SUBJECT : Funds for Representative in the Vatican.

TO : Major-General Kleeberg, Polish Representative,
Displaced Persons Sub-Commission.

1. In reply to your request to me on the 26 April 1944 as to whether there were any means by which money could be sent to the Polish Representative to the Vatican for the use of Polish Refugees in the City of Rome, I am advised by the Finance Sub-Commission that there is no possibility of sending money to these persons by commercial or other recognised channels.

2. The advice given by the Political Section was that the matter should be represented to your own Government who would then despatch the funds from there as required.

Memorandum for Brigadier Lash:

Subject: Spare Wheel Complete for the Car of the Polish Military Mission.

1. Major General J. Kleeberg head of the Polish Mission with the A.C.C. would appreciate if the following items could be perceived for the car which he is using in his official capacity.

- a. Five spare wheels (Jeep type) complete with tires and inner tubes.
- b. If such wheels are not obtainable in Naples would it be possible to obtain from Italian stocks five tires and inner tubes dim: 6.00 x 18 or 5.50 x 18 through Lt. Colonel Quin Smith, Hq. A.C.C., Salerno.

2. The case is urgent because Major General Kleeberg has no possibilities to get transport to visit various Camps.
