MEMORANDUM TO: Vice President, Administrative Section,
Vice President, Economic Section.

1. Request that you instruct Directors of Sub-commissions to refrain from informing Regions that transfers of their specialist personnel "have been arranged." Several recent incidents have occurred in which the Directors of Sub-commissions have so informed Regions and the transfers were impossible for reasons unknown to the Sub-commission. Since demands for personnel are received from many sources both from inside and outside ACO, it is impossible to keep Directors informed of all contemplated plans for the use of all personnel. In many cases, these plans are changed for good reason within the day or hour. Further the internal organization of forward Regions, such as IV and V are many times unknown to Directors and disruption of Provincial teams is quite likely to be caused without intending it. To give notice of changes which later can not be made or without consultation with any HQ which may be involved, gives rise to confusion and irritation.

2. Consultation with ROs and SGACs reference their personnel problems is within the province of Directors and is to be encouraged. Possible transfers may be discussed but no promises should be made in reference thereto.

3. All requests for transfers, attachments or temporary duty of specialist officers should be processed through the Establishment Officer, of the Executive Officer (B) who is responsible for all personnel placements (not directly to G-1). In all cases of disagreement between ROs and Directors of Sub-commissions as to the assignment or relief of a specialist officer, the situation will be presented to the Establishment Officer for decision. Co-operation of Directors will be very much appreciated.

SUBJECT: Review of Civilian Internees.

TO: Brigadier W. Lush, Executive Commissioner.

1. 371 P.O.W. Camp has been established at PADULA, Province of Salerno, to receive all Civilian Internees in Italy, since it has now been decided that the housing and administration of such persons is an Army and not A.C.C./A.W.G. responsibility.

2. At a discussion which took place between Brigadier Lush, Lt. Col. Gibson, G.S.O.1 (Ib), A.C.W.F. and myself, it has been decided to assist A.C.W.F. H.Q. with their task of review of all internees at Padula.

3. On the 21st. February, 1944, I went to P.O.W. Camp 371 with Lt. Col. Gibson and discussed with him and the Commandant of the Camp, Major Marshall, how the review could be effected.

4. It was agreed that I should attached two Officers to this Camp for the purpose of reviewing the circumstances relating to each internee and to recommend to the Commandant either continued internment or release.

5. In some cases, the responsibility for release will be taken by the Camp Commandant, in others, he will refer for decision or confirmation to H.Q. A.C.W.F. In all cases with which A.C.C. or A.W.G. have been concerned, my Officers will advise or consult me with regard to the action to be taken.

6. At present there are between 200 and 300 internees at this Camp, but it is expected that the total figure will eventually exceed 2,000. Since the influx will continue at least as long as the duration of military operations in Italy, it is anticipated that the responsibilities of such a review will be of indefinite duration.

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7. Owing to small numbers of Officers on my staff, I am unable to provide personnel from my own resources. I recommend, therefore, that the following Officers, both of whom are now in Region 1, be transferred to this Branch, so that I may assign them to this responsibility. Both are experienced London Police Officers and, in my view, have the qualifications required:

- (a) Lieut. W. BULLOCK, Supply Officer, Palermo Province;
- (b) Lieut. F. GRACH, C.A.P.O., Palermo Province.

8. As soon as these Officers are available, I propose to send them to Padula with a member of my staff who has considerable experience of this work in Sicily and who will initiate them to their task.

9. I request, therefore, that the two Officers mentioned be transferred to this Branch as soon as possible.

SUBJECT: Retaining Services of Capt. D. A. Morse.

TO : Colonel Spofford

1. The undersigned has had several conversations with you regarding the imperative necessity of keeping Capt. Morse on our Labor Sub-Commission Staff in Italy. As you know, he was designated to go to another theater, and you were good enough to arrange delaying his departure until 1 March.

2. The success attendant upon the promulgation and initiation of our Labor Program, as well as the handling and solution of current critical situations and problems, depends exclusively upon the competency and background of our personnel. Frankly, as you well know, we are tackling the huge problem before us with a mere handful of really competent men. Despite numerous urgent requests, we have not secured one single addition in the way of Officer personnel. With the exception of two or three men who may come under our jurisdiction ultimately, they are simply not available without calling on known competent personnel in the United States.

3. The foregoing recitation gives emphasis to the tremendously irreparable loss to our Staff, and equally severe blow to the successful progress of our plans that would be occasioned by the withdrawal of Capt. Morse at this time. Besides his complete competency in the labor field, he, above all others in the Sub-Commission, has had the longest and most intimate contact with all of the developments in this field since our initial Occupancy in Sicily. He has the widest acquaintance with all the important heads in the various units, whether American, British or Italian, who deal with Labor. He has himself evolved or been responsible for most of the important Proclamations, Rules and Regulations which have been issued both in Sicily and on the Mainland, dealing with important basic changes in renovation of the Italian Labor structure.

4. You are aware of the well developed program we are initiating. The new authority given to A.C.C. has increased our responsibilities tremendously. Therefore, at this time particularly, the loss of Capt. Morse would be inexcusable, and I, therefore, most urgently request that every possible effort be made to insure the retention of his services in this Sub-Commission for an indefinite period.

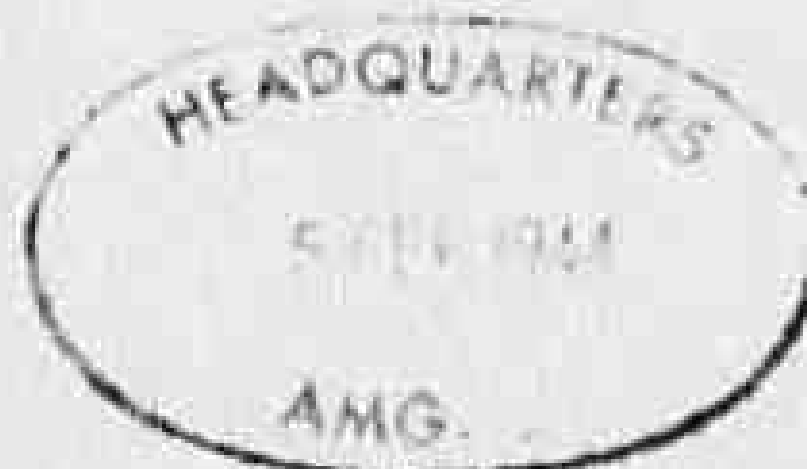
