SUBJECT: boundaries of Potenza Province
TO : The Chief Commissioner

1. This matter was raised at the Vice-president's meeting on the 13th March.

2. The following are the facts:

23 February: A telegram was received by the Allied Control Commission from Matese Province, protesting against the alteration of the boundaries. The protest was based on press reports.

23 February: Public meeting of protest at Matese. Telegrams were sent to Reale, the Allied Control Commission, Marshal Bedoglio, the Giunta, and the King.

25 February: Copy of said telegram referred to RO, Region II for comments.

26 February: Telegram forwarded to Dr. Reale for comments.

29 February: Full report on the subject received from RO, Region II. (This report had been dispatched by RO, Region II on the 24th February, at which date he was fully apprised of the proposed changes.)

6 March: Report on the subject from the Director, Interior sub-Commission.

7 March: Vice-president recommended no action.

7 March: Minister of Interior's reply to Director, Interior sub-Commission, justifying his actions.

15 March: Interior Sub-Commission informed that the actual boundaries have not yet been settled, and no decree yet been issued.

15 March: The Director, Interior sub-Commission informed RO, Region II, that no decision has yet been made, and inquired what number of officers would be affected by the change of boundaries. There are, in fact, for each province, approximately 3 officers in the field from all the communes.

- a. That HQ, Region II had the earliest information of the proposed changes.
- b. That the effect on the interior economy of his region would be immaterial.
- c. That the issues between Matera and Potenza provinces are matters for the Italian Government.
- d. That if the Chief Commissioner considers the matter of sufficient importance, a draft letter for his signature should be prepared by the Interior Sub-Commission.

Memorandum on the transfer of Comunes from Matera to Potenza Province.

1. Regional Commissioner, Region II, on 21 Feb heard from the Dari Press of the transfer of four communes from Matera to Potenza.
 2. On 24 Feb he wrote to H.Q. objecting strongly to the transfer and asking for the annulment of the decree. His objections can be summarized as follows :
 - (a) The population of the four communes transferred is 15.2% of Matera Province.
 - (b) The area of the communes transferred is 15.9% of Matera Province.
 - (c) The taxes paid by the communes transferred is 17.4% of the taxes of Matera Province.
 - (d) Even with its original 32 communes Matera Province could not balance its budget.
 - (e) There is a very strong political feeling in Matera against the transfer. The people claim that there is no economic or administrative justification for the transfer and express the view at a large meeting that the move is intended to improve the personal political influence of Signore Reale, a resident of Potenza. The R.C. agrees with this.
 3. Lord Stanisgate wrote on 7th March to H.Q. to say that since this is a matter for the Italians to decide, no action by A.G.C. is possible. He refers to "certain directives".
 4. Region II forward the resolution of a political body in the main Commune affected, objecting strongly to the transfer and asking that the resolution be brought to Chief Commissioner's attention. 5. 2
 5. Question now. Should not the objections of the R.C. and by Matera Province be brought to the attention of Reale or better Badoglio ?

1. The following report is submitted upon the transfer of the communes of Genzano, Sanzzi, Pelazzo S. Jervasio, and Triosirico from Matera to Potenza by Royal Decree, news of which was received in the Bari press on February 21st.

HISTORICAL

When the province of Basilicata (Incapria) was separated from Apulia in 1653, Matera became its political capital, as it had been the ecclesiastical capital for centuries. The situation remained unchanged until 1806, when the French transferred the capital to Potenza as a punishment for Matera's fidelity to the Bourbons. The difficulty of communication with Potenza, which is three hours fast driving by automobile from Matera, and approximately five hours from the southern part of Matera province, has always made Matera the natural commercial and economic center for the southern part of Lecania. From the time the French transferred the capital to Potenza, there was always a longing in the southern part of the province for Matera to regain its ancient historical position. This wish was granted in 1927 when, by royal Decree, Basilicata was divided into two provinces. Potenza was given 68 communes, and Matera 32. Matera is the ecclesiastical seat of a Metropolitan Archdiocese founded in very ancient times, while Potenza is only a suffragan See.

In November the rumors spread through the province that a plan was under foot to transfer some communes to Potenza. This scheme was attributed to Signore Deale, a resident of Potenza, recently appointed Undersecretary of State for the Interior in the Bedoglio Government. It was apparent that some politically minded persons were attempting to stir up sentiment for such a move.

1. The following report is submitted upon the transfer of the communes of Cenazzo, Benzi, Palazzo S. Jervasio, and Tricerico from Matera to Potenza by Royal Decree, news of which was received in the Bari press on February 21st.

HISTORICAL

Matera is the ecclesiastical seat of a Metropolitan Archdiocese founded in very ancient times, while Potenza is only suffragan See.

2. In November the rumors spread through the province that a plan was under foot to transfer some communes to Potenza. This scheme was attributed to Signore Reale, a resident of Potenza, recently appointed Undersecretary of State for the Interior in the Badoglio Government. It was apparent that some politically minded persons were attempting to stir up sentiment for such a move.

3. We are informed that SIG. Saphaile Scalcione, Guarentee that the province of Matera would not be touched, and gave the latter permission to publish the contents. Despite these assurances, SIG. Reale has apparently induced the Badoglio Government to issue a decree transferring these four communes from Matera to Potenza.

CONSEQUENCES

4. The consequences of the announcement of this transfer are somewhat important from two aspects, fiscal and political. Data furnished by the Prefect of Matera at my request show that the total population of Matera Province (one of the smallest, if not the smallest in Italy) was 165,776 in the census of 1936.

The population of the four communes transferred was 25,566, or 15.2 per-cent of the total.

b The area of these communes is 32,856 hectares, or 13.9 per-cent of the 379,345 hectares in the province.

The total of provincial taxes and surtaxes on land and buildings for the province for the year 1944 is £3,682,447. The part paid by the detached communes was £678,823, or 17.4 per-cent. It is thus clear that the transferred communes represent a better than average section of Matera Province. With the revenue from 32 communes, the province could not completely balance its budget. If, therefore, this severance of communes should be allowed to stand, the question would arise whether, since the provincial overhead could not be materially reduced, the province of Matera should be abolished entirely. It is openly alleged in Matera that this is the ultimate objective of Franco's regime.

c If it should be decided to annex the remainder of Matera Province to some other province, there would be serious economic loss to those who have made investments in business and real property to accommodate the needs of a provincial capital, such as housing accommodations for provincial officials.

d The political repercussions from the announcement of the Decree have been vigorous in Matera. With the permission of the Prefect, and the approval of the National Commissioner, a public meeting was held in Matera on February 3rd in the cinema theater. Approximately 700 people crowded the theater to capacity, and several more were unable to gain admission. The feeling was intense and the audience vocal but generally good-humored, and they did not become disorderly. At the end of the meeting, the people dispersed quickly.

e The first speaker, Avv. Milillo, represented the Socialist Party. He vigorously criticized the Badoglio Government, which he declared was carrying on the old Fascist system. In effect, that the separation of the four communes was the first step to the complete abolition of Matera as a province. He held that if there were justifications for the move, it should have been left until the end of the war, when it could have been considered by a strictly representative government.

(L) Repeated references to the allied Military Government were warmly applauded. It was evident that the audience was very hopeful that the fair-mindedness of the ACC/AANG chiefs would lead them to annul the Decree.

(D) In private conversation, responsible members of the community have expressed the view that there was no real economic or administrative justification for the transfer, but that its real motive was an attempt to strengthen Signore Seale's personal political influence. The opinion is also expressed that the Bedoglio Government is ill-advised, at a time when every energy should be concentrated on problems of major national importance, to waste any of its energy on petty political maneuvering, which can only result in alienating the people of one province without any compensating gain in another.

CONCLUSION

As Regional Commissioner, I must state that I believe the transfer was actuated by personnel politices on the part of Signore Beale, and that it was ill-advised to stir up the people of one province against the government for no good political, economic, or administrative reason. It is my recommendation that, if possible, the Decree should be annulled, or that necessary steps be taken to make it ineffective. I am confident that if it could be announced to the people of Matera that the proposed transfers had been abandoned, the people of Matera Province would be very well pleased; and that there would be little or no resentment in Potenza. The net result would be a distinct improvement in the political situation from the standpoint of A.C.C.

Successivamente press la parola l'avvocato Grandi Prospere, in qualità di libero cittadino, il quale, con torbido discorso, fece la stessa fine iniqua, sia perche queste Cagliari, a differenza di tutti i Comuni della Provincia, si era distinto, a prezzo del sangue dei suoi cittadini, nelleuccia dei tedeschi nel tardi pomeriggio del 21 settembre scorso e, sia perche non era questo il momento opportuno per apportare modifiche alle circoscrizioni amministrative, ciò che sarebbe di competenza delle assemblee legislative, dato che lo sforzo di tutti gli italiani è teso nella liberazione del nucleo della Patria del nemico.

Il discorso venne molto applaudito.

Si susseguirono il Dr. Venturo Tommaso per la Democrazia Cristiana l'avv. De Ruggieri Nicolo, quale componente del Comitato di Liberazione, l'avv. Bianco Michele per il Partito Comunista, che ribadirono le proteste già fatte dai precedenti oratori e, per ultimo, il Sindaco di Matera, avvocato Levrone Domenico, il quale dette lettura di cinque telegrammi inviati al Re, a sua Eccellenza Badoglio, al Ministro dell'Interno, alla Giunta Esecutiva del Comitato di Bari ed alla Commissione di Controllo Alleata a Napoli, di cui si allargano le
