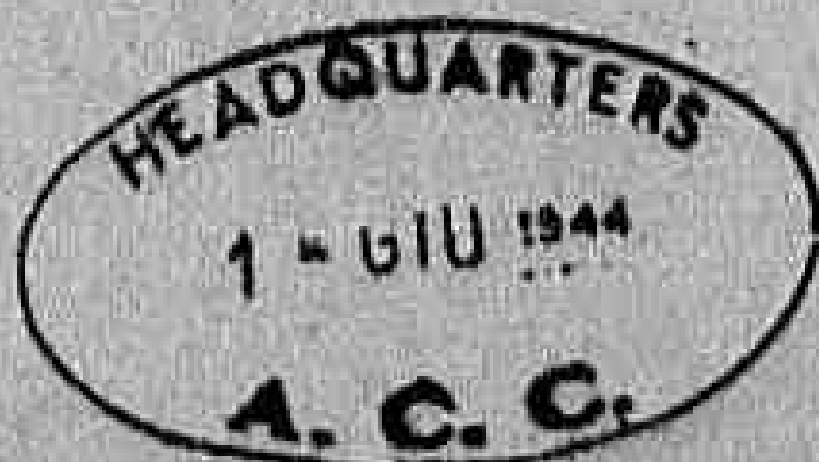

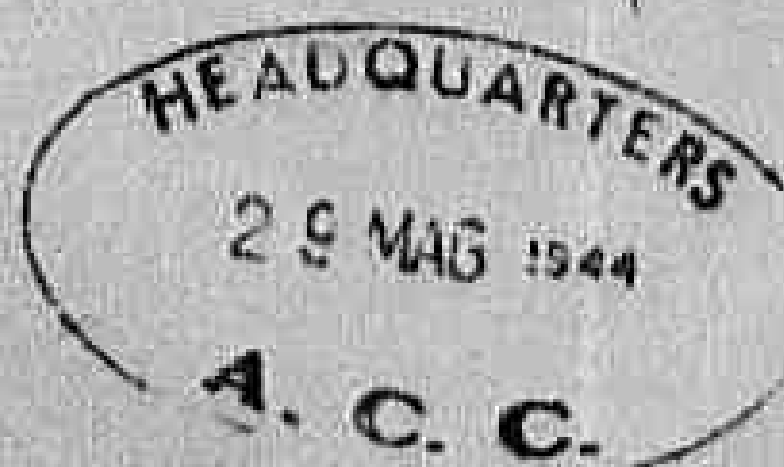

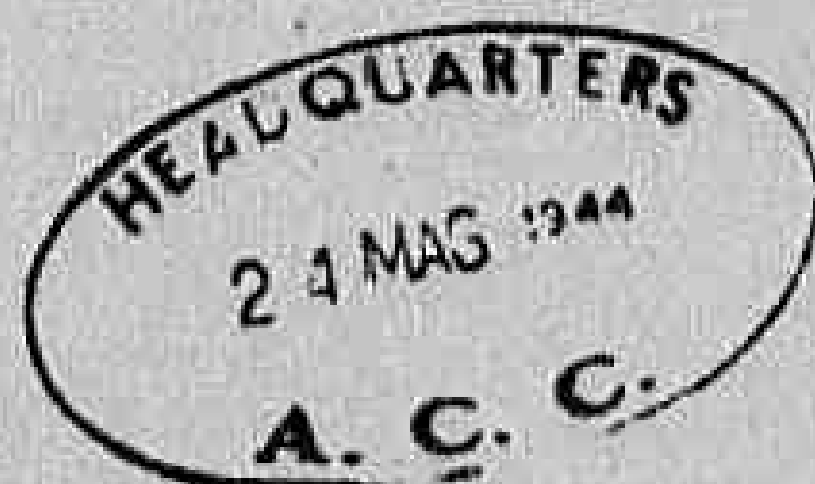

2. I hope it is understood that, after reporting to the Executive Commissioner at 1430 hours, officers should proceed to Salerno on the 5th June and report to the HQ Commandant at this HQ the same afternoon or evening so as to arrange their billeting, messing, etc., before the course begins.

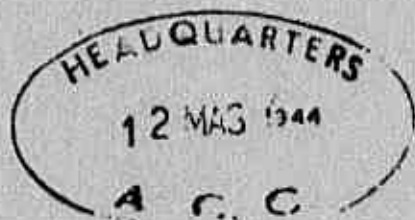
