REORGANISATION OF INTERMITTENT AND DISPLACED PERSONS SUB-COMMISSION.

1. Reference Administrative Instruction No 4 of even date.

INFORMATION.

2. U.e.f. 0100 hrs 23 June 44 H.Q. I & D.P.S.C. will be established in ROME.
3. The following branches of I & D.P.S.C. will remain in BARI in present locations until called for.

(g) G-17.

(c) All Allied Missions accredited to I & D.P.S.C.
(c) Records Bureau.

4. O.C. No 1 Sub Section will assume command all camps under control I & D.P.S.C. in Southern Italy and will come under the command of Regional Commissioner, Region II for administration, other than as qualified below.

5. Major Attayer will be appointed I & D.P.S.C. Staff Officer to Region 11.

ORGANISATION.

6. ADMINISTRATION. O.C. No 1 Sub Section will deal direct with Sub-Area Commanders regarding maintenance and subsistence of Camps under command.

O.C. No 1 Sub Section will consult R.C. Region 11 on such matters as cannot be decided by Sub-Area Commanders and O.C. No 1 Sub Section. Region 11 to consult HQ No. 2 District on such matters.

7. FINANCE. Finance Officer, HQ I & D.P.S.C. through Finance Officer, No 1 Sub-Section, will direct policy in regard to all financial matters.

3. The following branches of I & D.P.S.C. will remain in BARI in present locations until called for.

- (a) C-11.
- (b) All Allied Missions accredited to I & D.P.S.C.
- (c) Records Bureau.

4. O.C. No 1 Sub Section will assume command all camps under control I & D.P.S.C. in Southern Italy and will come under the command of Regional Commissioner, Region 11 for administration, other than as qualified below.

5. Major Attayer will be appointed I & D.P.S.C. Staff Officer to Region 11.

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O.C. No 1 Sub Section will consult R.C. Region 11 on such matters as cannot be decided by Sub-Area Commanders and O.C. No 1 Sub Section. Region 11 to consult HQ No. 2 District on such matters.

7. FINANCE. Finance Officer, HQ I & D.P.S.C. through Finance Officer, No 1 Sub-Section, will direct policy in regard to all financial matters.

8. 'A' MATTERS. Records, returns and casualties concerning all Officers and EM/ORs will be dealt with by HQ. I & D.P.S.C. and O.C. No. 1 Sub Section.

C of I and Courts Martial, in the first instance, will be disposed of through local Sub-Area Commanders and completed documents forwarded to HQ I & D.P.S.C. where applicable.

9. 'Q' MATTERS. Maintenance and subsistence of Camps will be dealt with by O.C. No 1 Sub Section through Sub-Area Commanders and if necessary Regional Supply Officers. Rations will continue to be drawn from Army sources on scales at present in force.

TRANSPORT. O.C. No 1 Sub-Section will continue to make demands on Sub-areas for movement of refugees until such time as a separate V.E. of vehicles has been approved for this Sub-Commission by A.F.H.Q.

10. RECEPTION OF REFUGEES.

(a) Arrivals in Port of BARI and No 1 Transit Camp from all sources will be responsibility of O.C. No 1 Transit Camp.

(b) Movement to Holding Camps will be carried out by O.C. No 1 Transit Camp as directed by O.C. No 1 Sub Section.

11. EVACUATIONS. - Yugoslav Refugees and other Nationals to MIDEAST, French North Africa, U.K. etc.

Policy in regard to evacuation from Italy will be directed by HQ I & D.P.S.C. and implemented through I & D.P.S.C. Staff Officer with Region 11.

12. MEDICAL. A.D.H., Lt-Col. Swanson will carry out the duties of ADMS as heretofore, with the exception that the direction of policy will be retained by the ADMS. Reference to ADMS may be made when desired on any subject.

A.D.H. No 1 Sub-Section will co-ordinate the policy as directed by A.D.M.S. HQ I & D.P.S.C. He will be responsible for all medical and hygiene arrangements and services in Camps under command No 1 Sub-Section. He will indent in first instance on A.C.C. sources (advising ADMS of such action) for medical supplies, and cases of non-availability will be referred to ADMS. HQ. I & D.P.S.C.

13. RETURNS. All existing returns called for by HQ. I & D.P.S.C. will be rendered to HQ I & D.P.S.C. and where necessary, copies will be supplied to HQ. Region 11.

14. CLOSING OF CAMPS.
The following Camps in S. Italy will be closed down under instructions HQ. I & D.P.S.C. when opportune, in the following order:-

1. Tutturano. 2. Santa Cesarea. 3. Di Bagni.

3. Ferramonti.

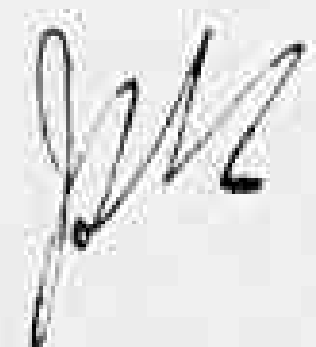

(b). No.1 Sub-Section will come under the command of Regional Commissioner, Region II for administration, other than as qualified below:

IADPSC. Staff Officer - Major Attayer will be appointed to Region II.
No.1 Transit Camp and Terranenti ex-Internee Camp come under command No.1 Sub-Section.

ADMINISTRATION.

1. O.C. No.1 Sub-Section will deal direct with Sub-Area Commanders regarding maintenance and subsistence of Camps under command.

2. O.C. No.1 Sub-Section will consult R.C. Region II on such matters as cannot be decided by Sub-Area Commanders and O.C. No.1 Sub-Section. Region II to consult HQ No.2 District on such matters.

3. FINANCE.
Finance Officer, HQ IADPSC through Finance Officer, No.1 Sub-Section, will direct policy in regard to all financial matters.

4. M.I. Matters.
Records, returns and casualties concerning all Officers and EM/ORs will be dealt with by HQ IADPSC and O.C. No.1 Sub-Section. C of I and Courts Martial, in the first instance, will be disposed of through local Sub-Area Commanders and completed documents forwarded to HQ IADPSC where applicable.

5. M.I. Matters.
Maintenance and subsistence of Camps will be dealt with by O.C. No.1 Sub-Section through Sub-Area Commanders and if necessary Regional Supply Officers. Rations will continue to be drawn from Army sources on scales at present in force.

TRANSPORT. O.C. No.1 Sub-Section will continue to make demands on Sub-Areas for movement of refugees until such time as a separate W.E. of vehicles has been approved for this Sub-Commission by A.F.H.Q.

6. RECEPTION OF REFUGEES.

(a). Arrivals in Port of Bari and No.1 Transit Camp from all sources will be responsibility of O.C. No.1 Transit Camp.

(b). Movement to Holding Camps will be carried out by O.C. No.1 Transit Camp as directed by O.C. No.1 Sub-Section.

7. EVACUATIONS. - Yugoslav Refugees and other Nationals to MIDWEST, French North Africa, U.K. etc.

Policy in regard to evacuation from Italy will be directed by HQ. IADPSC and implemented through IADPSC Staff Officer with Region II.

8. MEDICAL.

D.A.D.H. No.1 Sub-Section will co-ordinate the policy as directed by A.D.M.S. HQ I&DPSC. He will be responsible for all medical and hygiene arrangements and services in Camps under command No.1 Sub-Section. He will indent in first instance on A.O.C. sources (advising ADMS of such action) for medical supplies, and cases of non-availability will be referred to ADMS. HQ. I&DPSC.

9. RETURNS.

All existing returns called for by HQ. I&DPSC will be rendered to HQ. I&DPSC and where necessary, copies will be supplied to HQ. Region 11.

10. CLOSING OF CAMPS.

The following camps in S. Italy will be closed down under instructions HQ. I&DPSC when opportune, in the following order:-

1. Tutturano. 2. Santa Cesarea. 3. Di Bagni.

The following camps and Hospitals will be retained by

HQ. I&DPSC:-

1. Leuca and Leuca Hospital.
2. Maglie Hospital.
3. Ferramonti.
4. Taranto.
5. No.1 Transit Camp.
6. Arnesano.

11. ORDNANCE DEPOT and D.I.D. MAGLIE.

The above depots will continue to be used by O.C. No.1 Sub-Section until such time as the camps in para.10 are closed. If necessary the depots will be taken over, subject to agreement with HQ. No.2 District, should HQ. No.2 District withdraw the staff from these depots.

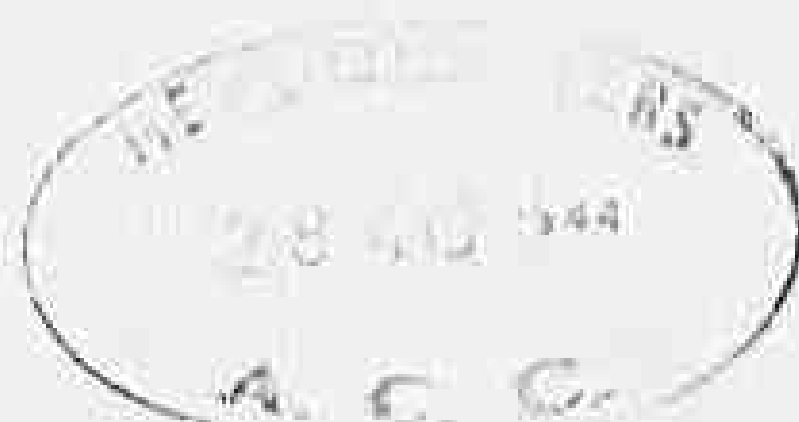

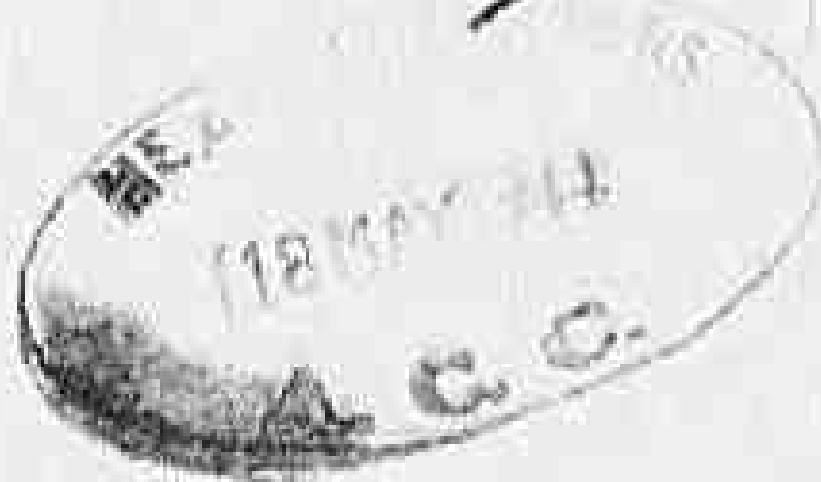

1. I beg to revert to para. 2 of the above letter.
2. There have been some 15 people in here during the last 48 hours among them Spaniard, French, Yugo-slav Officers with their wives.
3. We can as agreed give these people shelter and food but I think it is your view that our refugee camps are not suitable places to put for instance Yugo-slav Officers, some of them fairly senior and their wives.
4. I suggest as a solution that a house be taken and run as a transit hotel for these people, it would be manned by an Italian staff, this Branch could supervise it.
5. We urgently require an answer to the questions in para. 2 of our previous letter.

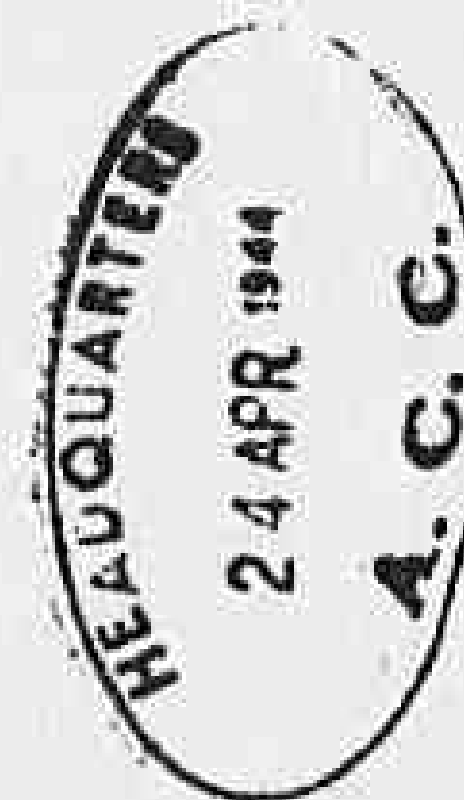

SUBJECT: Responsibility for Displaced persons living in communes.

TO: Deputy Chief Commissioner.

1 It is suggested that paragraph 6 of 100/572/10 of 17 Mar (copy attached), is a misunderstanding of the true position.

2 It is true that displaced persons residing independently in communes are cared for by Regions. The regional officer is quite as capable of acting as agent for the displaced persons sub Commission as for any other sub Commission and the mere fact that he is acting does nothing whatever to shift the responsibility from the sub Commission to which it has been allotted to another or to the Public Health sub Comm in particular.

3 It is admitted

a that in the absence of any instructions to the contrary responsibility for displaced persons remains in the Displaced persons sub Commission to whom it has been entrusted and is not affected by details as to how such assistance is given

b that no instruction shifting the responsibility should be given as

i assistance given to Italian Nationals (for which the Public Health sub Comm is responsible, is chargeable to the Italian Government while that given to displaced persons is not. Therefore there should be separate accounting both as to assistance in kind and cash allowances.

ii that the policy as to displaced persons including assistance in kind and allowances should apply universally wherever such displaced persons may reside. The determination of such policy is the function of the Displaced persons sub Comm. To allow the Public Health sub Comm to make independent decisions will introduce confusion as to the allowances admissible, complicate accounting, and other procedure and be a source of discontent if these two scales of assistance should differ.

Reference your letter ACC/3092/TH dated 12 March '44, the following information, as requested, is forwarded.

1. Class of People Dealt With

These can be divided into two classes.

(a) Ex-Internees

These are Jews interned originally by Italian Government now living in a community such as FERRAMONTI, purchasing part of their foodstuffs and free to move about in the locality of the camp.

(b) Refugees

These are refugees of all nationalities with the exception of ITALIANS which are received in this Sub-Commission's Transit Camps. After screening and disinfection, they are sent to holding camps where they await shipment overseas.

Certain Refugees are stateless and these remain in ITALY. Yugoslav refugees from BALKANIA have been the major concern of this Sub-Commission.

2. Housing

Refugees accommodated in huddled camps or village communities in houses.

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Certain Refugees are stateless and these remain in ITALY. Yugoslav refugees from Ljubljana have been the major concern of this Sub-Commission.

2. Housing

Refugees accommodated in hutter camps or village communities in houses.

3. Feeding

Ex-Internees receive food in kind up to 50% of their requirements: flour, pasta, rice, olive oil and purchase their other food and necessities with subsistence allowance paid to them through Italian provincial offices; (15 lire per day for adults and 10 lire per day for children). Ref-388
Refugees are issued with rations drawn from Army Sources. This is either at a communal kitchen or by household groups according to cooking facilities. Certain additional items of food may be drawn for invalids and children. Red Cross are also helping by supplementing the ration for children and special cases.

4. Clothing

This is supplied by Red Cross and also through A.C.C.

5. Medical

Two hospitals are maintained by this Sub-Commission and Refugee Camps have medical organization for dealing with the sick. Medical stores in the past have been received from Army Sources. One fifth of a unit being sent by your Dept. to this Sub-Commission.

6. Displaced Persons Living or Finally Established in Communes.

These are not the responsibility of this Sub-Commission and such Displaced Persons are dealt with by Regions.

MEMORANDUM TO COL. E. H. FOXE, Jr.

It would be extremely helpful if we could obtain promptly from the appropriate military authorities information with respect to non-Italian refugees in that part of Italy under the control of Allied Forces. In particular we should like to ascertain, among other things:

- (1) Number of non-Italian refugees living in camps in Bari or elsewhere;
- (2) Adequacy of camp facilities for present occupants and possibility of receiving others;
- (3) Number of such refugees outside of camps with indication of arrangement under which they are living.

We have information indicating that the British military authorities are presently evacuating refugees from Italy to camps in Egypt. Reports indicate that this is a fairly large scale movement. It would be extremely helpful to have more details of this operation including an indication of whether refugees are being taken from existing camps in Italy, the program contemplated and the basis upon which it is being carried out. We would also like to have any suggestions as to how the Board could be of assistance in any of these matters.
