SUBJECT: Location of Headquarters.

TO : A.F.H.Q., M.G.S.

1. Reference your MGS 312.4 of 1 May 1944. Regions at present partly established or under active planning are:

- Region IV - (Rome)
- Region V - (Abruzzi - Molise)
- Region VIII - (Tuscany)
- Region IX - (Emilia)

2. At present stage Regional Commissioners can only supply information as follows with respect to siting of their temporary and final Headquarters.

- I. Region IV (Rome): Advance Headquarters will follow as closely as possible the 5th & 8th Armies. In the event of a hold-up in taking over Rome, it is possible that Headquarters would be temporarily established at PROSINONE. No other intermediate points contemplated.
Present Location - NAPLES
Ultimate Location - ROME
- II. Region V (Abruzzi - Molise): Any intermediate move will be to ISTONIA (VASTO) on east coast. Should PESCARA fall very quickly, the temporary Headquarters would be established at PESCARA and not ISTONIA. As a secondary alternative, should events inland move more quickly with considerable delay and damage on east coast a second alternative would be SULMONA.
Present Location - CAMPORASSO.
Ultimate Location - ANCONA.
- III. Region VIII (Tuscany): First intermediate stopping point would be ROME, if progress northwards slow (say if static for two-three weeks), otherwise first stop at TARQUINIA. Second intermediate stop SIENA. Should invasion be seaborne, temporary established at ELBA, eventually as situation develops, LIVORNO.

Present Location - NAPLES (Nucleus)
Ultimate Location- FIRENZE.

IV Region IX (Emilia): First intermediate stopping place ROME; then, when possible, to RIMINI.

Present Location - NAPLES (Nucleus)
Ultimate Location- BOLOGNA.

3. It is, however, stressed that none of the above information can be regarded as definite, depending entirely upon the military situation prevailing at all times and places.

Subject : Proposed Region Headquarters.

1. In compliance with verbal request today for our proposed Regional Headquarters set-up, the following is our present plan:-

- (a) For present planning, and until ROME is occupied, to remain in NAPLES.
- (b) With ROME occupied, to open Regional Headquarters in ROME, and to remain in ROME until the military situation makes possible at least partial occupation of EMILIA, when Regional Headquarters would be opened in RIMINI, later opening in BOLOGNA when military situation permitted fuller occupation of the eight (8) Provinces in EMILIA, which is Region IX.



- 1/. Acting on instructions from you by the hand of Capt Baker I attach herewith brief notes on the proposed locations of Regional Headquarters (Region VIII, TUSCANY) upon a forward move of the Armies.
- 2/. It is to be understood that many combinations of circumstances may make the proposals outlined valueless and therefore only the most likely tactical situations are considered in making selections for Regional Headquarters.
- 3/. Such sites as selected are done in several cases without exact knowledge as to appropriateness of accommodation and are based more particularly as being preferable for ease of communications and availability.
- 4/. I will be at your disposal to discuss other arrangements in connection with Regional operations if such action is now appropriate.

REGION VIII (TUSCANY)

4th May 1944. (7)

Proposed sites for Regional Headquarters upon certain assumed military tactical situations.

1/. Military Situation. The present one (Sketch Map "A").

Regional Headquarters, Naples

Note:- If active preparation is premeditated the selection of a suitable Headquarters and a billeting location is needed. Space as taken by Region IV is estimated as about right.

2/. Military Situation (Sketch Map "B").

The enemy has been driven from the line GARIGLIANO - CASSINO - CASTEL SANGRO, etc., and has established a M.L.R. - ROME - AQUILA - SAN BENEDETTO, etc., with our Army control line ANZIO - AVEZZANO - PESCARA RIVER.

Regional Headquarters, Naples.

3/. Military Situation (Sketch Map "C").

Enemy M.L.R. CIVITEVACCHIA - VITERBO - TERNI - ANCONA, our Army control line - ARNONE RIVER - RISTI - TENNA RIVER .

Regional Headquarters. If a forward movement is not expected for 2 - 3 weeks or more - ROME - otherwise Naples but with a forward echelon at Rome.

4/. Military Situation (Sketch Map "D")

Enemy M.L.R. OMBRONE RIVER - BUONCONVENTO - AREZZO - RIMINI, our Army control line FIORA RIVER - CHIUSI - MAGIONE - CESANO RIVER.

Regional Headquarters, Tarquinia.

5/. Military Situation. (Sketch Map "E").

Enemy M.L.R. ORCINA - POGGIBONSI - BIBBIENA - RIMINI, our Army control line CORNIA RIVER - MASSA M - CASTELNUOVO - SANSEPOLCRO - METAURO RIVER.

Regional Headquarters, Tarquinia.

Note:- At this point, part of TUSCANY is South of the Army Control line. 2530

6/. Military Situation. (Sketch Map "F").

Enemy M.L.R. PISA - FIRENZE - RIMINI, our control line CECINA RIVER - VOLTERRA - POGGIBONSI - METAURO RIVER.

Regional Headquarters, Siena.

7/. Military Situation.

Enemy M.L.R. - GENOVA - THE APPENINES - RIMINI our control line SPEZIO - PISTOIA - FANO.

Regional Headquarters, Firenze. (Final Site).

8/. Military Situation (Sketch Map "A").

If the enemy vacates his present M.L.R. (GARIGLIANO RIVER - CASSINO - CASTEL SANGRO, etc., and reestablishes at The Appenines with our army control line inclusive of Firenze.

Regional Headquarters, Siena - with a move to Firenze as soon as possible.

9/. Military Situation (Sketch Map "A").

A seaborne invasion by our forces on the coast between LIVORNO and ORBITELLO.

Regional Headquarters, Elba - and eventually as the tactical situation develops - LIVORNO and then FIRENZE.
