1. Capt. BUMP came to see me this morning to tell me about the Foggia Harvest. He wanted to see you but you were busy so I promised to pass it on to you personally.

2. The collection up till Sunday last, 27th August was 1,200,000 quintals - this is the full quota for export. He expects that they will get another half a million quintals more which is pretty good going.

3. Capt. BUMP has seen Agriculture and P.R.O. about the new story. He is now on his way to join Region IX.

Foggia Harvest - Report by Col. Temperley.

1. At 293 is a good report by Col. Temperley on the operation of receiving and putting to work of 25,000 Italian Army soldiers.
2. The first page briefly explains what happened and the excellent effect on keeping wages down. He also explains how it was that there were one or two to spare (para. 11). I think this should be passed on to AAI with a letter of appreciation for their help.
3. The question of dispersal after harvest is stated to be under control, provided rail transport can be made available. I will take this up with Major Friend James and "Q" Movements so as to try and eliminate any undesirable incidents.

1. ~~As requested by Brig. [unclear]~~ The following is a brief summary of the operation of Italian Military Harvesters in this Province :-

2. In past years the Italian Government organised the immigration of Harvest workers into this Province on a large scale. The total numbers imported each year varied from 10 - 25,000. In 1943 it was 18,000.

3. This year's Harvest prospects were good (calling for more work), and it was known that the Allied Forces were employing up to 10,000 Harvest labourers on the Airfields. It looked as if there would be a shortage of at least 25,000 Harvest labourers this year. If this shortage were not met the effect would be to drive illegal wages to a high level and to drain the Allied Military Forces of their labour.

4. It was considered that the best solution would be to import Italian soldiers as agricultural harvesters and this procedure was in due course approved by A.A.I. and A.C.C.

5. The intention was to import serving soldiers, but at the last minute it was laid down that Congedanti (Time-expired soldiers), who were waiting at SARDINIA for return to their homes, should be used in the first place. It was realised that these men might be unwilling workers and that desertions might take place. But this had to be accepted.

6. I.M.I.A. supplied a staff and equipment for a "Military Harvest Workers' Centre" in FOGGIA to arrange dispersal to farms and the complete procedure was laid on whereby the soldiers would be sent to their work and supplied with the proper documents for pay and rations.

7. It soon became obvious to civilian labour, farmers and political agitators in FOGGIA that the arrival of the soldiers was depressing wage levels. Political resistance began to make itself felt. For fear of the political consequences, farmers were inclined to refuse soldiers. Accordingly, Provisional Orders were issued compelling Communes to accommodate and support soldiers before they went to work and compelling all farmers to accept a minimum of 1 soldier per 10 Hectares for a period of 30 days. These Orders had the desired effect. Farmers had an alibi to cover them from political criticism. Soldiers were steadily absorbed.

3. This year's Harvest prospects were good (calling for more work), and it was known that the Allied Forces were employing up to 10,000 Harvest labourers on the Airfields. It looked as if there would be a shortage of at least 25,000 Harvest labourers this year. If this shortage were not met the effect would be to drive illegal wages to a high level and to drain the Allied Military Forces of their labour.

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8. It is estimated that at least 80% of the soldiers were placed at work at their farms within 24 hours of their arrival and, (with a few minor exceptions), the remaining 20% within 30 day or two.

9. The presence of the soldiers had a most marked and immediate effect. Farmers, who, a few days before, had come to AMG to complain that workmen were demanding Lit. 800 and Lit. 200 per day for the Harvest, returned to report that the same men had come back offering to work for the legal wage. It is

believed that some 60% of the soldiers had agricultural experience and generally speaking, the farmers were well pleased with them. The B.A.D.L. of the Province reports that there has been practically no important drain on Military labour so far during the Harvest.

10. The soldiers have done good work and their importation has been a marked success. The Italian Officers supplied by S.M.R.F. were first-class; they knew their jobs and got on with it.

11. The estimated requirements of soldiers was based on actual day to day figures for previous years. Normally, Harvest collection reaches a high peak at the end of July and the beginning of August, calling for a corresponding high peak in imported labour. This year opening has not been accelerated by hot winds and progress has been much steadier. The peak in Harvest has not occurred, and the peak in labour requirements is also absent. Accordingly, it was possible to reduce the total requirements from 25,000 to 20,000 and to hold in reserve a Bn of 200 men at the FOGGIA Centre against emergencies. It can be said, therefore, that 95% of the soldiers actually imported found employment in the Province.

12. The problem of dispersal after Harvest work is proving complicated. This Headquarters understood that Harvest workers were to serve a fixed period and accordingly arranged for their concentration and disposal in the order of arrival. This scheme had to be abandoned when A.A.I. ruled that all Congedanti should be kept to last. A new scheme has been prepared, however, and provided that rail transport can be made available the concentration and movement of the serving soldiers should proceed without hitch. If there is any delay in providing transport there may be some difficulty in feeding and accommodating a great mass of idle soldiers without camping and cooking equipment.

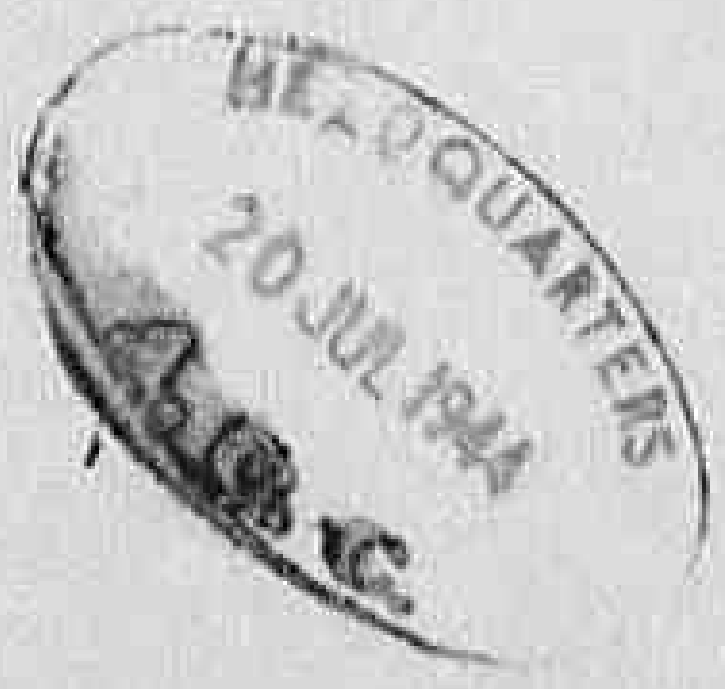

1. Will you please take up with Col. Temperley when you see him tomorrow the following point.
2. Major Friend James rang up from AAI to state that G(SD) are very perturbed at the handling of the harvesters which AAI obtained for FOGGIA Province. Col. Temperley has already returned 5,000 out of the original 25,000 and now apparently finds that he cannot fully employ all of the 20,000.
3. He has apparently suggested that small numbers such as 200 to 300 of Congedati should be dispensed with. AAI say that if any are not required they should be returned to MMIA as even small numbers are urgently required. They are desperately short of labour. Therefore if Col. Temperley cannot use the full 20,000 those which are not required should be regular Italian Army Personnel and should be offered back to MMIA. Congedati should be employed up to the end of the harvest period.
4. Finally AAI require a phased programme of the dates of release of military personnel. In this programme men of the Piacenza and Mantova Divisions should be released first.

TO : Vice President,

1. I have received your memo NY/10 of 20 June 44.
2. I am glad that the situation as regards binder twine is better than was reported. There is always a lag between despatch and arrival and I do not think there was any deliberate misrepresentation on this score.
3. The Provincial Commissioner understands that the 5000 shoes which you mention are to be used for the premium scheme and in any case for the civilian labourers. His present concern is shoes for the Military Reservists sent from Sardinia who are unshod.
4. On the question of transport I can only assure you that the figures given to me were those which the Provincial Commissioner had under his command when he spoke to me and that his requirements are the minimum on which he can organise the collection. If his requirements up to the end of June have been partly or even fully met by trailer, so much the better. Can he have the assurance that his July and August requirements will be met or do you wish me to ask AAI to provide from their resources.
5. My memorandum was intended to be informative and constructive only as a result of a visit to the Province most concerned with harvesting.

TO : Executive Commissioner

Reference your 199/2172/CA dated 19 June 1944.

1. Replying to your memorandum of the 19th June which covered your recent visit to Foggia Province and discussions with Provincial Commissioner, Col. Temperly, advise as follows.

2. I think it is worth while going further into this matter because you have been apparently misinformed in respect to several matters involved. Were action taken on the information without further checking, it would result only in the greatest of confusion. For example, I refer to the following subjects placing in quotation marks statements taken from your memorandum.

3. Binder Twine. 'Although the prospects have improved, there is as yet no binder twine although harvesting has begun'. It clearly gives the impression that no binder twine has been shipped to this Province whereas, a written report from the Agricultural Officer of Foggia Province dated June 12th states that he had received 105 tons of binder twine and already distributed it; further, that a train load was expected from Naples about June 12th. On June 12th, 16 cars (wagons) left Naples and arrived, according to Foggia Province report, on the 15th June. Twelve additional wagons were sent on June 13th, four of which went to Foggia. This amount was all in the Province before the date of your memorandum which was 19th of June. This Province will have its requirement of binder twine.

4. Shoes. 'The reservists are very badly shod. 1,000 pairs have arrived, 600 are expected, more are urgently needed'. 5,000 pairs of shoes were made available to Region V last week, the greater proportion of which were destined to Foggia. This information was known to Foggia Province.

5. Transport. 'Present situation is serious, at present they have 55 trucks running and 15 civilian trucks employed entirely on civilian food'. Position on the 19th June as we have it shows that they have 86 vehicles which with the 15 vehicles mentioned in the memorandum would make a total of 101 vehicles and in addition they drew beginning the 14th of June and ending the 17th June 100 one-ton trailers giving their vehicles that much additional capacity. This is for Foggia Province. We can not deal with Provincial

We can not deal with Provinces separately on transport, we must deal with the Regional Headquarters whose Transport officer has the responsibility of looking after the needs of all the Provinces in the Region. As you well know, we do not have a surplus of vehicles and they must be carefully controlled and handled; we are working in close harmony with Major Harris, Regional Transportation Officer and are sending additional vehicles to Region V as fast as they arrive.

6. I do think that there can be so much better team work if officers in the field give out only correct information; otherwise, we soon feel we have to discount very substantially their requests for material and equipment.

I visited Puglia Province yesterday and discussed with the Provincial Commissioner (Colonel Gasparley) the problems of the Foggia harvest and collection scheme. The following points emerged:-

1. Labour.

Military labour is arriving regularly and in sufficient numbers. Civilian labour is also available and it may be possible to divert some military labour to AMI at the end of the month.

2. Binder Twine.

Although the prospects have improved there is as yet no binder twine in the Province, although harvesting has begun. Supplies provided amount to 2 kilos per hectare as against 5 kilos per hectare last year. It looks as if there will be insufficient.

3. Shoes.

The reservists are very badly shod. 1000 pairs have arrived, 600 are expected, more are urgently needed.

NOTES ON MEETING HELD AT HQ REGION V.

Thursday 7th June 44.

FUCCIA HARVEST.

Main points of discussion:- Labour and Transport.

(1) LABOUR.

Col. Temperley anticipated that, of the 25,000 Italian soldiers (incl. 1 Col, 2 Majors and several Captains) allotted for agricultural work over the whole network of the FUGLIA Province, some 10-20% may be absentees or deserters. This figure has, however, been taken into consideration. They might accept outside offers for work from farmers, who it is understood are paying up to 600 lire per day (especially in the MATERA district).

The soldier labour will be taken on their arrival at Foggia Station straight to the farms, and Carabinieri will be responsible to keep check on their movements. They will be housed and fed by their employers, as they have neither tents or utensils of their own.

Lt. Col. MIDDLEWOOD queried the order that farmers must employ rich soldier labour in preference to civilian labour. This might cause ill-feeling among both civilian labourers and their employers of previous years. It was pointed out, however, that the percentage of soldiers employed would be only 10% against 90% civilians, for whom there will be sufficient work. The object of soldier labour is that farmers, who urgently require labour, shall use soldiers who are homeless and in most cases have agricultural experience from their former civilian life. It will also provide farmers with cheap labour and prevent them from calling on civilian labour at present engaged on vital wartime work in the FUGLIA Airfields. Payment is 65 lire per day; but only for the time the soldier is actually engaged on farmwork. In cases where soldiers arrive prior to the actual commencement of their work (a fact which will be unavoidable in view of the transport difficulties), they will receive food and accommodation only.

Trouble on this score is not expected.

Major. FISHER brought up the question of employment of Peccinini. This matter is to be talked over with A.C.C. bearing in mind the lack of good will among civilians.

(2) TRANSPORT.

The main point is to get the trucks which have been promised, of which only 69 so far have been received. *13? 120-130 trucks are available in the area.*

Major. FISHER suggested that it is impracticable to place the trucks in the manner laid down (13 points).

Lt. Col. LATIMER suggested the trucks to be placed in a strategic centre, so as to be available when needed. In this connection it was proposed to establish a Report Centre in Foglia, combined with a Runner System, in order to set up a satisfactory communications system. (Major COMINGS).

It was pointed out by Col. Sumpster that cases of trucks being urgently required at one place while others were lying idle at another place, would hardly occur. It should also be borne in mind that inland transport will substantially assist. It was suggested that once the trucks were received, movements of arms would be carried out in a proper manner. Apart from the 69 already received, another 100 were due immediately. It was decided that Foggia Province should ask for trucks as required. It was the function of the Inspector to provide the trucks, and it is up to Lt. Col. LATIMER to ensure sufficient are available.

(3) THRASHING MACHINES.

Although in previous years 1500 machines were used in the Province it is thought that this year, which are available for this year's harvest, will prove sufficient, seeing that they will be moved from place to place and not remain idle. The machines are distributed to about 2000 farms per day as the peak period.

(4) MINING EQUIPMENT.

Capt. BICE assumed the conference that the situation is well in hand. A truckload containing 100 and other equipment is arriving in Naples presently.

Notice of arrival of 100 on the 10th should be given in good time to the railway authorities, so that the same can be effected before other goods are unloaded which may delay the unloading of the 100.

(5) REPAIRS.

There can be time delay.

(6) REPAIRS.

Seeks. There are a great number of trucks involved at CASERTA which will be moved to REGGIO or TAVOLARA.

Latimer. It was suggested to the Brig. that as a substitute in case of emergency.

(4) BIDDING TWICE

Notice of arrival of B.T. on the quays should be given in good time to the railway authorities, so that clearance can be effected before other goods are unloaded which may choke up the unloading space.

(5) REPAIRS

These can be done locally.

(6) MATERIALS

Sacks. There are a great number of sacks warehoused at CASERPA which will be moved to FOGHIA on request.

Bolting. It was suggested to use wire rope as a substitute in case of emergency.

Fuel. Supply of coal again depends on satisfactory transport conditions. A bid for 5000 quintals has been made. Last month 150 tons were transported by road; for this month 350 tons are required, of which 180 tons by rail. There are not sufficient trucks, of which 40 are short at present. Lt. Col. LARSEN promised to look into this matter and get the fuel up as soon as possible.

(7) BLACK MARKET

It was pointed out that the crossing of the wool clip might encourage the black market and lead to illegal sales; difficult to check up if goods pass through various hands.

Illegal thrashing would hardly represent a problem. One Carabinieri each has been allotted to the supervision of 4 machines. It was thought that Italian Officers and NCOs might perhaps assist in this job of supervising, but it did not seem advisable.
