SUBJECT: Displaced Persons - Belgians.

TO : Headquarters, Allied Control Commission
Attention - R C and M G Section.

Reference your 112/2/CA of 31 March.

1. The policy regarding the movement of Belgian nationals from Italy to the United Kingdom has already been notified to you in para 3 of our cable F28956 of 7 April.

2. As regards the Belgian Congo. The Belgian Ambassador to the CFLN in Algiers has been consulted and we have been advised that the best way of Sending Belgian nationals from Italy to the Congo would be to route them through Middle East, where they can be taken care of by the Belgian Military Mission in Cairo. They should not be sent through North Africa. The Belgian Military Mission in Cairo would arrange for the onward transportation of any such persons to the Belgian Congo.

REFERENCE OUR 5348 OF 25 NOVEMBER AND MGS 321-12 OF 28 DECEMBER
 PARA 1. TROOPERS HAVE DIRECTED THAT ESSENTIAL FOR SECURITY FORTHCOMING
 OPERATIONS TO REDUCE INFUX REFUGEES, ALIEN VOLUNTEERS, AND NON-
 ESSENTIAL ALLIED PERSONNEL OF ALL SERVICES TO UNITED KINGDOM. EXCEPT,
 THEREFORE, AS IN PARA 2 NO DISPLACED PERSONS OF ANY NATIONALITY OR
 CATEGORY WILL BE EVACUATED TO UK EITHER DIRECT OR VIA ANY INTER-
 MEDIATE DESTINATION. PARA 2. ONLY EXCEPTIONS TO DIRECTIONS AS IN
 PARA 1 ABOVE MAY BE (A) POLIS. IF DESIRED BY POLISH MISSION ATTACHED
 DISPLACED PERSONS SUB-COMMISSION AS ALTERNATIVE TO EMPLOYMENT AS
 REINFORCEMENTS WITHIN THIS THEATRE, AND IF CONSIDERED BY FORMER AS
 SUITABLE FOR EMPLOYMENT IN POLISH ARMORED DIVISION. EVACUATION SUCH
 PERSONS WILL NOT TAKE PLACE WITHOUT SPECIFIC APPROVAL OF THIS HEAD-
 QUARTERS. (B) IN EXCEPTIONAL CASES INVOLVING PERSONS OF SUCH RANK
 OR IMPORTANCE THAT THEIR SERVICES WOULD BE OF IMMEDIATE AND REAL
 VALUE TO THE GOVERNMENTS OR FORCES OF THE ALLIED NATIONS NOW LOCATED
 IN THE UNITED KINGDOM. SUCH CASES TO BE REFERRED TO THIS HEADQUARTERS
 FOR THE APPROVAL OF TROOPERS PRIOR TO EVACUATION FROM ITALY. PARA 3.
 THIS ALSO ANSWERS YOUR 112/2/CA OF 31 MARCH IN ITS APPLICATION TO THE
