1. In order to simplify regional organization under advisory conditions the Chief Commissioner has decided to divide Region II by detaching from it the compartmente of Calabria and placing it under a Regional Commissioner. The transfer will be effective 0001 hrs 23 April 1944.
2. Region II will thereafter consist of the Provinces of Lecce, Brindisi, Taranto, Matera, Potenza and Bari with Headquarters at IMRI.
3. The new Region which will be known as Region VII will consist of the three Provinces of Reggio, Cosenza and Catanzaro. The location of the new Headquarters will be notified in due course.
4. (a) Colonel Marshall will be Regional Commissioner for Region II.
(b) On transfer of Lt-Col. McCaffrey to EMOUSA, Col. Kirkwood will be Regional Commissioner Region VII.
(c) Colonel C. Findlay, D.S.O., will be Director of Displaced Persons Sub-Commission.
5. Instructions on transfer of personnel, transport and equipment will be issued later.
