SUBJECT: Mission Indemnity (Indennita di Missioni)

TO : R.O.'s Regions II, III, IV, V, and VI and
SCAP's 3rd and 5th Areas, AFI.

1. An increase of 70% into Indennita di Missioni should be ordered for all employees of permanent and temporary status of the State, Provinces, Communes, Enti Para-Municipali and Public Institutions and Agencies which are administered by any of the pre-war governmental units.

2. Indennita di Missioni should not be looked upon as a wage. It is a travel allowance.

3. Indennita di Missioni has been increased by 70% in Sicily and in Salerno Province, and should be made uniform throughout Italy.

SUBJECT: Mission Indemnity (Indennita' di Missione).

TO : Brigadier M. S. Lush, Executive Commissioner, R.C. & M.C. Section

1. The basic request of the Prefecture of Naples should be approved, and an increase of 70% in the indennita' di missione should be ordered for all employees of permanent and temporary status of the State, provinces, communes, Enti Para-Statali and Public Institutions and Agencies (Aziende) which are administered by any of the foregoing governmental units.

2. Indennita' di Missione has been increased by 70% in Sicily as well as in the Salerno Province, and should be made uniform throughout Italy.

3. Indennita' di missione should not be looked upon as a wage. It is a travel allowance.

TO : Brig. General M. S. LUSH - Executive Commissioner
Regional Control & Allied Military Government Section - ACC HQ.

1. The Prefecture of Salerno, on 22 January 1944, informed the Managers of Public Offices of Salerno Province that the Indennita' di Missione, beginning 1 December 1943, would be increased 70%.

2. The Prefect of Naples has now requested that the same increase be extended to Naples Province.

3. Uniformity in these matters would be very helpful.

SUBJECT: Mission Indemnity (Indennita' di Missione)

TO : Colonel Foletti, AMG - Naples

1. The Prefecture of Salerno, with the circular letter of 22nd January, a copy enclosed, informs the Managers of Public Offices of this Province that the AMG had directed that the daily Indemnity of Mission, starting from 1st December 1943 will be increased of 10%.

2. I request to benevolently examine the opportunity that this increase may also be extended to the Province of Naples, in which the high living standard puts officials, ordered for service reasons to work outside their usual residence, in such conditions as to endure heavy financial sacrifices.

As you of course know, Salerno Province, prior to being turned over to "the King's Italy" was under region 2 for some time. Personally, I do not believe Naples should be guided by what Salerno does. Col. Poletti's letter to the Prefect of 21 November is the most precise and clarifying document that has yet been issued on the subject of salaries in my opinion, and I believe that we should stick to that.
