HEALTH.

Generally speaking, the health of these people is very good. One of their own has been appointed Resident Physician by the Camp Commandant; he attends the medical needs of those within the Camp, and without.

Liaison has been established with medical authorities of the 59th. Evacuation (A) and 34th. Station (A) Hospitals, for medical as well as dental treatment.

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Necessary medicines and instruments have been obtained by the Camp Commandant to meet the immediate needs in the Camp.

CLOTHING:

Their civilian clothes are rather frayed. Salvaged U.S. Military uniforms have been obtained through the Quartermaster I.B.S. and are being substituted for civilian garb.

The women ~~are~~ definitely have a clothes problem; in this connection, liaison has been established with the American Red Cross authorities, who are presently waiting a shipment of clothes from the United States. Upon receipt of these clothes, they will be distributed equitably.

LAST NEWS OF FAMILY:

None have had any word for some three years.

FINANCIAL STATUS:

All are in need of financial aid.

FUTURE PROSPECTS:

Many are very sanguine about returning to their respective homelands.

A small number are desirous of going to Palestine or the United States.

MORALE:

Considering their past adversity, their morale could be considered as excellent.

ESTIMATE OF NUMBER OF JEWS LIVING PERMANENTLY IN REGION.

Approximately 25.

HOSPITALS:

There are no Jewish Hospitals in this Region, nor are there any other hospitals which cater to Jews. See reference to HEALTH ante.

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SYNAGOGUES:

There are no synagogues in this Region.

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POLITICS.

Jews in this Region are taking no interest whatever in Politics.

TRADE.

Jewish traders and businessmen are operating and conducting their businesses normally.

LOCAL GOVERNMENT POLITICS.

Jews are taking no part whatever in local politics.

ANTI SEMITISM.

There is no evidence whatever of any anti-semitism.

GENERAL COMMENTS.

There has never, at any time, been more than a mere handful of Jews in this Region; therefore, there has never been any problem concerning Jews.

The Internees and Displaced Persons Sub Commission has adequately provided medical attention, food, shelter, clothing and recreational facilities among other things for Jews.
