1. Reference your G-5 216.482-44 of 19 Sep 44.

2. While the re-organisation of French schools and institutes may be highly desirable at some future date, any action taken toward getting them into operation now is not considered to be essential to the war effort.

3. Other organisations (British Council etc) have made requests similar to the above but permission has not been granted on the grounds that the educational activity did not bear directly on the war effort. When conditions permit it is suggested that overall consideration be given to authorizing the various educational groups coming forward who have interests in Italy.

4. It is therefore recommended that M. Andre Gide's proposed visit to Italy be deferred say for three months and his request re-submitted at the end of that time.

SUBJECT: Visit of Andre GIDE to Italy

1. Mr. Gide is a very old, frail and distinguished Frenchman. Both on that account and because he is an ally, the Political Section would naturally wish to see his case considered as sympathetically as possible. But if you ask me whether the reorganisation of French schools and institutes is of "sufficient value to the war effort" for us to approve a visit, I can only say that we have not yet authorised anyone to come out on behalf of the British Council, precisely for the reason that the objects of the Council are for peace and not for war.

2. I do not see that M. Gide can claim preferential treatment and should be inclined to reply to A.F.H.Q. that he should not be allowed to visit Rome until permission has also been given for British Council representatives to come to Italy.

When the Crown Prince of Italy was here to lunch today, he mentioned that his old friend, Marquis Cesarini, who is Podesta of Corinaldo, was said, when he tried to visit him today, to have been taken away by AMG. He was perfectly nice about it, but the General promised he would just take it up in case.

We of course know nothing of the Marquis. The Crown Prince represents him as an honest country gentleman who had accepted office as Podesta in the Republican Regime out of a sense of duty.

Of course, this letter needs no answer, but the General would be grateful if you could very kindly have the matter looked into.

Dear Ulick

1. Many thanks for your letter of 26th about the Marquis Cesarini. I think the Army Commander may be interested to know the following facts.
2. Cesarini was arrested by Polish PPS and not by AMG. He is a Squadrista, a member of PNF and later of PNF. He was Commandant of GNR. All of this he has admitted to in a signed and voluntary declaration. In addition there is an original letter from the German Commandant at DESI commending him as the Podesta of Corinaldo for the great help and assistance that he rendered to the German Army, and mentions him as a good Fascist and collaborator of Mussolini. Incidentally from 1925 to 1937 he was a "Moschettiere" to Mussolini.
3. I dare say that he is now a dear old country gentleman, but certainly the history I have given you is as bad as any I have seen and I hardly think it reflects very well on the Prince of Piedmont, who must know all this past history. Incidentally, I was not aware of the fact that the Prince of Piedmont was in the Eighth Army area. He visited quite a lot of very prominent civilians. This is the second time this has occurred as he did it in Florence as well, but after all, life is too short to make a stink about it with AGC.
4. I will say in mitigation of Cesarini that the Patriots and the local CC.RR all say he was a fair and just man, but it will have to be a very strong case in view of his past history when it is reviewed, as it will be on 1 Sep 44 by GSI(b) Eighth Army and my representative.

My dear Mr. Prime Minister:

I have received from the Commander-in-Chief the following message which I am sure Your Excellency will be glad to transmit to His Royal Highness The Lieutenant General of the Realm and any others concerned:

"The Commander-in-Chief of the Allied Armies in Italy will always be very pleased for Lt. General of The Realm Prince Umberto or members of the Italian Government to visit Italian troops serving directly under General Alexander's command, but he must ask His Royal Highness to make arrangements for such visits through Advanced Headquarters, Allied Armies in Italy, so that the Allied Commanders under whom Italian troops are serving may be duly informed beforehand and in order that the necessary measures may be taken for security and so on."

You will perhaps remember that a year ago you were good enough to allow Mr. R.K. Brady and Mr. F. Berry of St. Edward's College, Malta, to visit Tripolitania to study the Educational System there. As a result of their visit they put up a report which I think you found of some value.

These two men are anxious to work during their present summer vacation of about six weeks, and have asked me whether they could possibly be of use to the Allied Control Commission in Italy. They are prepared to do any educational work either of a general nature or if more desirable, of a particular nature such as the teaching of English to key Italian personnel.

They do not, of course, expect to receive any remuneration for this work other than normal out of pocket expenses. If you are able to use them in any way I should be very glad if you would let me know - if possible by telegram in view of the short time at their disposal.

1. In March last following on recommendation at a meeting of the Advisory Council for Italy, permission was given for representatives of British Trades Union Congress to visit Italy. No application for travel facilities for the delegation was made for some time but recently requests for facilities were put in, and have been approved, for the following to represent the British Trades Union Congress on the proposed visit.

Mr. Lawther, President of the Mine Workers
Federation.
Mr. Tom O'Brien of the General Council Trades
Union Congress.
Mr. Schevenas, Secretary of the International
Federation of Trades Unions.

2. Following on the original permission given for the British Trades Union Congress to send a delegation, Washington stated that it was desired to have representatives of U.S. labour afforded the same facilities and the principles of this was agreed. Washington have been informed of the authority given for the three gentlemen referred to in paragraph 1 to make their visit and as it is understood that it may be desired that the visit of the U.S. labour organisations should coincide with the British, they have in that event been requested to forward soonest the names of the American representatives for Theatre clearance and to state when they would arrive here. A reply is awaited to this request.

3. It is anticipated that the British delegates will not arrive before the 18th inst.

4. The British Resident Minister reports a request from the Foreign Office that an interpreter, presumably an Italian, but not a politician, be made available to the delegates. Will you please select a suitable person for that work and inform this Headquarters of his name and have him available on call?

5. Will you also please submit here a suggested itinerary for the visit? It is anticipated that the delegates will desire to visit the large centers of population, including Naples and Rome. Will you please also make any necessary clearance with AAI. No definite time limit for the duration of the visit has been fixed.

6. Further details as to ETA, etc., and as to whether the U.S. delegates will in fact co-incide in date with the British delegates will follow as soon as possible.

7. The object of the visit has been stated by the British Resident Minister here to be

"to enable the delegates to examine the present situation as regards Trades Union activities in Italy, to make contacts with Italian Trades Unionists and to offer suggestions for resuscitating the movement. The delegates will themselves take no active part in the work of reconstruction."

The following is an extract of letter received from the
Home Office:-

"Could you tell me whether it would be possible to arrange for Sir Frank Brock to pay a visit to the Police Officers who are with Civil Affairs in Italy. As I think you know, Sir Frank Newsam has for some time been anxious to arrange for such a visit, and we think it would be an advantage for Brock to gain some first-hand knowledge of the working of Civil Affairs. Although he does not occupy any official position in your organisation he has, as you know, been very much concerned with the selection and training of the Police Officers whom we have supplied and indeed with all matters relating to the Police aspect of Civil Affairs. We also have reason to believe that his visit would be very much welcomed by the Police Officers themselves in Italy; although they are now outside our official jurisdiction they look to the Home Office to what over their personal interest, and they are naturally concerned as to the effect which their absence abroad may have on their careers in the Police Service after the war. They would, therefore, we think appreciate an opportunity of discussing these matters with Brock. If a visit could be arranged it would, of course, be understood that Brock would undertake it in his personal capacity as an Inspector of Constabulary, and there would be no suggestion that he is taking any official part in the Civil Affairs organisation.

As regards the details of the visit, if it can be arranged, we thought that he might go for two or three weeks and that he would make a tour which would enable him to make contact with the senior Civil Affairs Officers and see as many as possible of our Police Officers in the places where they are stationed."

We are of the opinion that the proposed visit will be to the advantage of all concerned and shall be grateful if you will cable whether the necessary arrangements can be made.
