SUBJECT: Advice of Refugee Movement.

TO : Executive Commissioner

H.Q. A.C.C. Naples
for Refugee Sub-Commission.

1. I DISTRICT report the following circumstances:

- (a) On 27 May, information was received from H.Q. A.A.I. that approximately 1,000 refugees would be arriving at REGGIO on 31 May, and all necessary arrangements were made for their reception and onward journey to SYRACUSE on 1 and 2 June.
- (b) At 1000 hrs, 1 June 44, a message was received, through Movements channels, stating that the refugees in question were **NOT** coming to SICILY, but were to be accommodated at CALABRIA.
- (c) On receipt of this advise, all arrangements were cancelled, But within two hours, a further message was received stating that the refugees were, after all, for SICILY, and would be crossing the ferry on 2 and 3 June 1944.
- (d) As all this conflicting information emanated from A.C.C., will you please investigate, and advise this H.Q. of any information which you may be able to obtain, as a great deal of inconvenience was caused to all concerned.

2. In view of para 1d above it is requested that the inconvenience reported be drawn to the attention of those concerned. It is however appreciated that refugee movement must often be determined at very short notice.
