To : A.M.G. Eighth Army (main)
through: A.M.G. L.O. X Corps.

1. In compliance with verbal order of July 21, 1944 of Group Capt. Benson commanding officer A.M.G. - Eighth army the following list of category arrests in Perugia province are being held in Perugia, for disposition of proper authorities. All evidence and arrest reports are held by this office.

1. MARIOTTI MARIO = Fassinello 5 Spoleto = Maresciallo of Italian royal army and then of republican army. Arrested by the A.M.G. on the 19.7.44 Category A NO21 National republican guard.

2. FOGLIA GUILLIEMO = Corso Garibaldi 26 Spoleto = Merchant = Arrested by the A.M.G. on the 19.7.44. Undesirable fascist element. Entered fascist party in 1923, chief of sector of the PNF, officer of the fascist militia. It is said that until the 25/7/43 he took part in the violencees that were done in the Casa del Pasco.

3. ORVI FEDERICO = mason = Montefalco (Prov. of Perugia). Arrested on the 23.6.44 by the A.M.G. = Cat. A No 21. Member of the PNF since 1933. Called under colours in June 1943 in the fascist militia. Volunteer in the fascist militia during the african campaign. He was private in the fascist militia (national republican guard) until april 1944, in Foligno. It is not known that he made propaganda but it is stated he has sold some military clothes after having stolen them. It is also known he volunteered in the fascist militia in order to have a possibility to devote himself to his activity of stealing.

4. SPITELLA Ponziano = employed = Via Basilica 4 Spoleto = Arrested on the 20.6.44 by the patriots. Cat. A. No. 21 = Fascist republican guard - member since the 20 of nov. 1943. Took part in the punitive operations in the region of Norcia against patriots, according to the charge of a patriot.

5. MICHELI NELLO = shoemaker = Pontebari 24 - Spoleto = Arrested on the 18.6.44 by the Public safety of Spoleto = Cat. A. No. 21 National republican guard. Member of fascist party since the 1923 and of the PNF since January 1944. Declared not to be member of fascist militia and of the fascist republican guard and to have concealed his son not to let him to go under colours. Denied to have indicated to the germans the house of Colonel Gregori as accused by Partisans.

6. SALVATERRILLI PIETRO = Vicolo Superiore 8 Spoleto = technician arrested by the A.M.G. on 19.7.1944 = entered national fascist

by the A.M.G. on the 19.7.44. Undesirable fascist element. Arrested fascist party in 1923, chief of sector of the FFR, officer of the fascist militia. It is said that until the 25/7/43 he took part in the violence that were done in the Casa del Fascio.

3. CORVI FEDERICO = mason = Montefalco (Prov. of Perugia). Arrested on the 23.6.44 by the A.M.G. = Cat. A No 21. Member of the FFR since 1933. Called under colours in June 1943 in the fascist militia. Volunteer in the fascist militia during the african campaign. He was private in the fascist militia (national republican guard) until april 1944, in Foligno. It is not known that he made propaganda but it is stated he has sold some military clothes after having stolen them. It is also known he volunteered in the fascist militia in order to have a possibility to devote himself to his activity of stealing.

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6. SALVATORELLI PIETRO = Violo Superiore 8 Spoleto = technician arrested by the A.M.G. on 19.7.1944 = entered national fascist party 1922, squadrista, sciarpia littorio, entered republican party in October 1943, member of national republican guard 15.3.44. Category A No. 21 National republican guard. Dangerous fascist element.

7. VALLANI GUILLERMO = Via Pierleone 6 Spoleto = commercial representative = arrested by A.M.G. on 19.7.44 = entered FFR on 1.7.22 = squadrista sciarpia littorio, member of fascist militia in 1940 for 6 months entered fascist rep. party in October 1943. Undesirable fascist element. Category A No. 17 officer of militia.

8. OTTAVIANI OSVALDO = Via Palazzoecio 3 Foligno = student = arrested by P.S. (It.) in Spoleto on 15.7.44 = member of fascist youth organizations. Was called under colours in 1942, was member of the auxiliary police of the Questura of Perugia since Feb. 44. Cat. A. No. 21.

9. PASQUALINI ACHILLE = Pissignano 45 near Campello = worker = arrested by patriots at Campello on 29.6.44. = member of fascist republican Guard. Was on duty in Trevi until June 7. Cat. A No. 21 Nat. rep. guard.

10. PERACCHI ANGELO = Via Fontebelle 17 in Assisi = cameraman = arrested on 15.7.44 by PS of Spoleto = cat. A No. 21 auxiliary PS Police in service with fascist republicans.

11. PERUGINI ADAMO = Via Testaccio 3 in Spoleto = agriculturist = arrested by patriots on 17.6.44 = cat. A. No. 21 voluntarily joined fascist republican guard in Jan 44. Was never member of PNF. cannot read.

12. PIZZOTTI GIOVANNI = Via San Tommaso 1 in Spoleto = mechanician = arrested by patriots on 20.7.44 = cat. A. No. 21 national republican guard. member of fascist party since 1933 as ancient front soldier. Member of fascist militia since 30 as "maresciallo" (staff sergeant). Member of fascist republican guard since 7.2.44. According to a charge of two patriots he had taken part in the repression of patriot movement, in the neighbourhood of Spoleto.

13. PRATOFIORINO ANGELO = Arma di Papa Urbano = Spoleto = shoemaker arrested by patriots on 1.7.44 = member of fascist party since 38. Was called under colours in the fascist national guard from december 1943 until 2.1.44.

14. SALVATORIELLI MELIO = Vicolo Superiore Spoleto = Arrested by patriots on 24.6.44 = Cat A. No. 21 as member of fascist republican guard from Sept. 43 until the 28 May 44.

15. SANTACROCE SALVATORE = employed of civil engineers section = arrested by the carabinieri on 20.7.44 = declared to be member of fascist party since 1920 (squadrista) and to have joined the fascist republican party in nov. 43. Lieut of fascist militia. never member of fascist republican guard.

16. PASQUINELLI GIUSEPPE = assaiante = living at San Giacomo near Spoleto = arrested by patriots at Poreta (Prov. Perugia) = Political secretary of the PVR in San Giacomo = squadrista = member of fascist party since 22.

17. PASQUINELLI ALFREDO = Piazza Mentana 2 = Spoleto = mechanician = arrested by patriots at San Giacomo di Spoleto on 2.7.44 = member as private of the national republican guard since november 1943 = category A No21.

18. CARLUCCI FRANCO = worker = Vicolo del forno 6 = Spoleto = arrested by patriots at Spoleto on 16.6.44 = Member of fascist republican party and of national republican guard since the 16.9.43. Cat. A. No21 National republican guard.

19. CHERUBINI ARIANO = mason = San Giacomo near Spoleto 32 = arrested by patriots on 2.7.44 = fascist republican political secretary = member of teh fascist republican party. A.M.G. 8 Army Directive 04/23

13. PRATOFIORITO ANGELO = Arma di Papa Urbano = Spoleto = shoemaker arrested by patriots on 1.7.44 = member of fascist party since 38. Was called under colours in the fascist national guard from december 1943 until 2.1.44.

14. SALVATORELLI EMILIO = Vicolo Superiore Spoleto = Arrested by patriots on 24.6.44 = Cat. A. No. 21 as member of fascist republican guard from Spet. 43 until the 23 May 44.

15. SANFACONDE SALVATORE = employed of civil engineers section = arrested by the carabinieri on 20.7.44 = declared to be member of fascist party since 1920 (squadrista) and to have joined the fascist republican party in nov. 43. Lieut. of fascist militia. never member of fascist republican guard.

16. PASQUINELLI GIUSEPPE = assistente = living at San Giacomo near Spoleto = arrested by patriots at Foreta (Prov. Perugia) = Political secretary of the PVR in San Giacomo = squadrista = member of fascist party since 22.

17. PASQUINELLI ALFREDO = Piazza Mantana 2 = Spoleto = mechanician = arrested by patriots at San Giacomo di Spoleto on 2.7.44 = member as private of the national republican guard since november 1943 = category A No21.

18. CARLUCCI FRANCO = worker = Vicolo del forno 6 = Spoleto = arrested by patriots at Spoleto on 16.6.44 = Member of fascist republican party and of national republican guard since the 16.9.43. Cat. A. No21 National republican guard.

19. CHERUBINI ADRIANO = mason = San Giacomo near Spoleto 32 = arrested by patriots on 2.7.44 = fascist republican political secretary = member of the directory of the fascist republican party. A.M.C. 8 Army Directive 04/23 of June 6/44 as reason for arrest.

20. COPPINI ENRICO = employed of the post office = Via San Martino 6 in Spoleto = arrested by patriots on 19 June 1944 on charge of having worked as a spy for the germans, though patriot ~~was~~ a band. Category A No 21 National republican guard.

21. PROIETTI ADRIANO = railway worker = San Giacomo 79 near Spoleto = arrested by patriots on 29 June 44 = Cat. A No 21 nat. rep. guard. Charged to have been a spy for the germans, though his superior of the railway service has a good opinion of him.

22. CIMARELLI RAIMONDO = mason = Piazza d'Armi 121 = arrested by a civilian at Spoleto on 18 June 1944 = Member of fascist party (from youth organization) and of republican party since the 6 Oct 1943 as well as of the fascist republican guard. Category A /17/21.

23. MARIANI LUIGI = mechanician = Tarraglia near Spoleto No 12 = arrested by partisans at Spoleto on 17.6.44. Member of fascist party since 1941, of rep. party since feb. 44 and of fascist republican guard since 20 feb 1944. = Category A No21 = fascist republican guard.

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24. MAURILIO BONIDA = Piedipaterno S.M. = mechanician = arrested on 29.7.44 by partisans non comm. off. of fascist repub an Guard since Jan 44 member of a militia battalion in Slovenia from the 8.5.43 since Jan 44. (34th batt. MVSN)

25. BONORANDI DANTE = Viale Trento e Trieste Spoleto = Director of the Manufactory of Spoleto= arrested on June 16 1944 by partisans = Member of fascist party since 1927 and of republican party since Nov 43, was president of the dopolavoro of Spoleto (also during the Badoglio gov.) Category A No 12.

1. A High Commission for the Punishment of Fascists has been set up
under the presidency of a High Commissioner (Count Sforza)

2. The High Commission will order the arrest and trial of Italians
accused of Fascist crimes.

3. The procedure as far as arrests are concerned will be :

In Italian Government Territory

The High Commission will issue orders direct to the Questore.

In Military Government Territory

The High Commission will send to the Public Safety Sub-Commission
the warrant for arrest with a request that the Questore be authorised to make
the arrest and send the prisoner to a specified jail to await trial.

The Public Safety Sub-Commission will forward the documents
direct to the Regional Public Safety Officer concerned instructing him to
authorise the Questore to execute the warrant, provided the arrest is not
contrary to the interests of Allied Military Government.

4. Although for security reasons documents concerning the arrest
of Fascists on behalf of the Italian High Commission will pass direct from
Public Safety Sub-Commission to Regional Public Safety Officers, the latter
will keep Regional Commissioners informed of important cases in the normal
way.

TO : Admin. Sect. (for Public Safety Sub-Comm.)

1. Reference your ACC/L.754/PB of 7 July 44 it is pointed out that in this case the instructions were issued direct to the Questure bypassing the Regional Commissioner and his Public Safety Officer. Neither the Regional Commissioner nor his Public Safety Officer were informed until after the Questure referred the matter to them.

2. Regional Commissioners must be informed but this may be done through Regional Public Safety Officers.

3. It seems desirable that a letter should be issued by you to all Regional Public Safety Officers clarifying the procedure you propose to follow and we shall be glad if you will consider this. May a copy of any instructions issued by you be sent to this Section.

2. On 27th June, 1944, instructions for the arrest of Cesare ROSSI were given by the Public Safety Sub-Commission to the Regional Public Safety Officer Region 3. *Yes but only after signature of the RPSO*
3. For technical reasons it is not considered desirable that particulars of warrants of arrest should be sent except direct to the RPSO concerned.
4. It is the RPSO's duty to keep his Regional Commissioner informed of any important matter he has to handle.
5. The High Commissioner for the Punishment of Fascists has been instructed that when he wishes to effect the arrest of Fascists in Military Government territory he will communicate with the Public Safety Sub-Commission who will issue the necessary orders.

1. Reference your 332/CA dated 29 June 1944.
2. This is essentially a matter for Public Safety to deal with. I understand that it is being worked out the channels for these arrests along the lines suggested.
3. However, it does occur to me that as the Italian Government increasingly wants people in Military Government Territory arrested for trial under the Espionage Decree and brought to Italian Government Territory, some simpler plan of direct action might be devised as seems to be the case in arrests for ordinary crime where an alleged offender has escaped to Military Government Territory.

It will be noted that instructions were sent direct to the Questore and not to the Regional Commissioner. As the Regional Commissioner must know what is going on in his territory it is considered that such instructions should be sent to him and that the Italian Government should be informed of the channels. May we have your comments please?

2. The warrant of arrest was given under Art. 2 RUL 26 May 44, No. 134 and Art. 146 Codice Penale of 1889.

1. Reference is made to the attached communication, N. d1 Prot. 1011472, dated 22 June 1944 from the Questore of Naples regarding the arrest of Cesare ROSSI.
2. It would be appreciated if the position could be clarified as regards the correct channels of communication to be followed by the Italian Government in Salerno.
3. The following extract has been taken from our records:-

"Former chief secretary to the Minister of the Interior, a position which was given to him by Mussolini for his attachment and fidelity to Mussolini himself and to the Fascist Party generally. He was closely mixed up in the Fascist plot in 1924 against the Socialists in which MATTEOTTI was assassinated. Owing to the scandal caused by this killing, ROSSI was thrown out of the Ministry of the Interior and arrested. He escaped and revealed to the then 'free Press' the whole story of the killing, showing the part he himself had played. He was again arrested, this time between the Italo-Swiss frontier. He was first put in prison and later only interned. After his first escape, he was a fugitive in the house of the PISCITELLI family, in the Comune of ACEQUA, Province of NAPLES.

The Italian Supreme Command informs me that the Consul General Ezio Garibaldi has been arrested by the English Authorities.

I know, on the other hand, that a brother of his, Ricciotti, had established contact with the Allied Authorities.

I am anxious to tell you what I know regarding these two gentlemen:

1. Ricciotti - Apparently in disagreement with the fascist regime. He was in France, instead, as an agent of the fascist police who mainly reported activities of the antifascist refugees on French soil.

2. Ezio - Consul General of the Fascist militia. He was one of the most conspicuous exponents of the Party.

It would be well if both of them were to be put out of circulation and placed where they could do no harm.
