Thus, when the Phase II reinforcements are ordered away, there should be very little disorganization, the normal work of the provinces being carried on as usual.

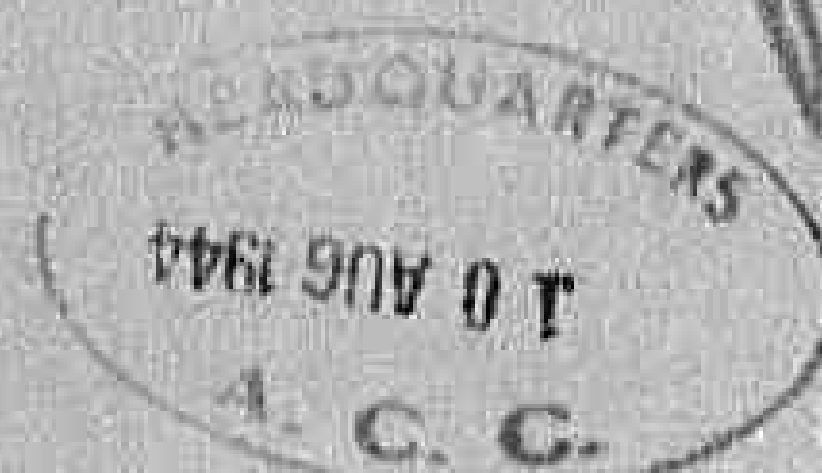

Reorganization Headquarters Region 4

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GENERAL ORDERS - Regional

Number 41

1. The following general administrative order, setting forth duties and administrative procedure for the Headquarters staff, is published for the information and guidance of all concerned.

The provisions of this directive cancel all previous regulations issued on this subject.

OFFICE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER - Lt. Col. Kenney.

The executive officer will co-ordinate the activities of all special staff sections and the administrative staff, which latter will consist of the adjutant's section and the headquarters commandant's section and the Regional supply section. The executive officer will review all reports and communications to and from the higher echelon and the instructions and communications to the provincial echelons. He will bring to the personal attention of the Regional Commander all important matters under his supervision.

ADMINISTRATION - Adjutant's Section - Capt. Mansueti, Adjutant.

The Adjutant will supervise work of personnel of all divisions of his office. He will receive and dispatch important telephone, cable and telegraphic communications. He will establish a message center and maintain region tickler in respect of administrative reports required on special dates in provinces. He will distribute personnel and those assigned to in accordance with requirements. He will be responsible for the issuing of all orders, publications and instructions.

Principal Assistant - WO Pasorella, Assistant Adjutant.

In charge of the personnel division.

He will maintain the personnel classification and service records of all American officers and men of the Region. He will have prepared the regional strength reports, record changes, transfers, etc., and will check ration returns. He will supervise typing and the checking of special and routine Regional reports required for higher echelon and the corresponding supervision of orders and instructions and indoctrination to lower echelon. He is immediately responsible to the adjutant for the work of his division.

OFFICE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURETHE EXECUTIVE OFFICER - Lt. Col. Fenney.

The executive officer will co-ordinate the activities of all special staff sections and the administrative staff, which latter will consist of the adjutant's section and the headquarters commandant's section and the Regional supply section. The executive officer will review all reports and communications to and from the higher echelon and the instructions and communications to the provincial echelons. He will bring to the personal attention of the Regional Commissioner all important matters under his supervision.

ADMINISTRATION - Adjutant's Section - Capt. Henseler, Adjutant.

The Adjutant will supervise work of personnel of all divisions of his office. He will receive and dispatch important telephone, cable and telegraphic communications. He will establish a message center and maintain section tickler in respect of administrative reports required on special dates. He will maintain roster of Region personnel and those assigned to provinces. He will distribute personnel assigned to his office in accordance with requirements. He will be responsible for the issuing of all orders, publications and instructions.

Principal Assistant - MO Pasarella, Assistant Adjutant.

In charge of the personnel division.

He will maintain the personnel classification and service records of all American officers and EM of the Region. He will have prepared the regional strength reports, record changes, transfers, etc., and will check ration returns. He will supervise typing and the checking of special and routine Regional reports required for higher echelon and the corresponding supervision of orders and instructions and endorsements to lower echelon. He is immediately responsible to the adjutant for the work of his division.

Assistant - MO Clark, chief clerk.

In charge of the correspondence, records and files and the mail division.

He will be directly in charge of the mail and message center division. He will receive, record and distribute all routine office mail received and will supervise the dispatch of the same; confidential and secret mail will be turned over to the executive officer as soon as received in the message center. He will supervise the preparation of all routine correspondence and will be directly in charge of the records and files division.

British Administration Officer - Capt. M. O. Riley.

The British Administration Officer is responsible to the Regional Commissioner through the Executive Officer on all matters pertaining to British personnel in the region in respect to instructions promulgated in A.U.I., C. A. O. 3, A.C. 1.1, Routine Orders and Area Orders, etc. and that such instructions are brought to the notice of officers and ORs by publication in the Daily Bulletin or by other means.

He is responsible for matters of Administration in respect of:

1. Discipline of ORs and trial within his power.
2. Courts of Inquiry etc. as ordered by Regional Commissioner or higher authority.
3. Officer Casualties, for publication in Part II Orders.
4. Claims and Allowances.
5. ORs pay, allotments and casualties.
6. Reports.
7. Correct registration and care of documents, returns and records of British personnel.
8. Clothing and equipment.

General Administration of the British Detachment will include ORs' welfare and amenities and will be carried out in co-operation with the Headquarters Commandant.

HEADQUARTERS COMMANDANT'S DIVISION - Lt. Colt., Capt. Mahoney.

He will command the Headquarters company and will be responsible for the quarters, messing, discipline and duty assignment of all men assigned or attached to his company. Discipline of ORs will be maintained through the British administration officer. The H. Commandant will supervise the administrative work and records of the company and will function as a billetting officer for Regional personnel when no billetting officer is functioning in place.

Transport Section - Capt. H. Galt., Lt. Houston, Transport Officer.

The Regional Transportation Officer will be responsible for the let and and echelon maintenance of all Regional Headquarters transport. He will set up a dispatch office, which will record status of all vehicles and trip movements. As far as practicable each driver will be assigned to a particular vehicle and will be responsible for the care, safe driving and protection of the vehicle when under his charge, on the road or in town, at halts or when parked outside of authorized parking areas. The CO will be responsible under the supervision of the Headquarters Commandant for the personnel assigned here and discipline of all ranks attached to his section. Discipline of ORs will be maintained through the British Administration Officer.

Messing Section - Capt. H. Galt., Lt. Houston, Messing Officer.

3. Officer Casualties, for publication in Part II Orders.
4. Claims and allowances.
5. Canteen, allotments and ex-gratia.
6. Correct registration and care of documents, returns and records of British personnel.
7. Clothing and equipment.

General Administration of the British Detachment will include the welfare and amenities and will be carried out in co-operation with the Headquarters Commandant.

HEADQUARTERS COMMANDANT'S DIVISION - Lt. Col., Capt. Mahoney.

He will command the Headquarters company and will be responsible for the quarters, messing, discipline and duty assignment of all men assigned or attached to his company. Discipline of the detachment will be maintained through the British administration officer. The HQ commandant will supervise the administrative work and records of the company and will function as a billeting officer for regional personnel when no billeting officer is functioning in place.

Transport Section - Asst. Lt. Col., Lt. Houston, Transport Officer.

The Regional Transportation Officer will be responsible for the 1st and 2nd echelon maintenance of all regional Headquarters transport. He will set up a dispatch office, which will record status of all vehicles and trip movements. As far as practicable each driver will be assigned to a particular vehicle and will be responsible for the care, safe driving and protection of the vehicle when under his charge, on the road or in town, at halts or when parked outside of authorized parking areas. The TO will be responsible under the supervision of the Headquarters Commandant for the personal appearance and discipline of all ranks attached to his section. Discipline of the detachment will be maintained through the British Administration Officer.

Messing Section - Asst. Lt. Col., Lt. Hall, Mess Officer.

The Regional Mess Officer will supervise the messes. He will draw and distribute rations for all messes in accord with ration returns and will make authorized market purchases when required. He will maintain the records of purchases and submit such accounts to the HQ for reimbursement. He will purchase and distribute mess equipment required and will be responsible through the HQ for the maintenance of the proper inventory of mess equipment.

MURRAY SECTION - Capt. Robinson, Supply Officer - B-4

The Regional Supply Officer will be responsible for the requisition and proper housing, care, disposition and record of all property, stores and equipment issued and authorized for the Region. He will regularly inspect the property for proper use, care and repair or replacement, and will report monthly on the status of the same to the Regional Commissioner. Regional property at provincial headquarters will be subject to inspection and processing by the Regional supply officer as outlined above and provincial supply officers will accordingly be called on for reports by the Provincial Commissioner.
