I, the undersigned, Cafa' Stella living at Via Lucana N° 2 permit myself to mention the following.

My husband Cafa Nunzio affected by epethelioma of the left cheek was in the civilian hospital which he left, without being able to take radium treatment because of the shortage of therapeutic facilities at Tripoli.

Without the treatment of radium, my husband will die while in intense pains.

Since there is radium in Naples, I warmly pray you to grant me permission to go to Naples or some other airport in Italy by air, with the hope of saving the life of my husband.

Confident that this favor will be granted, I thank you
