Dear Lush:

Reference your 6489 of 20 June 1944.

It is regretted that letter G-5 210.3-8 of 17 June 1944 was sent without prior clearance with you. However, the officers concerned have been told that they will not proceed until you agree.

The case under review is that of Brigadier King and Col. Burke. The former is the Head of the Relief and Supplies Dept. of AM HQ (Balkans) and Col. Burke is the Principal Medical Officer. These officers and any others for whom permission is asked will be fully instructed that they are not to request transport but are to make their schedule conform to existing facilities and that they are to have every regard to operations and in taking the time in their discussions with your staff. There is a great deal to be gained from contact with the problems in the field in a way which will not interfere with operations, and I am reluctant to closing off this avenue of experience and knowledge from units which are just forming unless the privileges you are granting them are being abused.

Without submitting them to you and for the reason that we had given you quite a few visitors, we refused earlier applications from General Hughes, Commander of Military Headquarters (Balkans) and other personnel to study conditions in Italy. That fact, therefore, gives these applications perhaps a slight added weight.

I shall be glad to have your comments at your convenience.

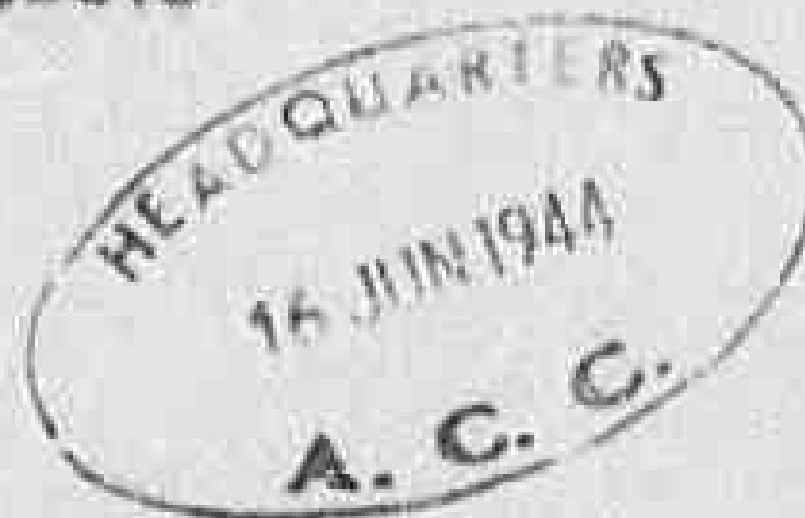

My dear Brigadier:

Reference your letter on visits of Headquarters officers to Region VI and the unnecessarily strict requirements, I set the restriction because we were unable to control these people in their visits to you. I felt and still feel that a strict regulation is better and a bit of leniency in the enforcement will get the correct results.

It places the onus on our Adjutant to make decisions but I have instructed him to consult me in doubtful cases. His general instructions are that if no Headquarters officers are in your Region to permit the travel after a 3 day interval. If 2 or 3 are already there, to hold up the other applicants until return of some.

I am particularly anxious not to have you bothered during the reorganization necessitated by our sudden withdrawal of a considerable number of officers. Thereafter we will encourage visits. With so much new territory for our officers to visit, you will probably see little of us for a time.

I do not expect to be forced to call for any more GAGs or GAGOs from you for a long time.

1. My attention has been drawn to Order No. 4 of Daily Bulletin No. 129 of 3 Jun 44. I cannot trace that this order is based on any official application made by this Headquarters. It seems to me to place unnecessarily difficult conditions on Staff Officers' visits to Sardinia, which visits are always appreciated by this H.Q.
2. ^{London} It is estimated that it will take three to four days for a cable or letter to travel from an office on the mainland to an office at this Headquarters. Allowing the same period for reply from this Headquarters it will mean that 6 to 8 days must elapse before an Officer at your Headquarters can submit a request for a Travel Order to visit Region 5.

The visiting Officer will therefore have to commit himself to a visit to Sardinia about 7 to 9 days in advance.

3. It is true that provision of transport for visiting Officers sometimes places a great strain on Regional resources and the situation will not be improved as and when military vehicles are released for the mainland. It is felt, however, that transport can always be made available provided notice of the visit is received, and the visiting Officer does not require the transport in an abnormal hurry.

Recently within a space of about seven days the following visitors arrived in Sardinia:-

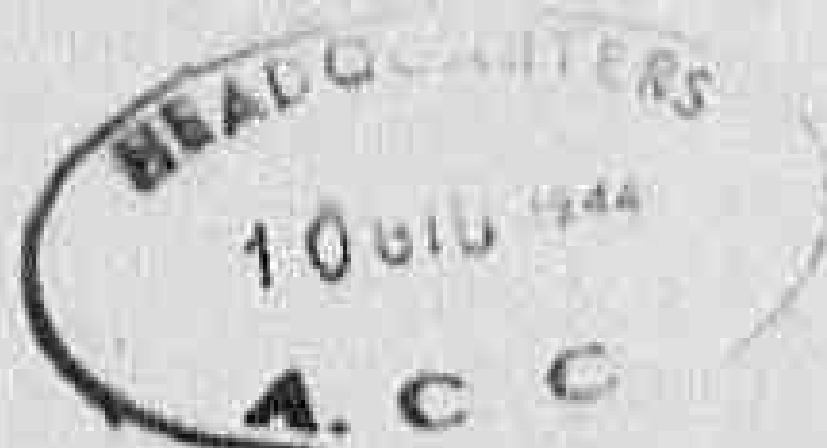

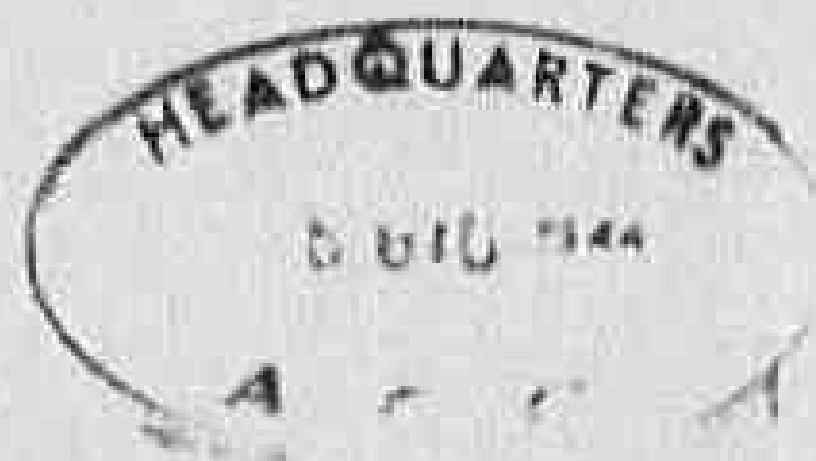

My dear Findlay

This is to introduce to you Mr. Ackerman of the War Refugees Committee set up in Washington at the order of the President. The objectives of the Committee are to assist in every way people in German occupied territories who are in fear of death.

Mr. Ackerman will describe in more detail his object in coming to this country, but the Chief Commissioner wants me to point out to you that so far as we are concerned Mr. Ackerman's functions are concerned with people outside this country and not inside.

If he finds persons in need of his assistance and wishes to bring them to Italy by agreement with this Commission, he may do so (e.g. Hungarian Jews), but once they are in this country the refugees come under your control.

If Mr. Ackerman wishes to discuss matters with the Allied Missions attached to the Displaced Persons Sub-Commission he should approach them through you.

He will also wish to consult with Sir Clifford Heathcote-Smith and I should be grateful if you would arrange this.
