Allied Control Commission -Attention: M.G. and R.C. Section Reference is made to a memorandum from the Displaced Persons Subcommission (not to you), under their reference IDF/45/632 of 10 March 1944. (Copy attached). 1. We have been in touch with the Chinese Consul at Algiers to whom we have shown all the relevant correspondence in this matter. After considering the present status of these Chinese citizens and the condition under which they are living, and having regerd to the difficulties which would inevitably arise in the procurement by mail of all the particulars necessary in the preparation of passports for them, the Consul has recommended that these persons should postpone their application for pasaports and should remain in Italy until the conditions necessary to their repatriation or travel are more favorable. 2. As you are aware, even were passports to be issued to these persons and were special arrangements to be made for their evacuation from Italy there would be no possibility at this time of arranging their repatriation to China, nor could any guarantee be given that they could be found better employment or assured superior living conditions in any country to which they were moved. 3. All photographs, the original letters in Chinese (together with a translation into French of the basic communication), and the original of a memorandum which we have received from the Chinese Consul at Algiers are returned to you herewith for retention by the Displaced Persons Records Bureau against the time when it will be advisable to evacuate these persons and when these documents will be required. SUBJECT: - Displaced Persons - Chinese.

TO :- A.F.H.Q. Military Povernment Section.

- 1. Reference your letter MGS-383.12 dated 29.1.44.
- 2. The seven Chinese have been located. Owing to language difficulties it has been difficult to obtain the correct English names but it is thought that the following information and the attached names in Chinese, will, if compared with the original letter signed by these seven men which the Chinese Consul General in London holds, give exact particulars for passport purposes.
- 3. These five men are at present employed by 8th Army Rest Camp near Bari.

(Guiseppe) CHATZEZU. KIN YANG KIO. TSIOUG SHNOTOI. YEM CHEN SHIEM. TUNG TAO MING.

The sixth is working in BRINDISI, address, Francavilla Stations
Brindisi, and is called TCHEND YUC CHINC (see attached photograph).

The seventh is working in a British Hospital near Bari and is
called LECCHI LIEN (doubt especially about this name, see (G) Chinese list).

There is an eighth man on the Chinese list (D). We are informed that this man is working at the Eth. Army Rest Camp and is in possession of a passport.

4. The letter in Chinese from Chinese Consulate General has not been given to these men (retained herewith) as it instructs the men to apply 10 to CAIRC or ALGIFFE and your para 2 states you will arrange the provision of passports.
