1. Reference your letter No. 111/14/CA, dated 19th April 1944, and further to this office letter PS/9.1 dated 22nd April 1944.

2. A reply has now been received from St. Stefano, and resulting from information contained in it, it has been established that the undermentioned persons are incarcerated in the prisons stated against their names:-

(a) Procida Penal Prison.

MOSCO Demetrio. Found guilty of murder and sentenced at Rodi on 25th October 1939, to life imprisonment.

(b) St. Stefano Penal Prison.

CAPUJOE George. Found guilty of a political offence at Rodi and sentenced to life imprisonment.

This man was freed by the American Military Authorities when they visited the island, but he was, and still is, too ill to be moved and is at present in the prison infirmary.

(c) Fozzuoli Prison.

IASCIA Demetrio. Found guilty of murder and sentenced at Rodi on 22nd December 1938, to life imprisonment.

3. Delay in obtaining this information is due to the fact that the above named are entered in the prison records as Italian subjects and not Greeks, as they were all born on the island of Rodi, which is or was an Italian possession.

4. In view of the serious nature of the crimes for which, these men are now serving sentence, will you please confirm whether they are to be released, and if so, forward the necessary authority.
