SUBJECT : Staff Pay - U.D.F. Officers

1. We have been informed that the question of Staff Pay for U.D.F. Officers holding Staff Appointments is being investigated.
2. A board of officers is at present being formed to examine officers holding staff appointments, who have not passed a staff course. Those officers who satisfy the board will be recommended for transfer to S.A. Staff Corps.
3. This refers only to officers of the rank of Captain or above.
4. Will you please forward the following particulars in respect of all U.D.F. officers in your formation :
 - (a) Rank, Name, No. Unit.
 - (b) Full details of any recognized Staff Course attended, with result.
 - (c) Whether an application has been made previously for transfer to S.A. Staff Corps.
5. In view of para 2 above, I request that the matter be treated as urgent.
