachelor type of barracks of plaster and cement construction, and it is equipped to meet the living requirements of the ex-internees. It is located in the center of an agricultural area where food is readily purchased from local farmers, and fuel is available for heating and cooking purposes at a relatively low cost. The present location makes it practicable for the camp to be operated on a different basis than other refugee camps. Resident ex-internees receive a daily cash payment from the Italian provincial authorities, in addition, they receive an allowance of basic food of flour, pasta, rice and olive oil in the amount of 50% of their daily requirements. They are expected to purchase the remaining 50% of food requirements, as well as other necessities, from their cash payment.
5. Further effort will be made to locate an appropriate static camp which can meet the capacity requirements for families and single persons and correct the deficiencies of the present system of camp operation now in effect at FERRACORTE.

Reference is made to our 5348 of 25 November, and to our

1. As notified by the War Office in their 55418 SD2 of 5 January (not to you) agreement had been reached with the Polish Government whereby all Polish P.W., escapees, and displaced persons of military age and capable of military service then held in this Theatre were to be evacuated to the U.K., and that all Poles of the same categories subsequently available should be retained in the Theatre as reinforcements for the Polish forces.

2. The attached copy of an amendment to ACFM Adm Instruction No: 30 gives effect to these decisions, and amends also our cable and memorandum quoted above in respect of Polish nationals who are displaced persons of military age and capable of military service. ACFM Adm Instruction is not held in AFHQ and we are unable, therefore, to know whether it, or this amendment, has been received in your Headquarters.

1. In view of the probable early arrival of 7 Polish Rft Div in ITALY, Polish PW and Escapees recommended as suitable for eventual employment with the Polish Army, will not be evacuated.
2. They will be retained, segregated from other Axis PW, in PW Camps where they are at present being held.
3. Where suitable arrangements cannot be made in forward camps for retention in complete segregation, evacuation will be arranged to 368 PW Camp.

For the purpose of this mission, it is agreed to be able to send mission for displaced persons Sub-Commission within a few weeks: 2 weeks. Your mission decision is to disposal. 3 weeks. Instructions being obtained. This notify you when received.

2. Nationals, Hungarians, Bulgarians, Austrians, and stateless persons will be retained.

It is to be clearly understood that no displaced persons of any category whatsoever will be moved for repatriation to North Africa, nor to any other country or theatre, except in accordance with following procedure:

- Displaced persons first to have been screened.
- After screening full personal details of personnel on forms as notified in our 7513 of 6 November will be forwarded to this Headquarters for approval by G-2 (SI). After examination personnel will be returned to you as in (c).
- Approval or refusal for movement of specific personnel will be notified to you.
- After receipt approval you will arrange movement, making necessary arrangements for care or custody of personnel during transit, and notifying this Headquarters in advance of port or policy in regard to disposal displaced persons.

The following directions will be read as operating only after screening of individuals all nationalities, and after their receipt by Sub-Commission:

- FRENCH. Evacuate in accordance with existing instructions in consultation with accredited French Mission.
- YUGOSLAV. New Policy will be notified shortly. Venetian retain and keep busy, taking steps to segregate conflicting elements to avoid strife. (Our 7513 of 6 November refers)
- CZECH. Retain pending arrival of Mission from Czech Government to be attached to the Displaced Persons Sub-Commission. (Our 7513 of 6 November also refers)

SUBJECT: Liaison Officer - Internees & Displaced Persons Sub-Commission.

TO : Military Government Section, A.F.M.S.

1. I would refer to your Signal 57635 of 28 Feb 44 and to my reply Station 1554 of 3 March 44, and regret that I have to report unfavorably on the activities of Major P. B. Webb, MRSRA, who has interfered with the work of the Internees & Displaced Persons Sub-Commission, and has conducted himself in a manner not in accordance with that of Liaison Officers.
2. At the outset he failed to call at the H.Q. of the Sub-Commission. He did not make his status known, nor did he present his credentials. As to the manner of interpreting messages I would quote that he interpreted a message from MIDWEST which stated that only those Jews with valid Palestine Immigration Certificates were ordered to embark to EGYPT, as confirming his statement that only Yugoslav Partisan refugees may be sent to EGYPT. As a matter of fact, he had stated in his letter to the Officer Commanding of a Sub-Section of the Sub-Commission that any Jews who had arrived in Italy as Partisan refugees would be received without question by his Administration in the MIDWEST. He was unable to, or failed to present or obtain, any official instructions that substantiated his interpretation as to what Jews would be acceptable to MIDWEST.
3. Furthermore, Major Webb visited No.2 District H.Q., who have no responsibility for the embarkation of Yugoslavs, and made an effort that No.2 District H.Q. should order the Sub-Commission not to send certain Yugoslav refugees to MIDWEST. He visited Jews in a Camp operated by the Sub-Commission without the prior knowledge and consent of the Director of the Sub-Commission, and according to a Jewish Chaplain, the result of his talk during his visit was such that the Jews of the Camp became very excited and perturbed to no purpose.
4. I submit that Major Webb has been of no assistance to the Sub-Commission. He has made a task which is already difficult considerably more so. I would recommend that if MIDWEST desires to have a Liaison Officer with this Sub-Commission that an Officer be sent who will conform to the accepted practice regarding Liaison Officers and who will, in matters affecting the embarkation of refugees, deal with the Director of the Internees & Displaced Persons Sub-Commission, rather than with Headquarters of his own choosing.

1. There are in Gravina and Bari Transit Camps some 1360 Yugoslav partisans. These men are for the most part P.O.W., captured by the Italians and released after the armistice.
2. These men are, with the cognizance of 133 Force, being organized as a military unit by the Partisan Delegation. They are in fact, a military formation (the criterion being that they draw Scale 13 Ration, as opposed to Scale 30, drawn by other refugees) and are regarded as such by 133 Force who wish them transferred to one camp at Castro where they can be properly supervised.
3. 133 Force, are ready to take over the supervision of these men, but cannot at present provide a camp Staff and has asked the Sub-Commission for Displaced Persons to do so.
4. As a temporary measure Colonel Kirkwood can find the Staff for this Partisan camp at Castro, but I must point out that it is not the duty of the Displaced Persons Sub-Commission to maintain military formations and I must ask that the Displaced Persons Sub-Commission be relieved of their duty by March 15, when the Staff will be required elsewhere.

I discussed today with Mr. Malin the general Refugee situation in Italy, and in one respect the policy and activities of the ICR have an important bearing upon military operations here. But the difficulty of finding asylum or dispersal areas for these Italian refugees is growing, and many provinces have already reached saturation point. However, the campaign in Italy still has a long way to go, and every means must be explored for the handling in future of more refugees, and for preparing in advance to disperse whatever numbers operations may make it necessary to move.

Every Yugo - Slav, or Jew or Czech, Austrian, Polish, etc. nationality - mentioned in Mr. Kalin's letter - that can be removed from Southern Italy, means so much more space for Italian Refugees from the battle zones. If the former are not evacuated from Italy, we shall very soon have to think of shipping Italians from the mainland, and this will mean shipping them back again at a later date. The other nationals, will, on the other hand, sooner or later be shipped out of Italy in any case.

In view of the above, I believe that AWH and the other authorities mentioned in Mr. Kalin's letter should be urged at once to get the evacuation of nationals in question pushed ahead with, within the shortest possible time.

Under the terms of this Headquarters letter G1/B/2206/42 of 9 February, as confirmed by "Minutes of Meeting held at Allied Force Headquarters on 7 February, Re-organisation of PW Sub-Commission", surplus personnel of PW Sub-Commission are to be attached to the Displaced Persons Sub-Commission. (Copies of both the foregoing communications were forwarded to your Headquarters).

By comparison of the War Establishment of the late PW Sub-Commission with that of the proposed WE of the Allied Ex-PW Adm Unit it is disclosed that 12 MGS will be available for attachment to the Displaced Persons Sub-Commission. The following table is given in support of this calculation:

who were in compulsory residence in Italy prior to the Allied occupation, and, in conjunction with the Refugee Branch of the AMO and R Section, to Italian refugees from the combat zones. It is requested, therefore, that you will compute your present commitments in detail and report whether, by employing the services of these 12 additional MGS, and such Allied civilian or Italian personnel as may be available, you will be able to undertake full responsibility for the treatment of the sick of all categories mentioned above.

In this connection it is necessary to draw attention to a directive from the War Office (cable 91732 AMO/IO of 23 November - not to you) in which it is stated that, (a) RAMC officers can only be spared for Civil Affairs (i.e. AMO or AGO) at the expense of military medical requirements, and, (b) that RAMC officers may not be posted to Civil Affairs without reference to the War Office. It may be that you will decide that 12 additional MGS will not be sufficient if you are to undertake full responsibility, but in any case, before any more RAMC can be posted to AGO, the matter will first have to be referred to the War Office. If, in your opinion, it would be impracticable for you to assume full responsibility you should indicate other plans whereby persons of all categories aforementioned may receive medical treatment.

3. Other factors which should receive consideration in your report are the questions of medical supplies, and the provision of hospital facilities. The precise nature and extent of medical equipment held by the late PW Sub-Commission is not known, but it is anticipated that certain essential articles and commodities necessary to the operation of hospitals may not be available to AGO. Similarly, you should indicate whether it will be possible to obtain hospital accommodation (or tentage), and adequate trained hospital staff, from local resources. Upon receipt of your report the matter will be taken up with the appropriate authorities at this Headquarters.

1. Owing to the Displaced Persons Sub-commission having been up to now non-effective, responsibility for the treatment of sick and wounded refugees has devolved largely on D.D.M.S. 2 District.
2. Responsibility has been accepted as a temporary measure and in the absence of any other possible arrangement, for the treatment of Partisan sick and wounded. Refugees, as non-combatant personnel, fall into quite a different category. It is essential that A.C.C. assume control as soon as possible.
3. It is understood that as a result of the disbandment of the P. Sub-commission, medical personnel will be available which it is proposed to absorb into the Displaced Persons Sub-commission. It is recommended that immediate steps be taken to ensure that the latter organisation is in a position to take over full responsibility. Requests have been received from D.D.M.S. A.F.H.C. Adv. Admin. Echelon for medical personnel to be released for this purpose. These are not available from purely military resources.
4. The question of medical supplies for refugees requires immediate consideration. This should be a purely A.C.C. commitment. Emergency issues are being made by D.D.M.S. 2 District from Military resources.

I am at A.F.H.Q. for the next few days working on the reorganisation of the P.W.S.C and the transfer of men, transport & accommodation to D.P.S.C.

All concerned agree in principle; the temporary loan of all surplus has been authorised and is now being implemented by Cols. Robinson and Kirkwood. The only difference from your plan is that all ex P.W. matters will be dealt with by A.C.M.F through normal military channels (and a small ex P.W. section) and not by A.C.C.

I enclose a copy of my memo (WP 22 of 2 Feb) to the D.A.G. here so that you can see the lines on which we are working.

I hope to be released and return to BARI in a few days, unless another job has been found for me in the meantime; and shall then be free to give Kirkwood all the help I can.

1. It is asserted that, until the cessation or capitulation of Germany, the number of Allied prisoners of war who will escape or be returned to our lines in this theatre is not likely to exceed the 200 a month.

It is possible that there might be more if the enemy should suddenly evacuate large areas of occupied territory, but these could probably consist of local troops or partisans, who would not have to be evacuated.

The organization proposed below is therefore designed to handle these expected commitments now and to be capable of a sudden and considerable expansion, if needed.

2. In principle it is proposed that the examination reception and interrogation of captured prisoners of war should be the responsibility of the Army (or Corps), concerned who should pass them as expeditiously as possible to a small GPO (Army) organization (see para 5) responsible for their collection, welfare, equipment, documentation, detailed interrogation, medical examination and repatriation. However possible, normal service channels and installations of the district concerned should be used.

3. The expressions of war (X_{10}) organization (referred to in the present context as:

- (a) Site No. Location near the end of station and main personnel port (at present area is used as a parking area near No. 10).

Strength: 1 Major 2 2ptains 3 400 2 curru.

- (b) And Data: location near each probably with a list of names of persons which might be employed. Detailed list of names (or with some) are attached with or without any detailed explanation.

Strength: 1 Captain 2 CPO 1 CPO.

(a) GRC Sec. Location near 24 and 26 and main personnel port (at present area NAGINA - 200000 near NAGINA).

Strength: 1 Major 2 Captains 5 GRC 2 cars.

(b) Field Det. Location near each reg (or with Corps) HQ, probably with adv rif sec near GRC or with any detailed force which might be employed.

Strength: 1 Captain 2 GRC 1 car.

(c) Reception Camp. Location near GRC Sec and main personnel port (present site at NAGINA near NAGINA is suitable).

Strength: 1 Lt. Col. 1 Major 2 Captains 48 GRC plus 4 Medical 2 Intelligence Officers, 5 vehicles.
(Additional Officer representatives from AN, IAF, Dominions, Allied etc, Governments, etc etc, may be attached if needed.)

(d) Imprisonment Camp. Location at subsidiary personnel ports to M.B. (at present one only at TAWANTO for evacuation).

Strength: 1 Officer 6 GRC 1 car.

4. The above organization would also act as a cadre for any necessary expansion which might include the allocation to PW work of advanced reinforcement units, reception camps, medical units, or Axis prisoners of war camps as might then become available together with an increase in the PW staff from similar sources. Steps might be taken to make these appointments as soon as possible need for them becomes apparent.
5. Although it is recommended that this organization should be part of normal military headquarters and HQ of the Allied Control Commission or the Military Government Section, it is suggested, if the Displaced Persons Sub Commission of the Allied Control Commission does need very material increases in staff and camp facilities, that personnel, material and accommodation thus rendered surplus to PW Sub Commission requirements should be made available to Allied Control Commission, thus regularizing the temporary arrangements already made.
6. It is suggested that these (or any counter) proposals should be examined at once by reps of the following branches and Services:
