1. I feel that this file needs some explanation. Folio 22 states that Captain German had been selected and instructed to attend the third course of interior administration but had not at that date (12th May) reported for the course. On 18th May, Lt. Col. Kincaid wrote to the Executive Officer, Region 3 (Folio 26) saying that the Executive Commissioner wished to have a permanent Provincial Officer stationed on Capri so that Major Woodward could be relieved. It was planned that the new officer could conduct the courts and relieve the Legal Section of a considerable amount of work. It was then arranged over the telephone that Captain German, who was believed to be attending the course at Salerno, should be assigned immediately to this duty

2. Folio 30 states that it was discovered that Capt. German had meanwhile been posted elsewhere and was not aware of his selection for the course. It was therefore arranged that Capt. McNulty should be posted to Capri. In the meantime Capt. McNulty had been posted back to the US on special duty.

3. Civil Affairs Branch spoke to Colonel Kincaid on 3. June who stated that everything was going satisfactorily in Capri and that he did not think a relief necessary, having talked with Major Woodward on the matter, beyond the attendance of a judicial officer every three weeks.

Just prior to 27 April 1944, Brigadier Lush expressed a desire to have a permanent Provincial Officer stationed at Capri so that Major Woodward, AGO 2688 be relieved. It was planned that the new officer could conduct the courts and relieve the Legal Section, Province of Naples from considerable work.

At this time Brigadier Lush over the telephone in my presence arranged to have Captain German, who was then at Salerno, immediately assigned to this duty. This was done and after the conference, which you will recall, it was determined to have Captain German attend the third course in Interior Administration at HQ AGO Rear from 2 to 9 May 1944.

Captain German has never reported to this Headquarters and we assumed he had been attending the school.

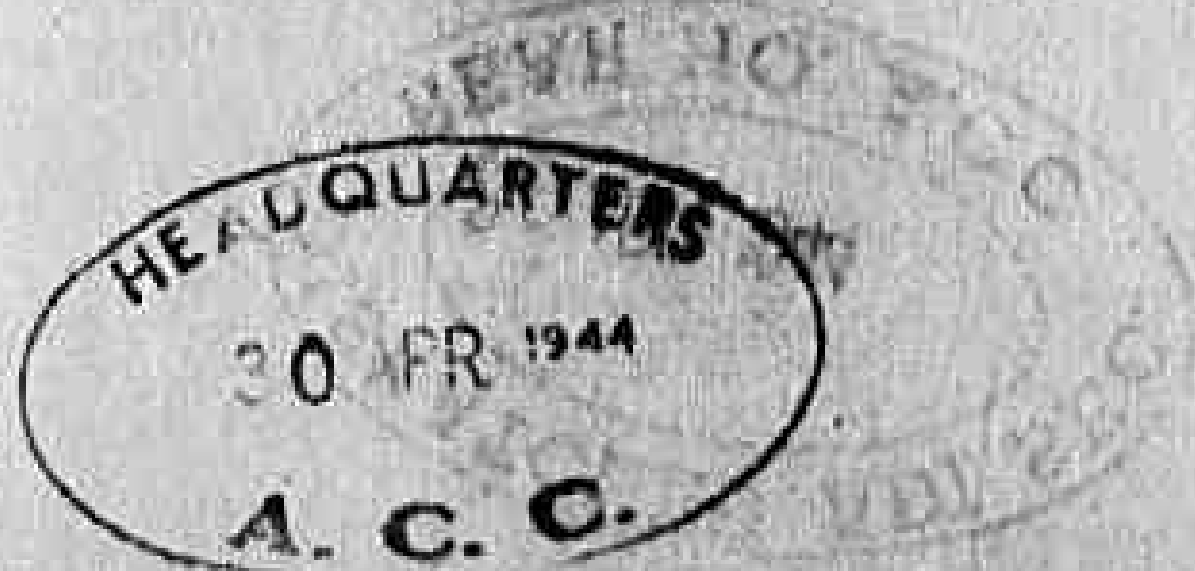

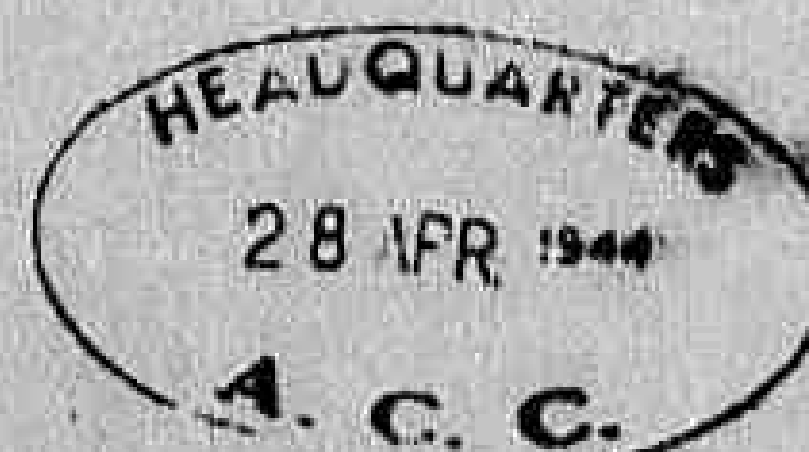

SUBJECT: Interior Sub-Commission Courses

TO : Vice President, Administrative Section

1. I wish to bring certain points, in regard to these courses, to your notice.

2. We are now approaching the end of our second course, and I can only say that the courses so far have apparently been followed and attended with great interest by the students who have expressed themselves accordingly.

3. To date, a total number of 20 have attended as students.

4. I am, however, beginning to find it difficult to obtain lecturers who can lecture with authority on the requisite subjects, and the lecturers who are repeating lectures are becoming tired of delivering them at too frequent intervals.

5. The syndicate working inbetween lectures, has been of value and considerable interest has been taken by syndicates in our files.

6. It is, however, right for me to report to you that I am finding the duration of these courses a strain both to myself and to my staff.

7. I am not able, in view of the responsibility of the course, to give to my real work as Director of the Interior Sub-Commission, that concentrated attention which I feel is essential.

8. This also applies to the members of my staff (from the small number now assigned to me, I am endeavouring to keep at least one officer permanently on tour).

9. Yesterday, I rang up the Executive Commissioner, Brigadier Iush, and put the aspect of the course position to him over the telephone, saying that a 7-day lag between courses was insufficient. He immediately agreed to a 14-day lag. This will alleviate the position in future courses, but does not, in fact, go far enough. There should be one course each month, in my judgement.

10. I feel, moreover, that courses should be cut down to 7 days, with a maximum of 3 hours lecture per diem. With a dwindling list of possible and enthusiastic lecturers, I hope to arrange an adequate program which should cover the

immediate problems of local government, but I would eliminate the background and confine the course to the ad hoc position.

11. Giving the students a day off, and allowing for their day of arrival and day of departure, the course would then cover 10 days in all, and I think and suggest that this should be the future arrangement. Each course to assemble on the 1st of the month.

12. A further point is that officers will not be away from their posts in the field possibly longer than they can be spared.

13. My suggestion, summarized, therefore, would mean: Report to the Executive Commissioner and arrival at Salerno, 1st day. 2nd to 5th day, inclusive, lectures and syndicate work. 6th day, off. 7th to 9th day, inclusive, lectures and syndicate work. 10th day, departure for stations.

14. I should be grateful if you would recommend my suggestion to the Executive Commissioner.
