TO: COMMANDING OFFICER, 58TH/AMMUNITION CO., APO 464, USArmy

1. Attached file forwarded through AMG channels shows that a 2nd Lt Robert W. Johnson signed for and obtained from the Avellino Provincial Consortium on 30 Jan last 5 Quintali of wheat "for use by the government hospitals of the 5th Army in Italy."
2. This office has been advised that the vehicle used by Lt Johnson bears the number of one belonging to the 6694th Ord. Base Group (Prov.), which for some time past has been stationed in the vicinity of Santa Maria.
3. Records of the Ord. Base Group (6694th) show that 2nd Lt. Victor W. Johnson, Jr., is now attached to 58th Ord. Amm. Co.
4. Owing to the similarity of names, and to the fact that the number of the vehicle shown on the receipt for such grain belongs to an ordnance unit, it is suggested that perhaps 2nd Lt Johnson might possibly be able to throw some light on the transaction and thus aid us in clearing up a matter which the Surgeon's Office, 5th Army, knows nothing about, although, as above indicated, such grain was drawn "for use by the government's hospitals of the 5th Army in Italy."

The Commune concerned has been informed that in future only papers bearing the stamp of the Alimentation office of this Province and the A.M.G. stamp will be accepted. Please May an investigation be made into this Matter.
