SUBJECT: Visit of Professor Dodds and 4 others from Sicily to Italy.

TO : Colonel A. E. Young,
Public Safety Sub-Commission.

1. A signal has recently been received from A.P.R.Q. stating that Professor Dodds and four civilians had been waiting a long time in Sicily for a permit to enter Italy. They cannot understand why this has been delayed.

2. Major Fielden, Public Relations Officer, states that on their visit to Sicily they caused a great deal of trouble to A.C.C. and is not anxious for them to be given permission.

3. The matter was referred to General MacFarlane who directed that a meeting should be held as soon as possible to discuss it. The meeting will be at 1600 hours this afternoon in General MacFarlane's office and the following will attend:-
