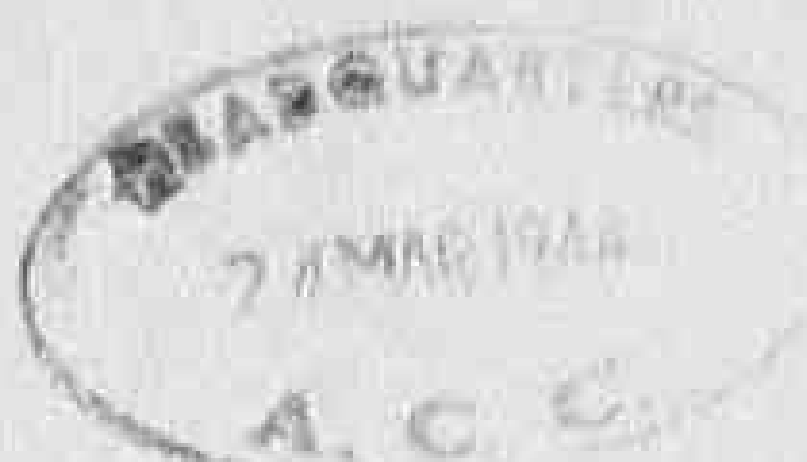

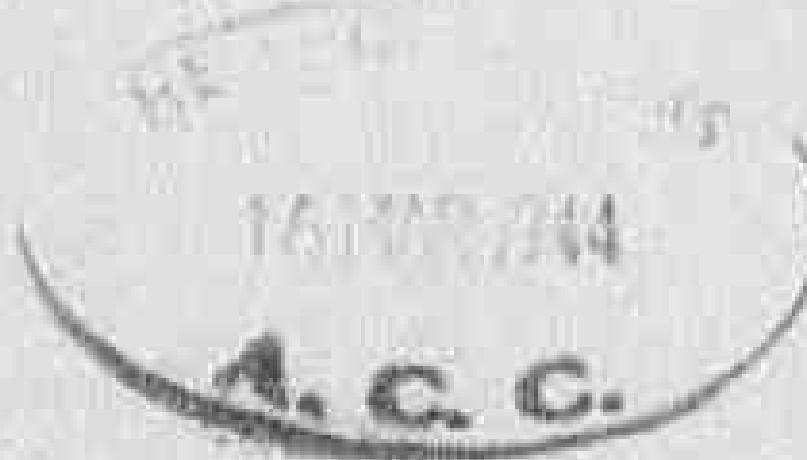

The mission has arisen because it has been felt that "material benefits resulting from conversations with General Holmes and other officers less directly connected with these problems who have returned to US indicate that planning now in progress would be greatly improved by the information that could thus be made available at this critical time". (The quotes above are from CCS cable).

3. In a later cable it was stated that the Group would also study conditions in this theatre, particularly as regards food, so that the theatre requirements can be related to other needs.

4. It is anticipated that the Group will wish to visit Naples and Salerno in the course of their stay here but the length of their desired visit to Italy will not be known until they have arrived here. Further

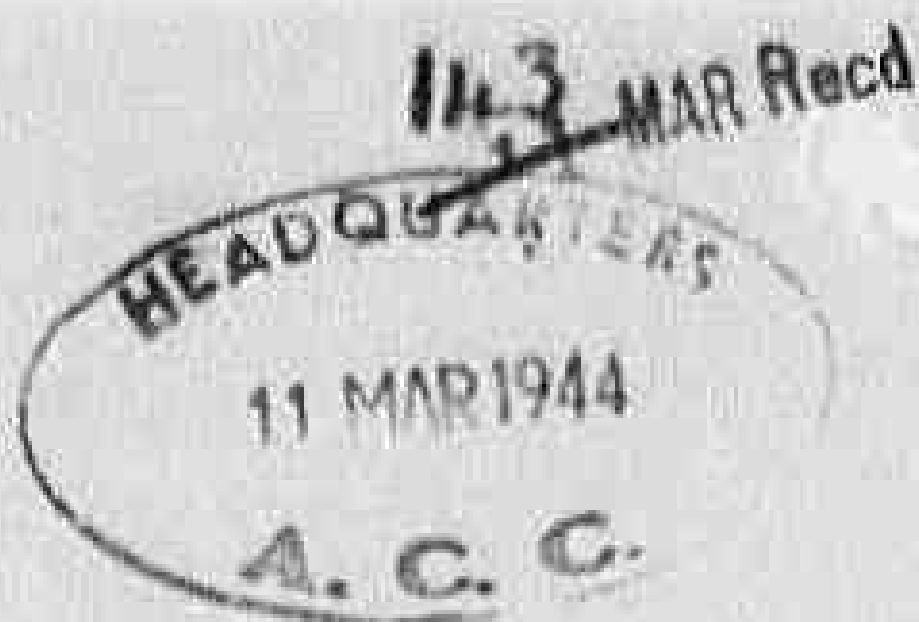
