

1. HQ, 12 Air Force Service Command, have asked that all civilian personnel be evacuated from the Alfa Romeo Settlement, Pomigliano.
2. There are at the present time some 1500 civilians living in the settlement. Of this figure approximately half the adult males are directly employed by Alfa Romeo on aircraft engine work, which it is understood forms a part of the scheme for the rehabilitation of the Italian Air Force. These men with their families represent a total of some 700 persons.
3. There are thus two aspects to this question which affect your HQ:-
  - a) The removal of the Alfa Romeo workers, who are presumably working under the directions of the Air Force Sub-Commission.
  - b) The general question of the total evacuation to adjacent areas of 1500 civilians.
4. It is requested that you consider both these aspects, and if the evacuation is considered feasible take the necessary steps to clear this area. It must, however, be pointed out that in the event of a mass evacuation it will not be possible to supply transport from military sources to convey the Alfa Romeo workers between their homes and the airfield.
