



His duties would be to investigate for the Board the possibilities of rescue and relief for minority groups in enemy occupied territories in areas near Italy who are in imminent danger of death.

The representative proposed is is. John Lawler, now with the Pinance Sub-Commission. AFHQ, if permission is granted them, would like to make his HQ at BARI.

It appears that the reason for choosing BARI as HQ is because they think that the Resident representative of IGCR is also stationed at BARI. AFHQ point out this inaccuracy and ask whether you would prefer Mr. Lawler to be at HQ. A.C.C.

An early reply by cable is requested. I presume that you would _ prefer the representative to be stationed at HQ. A.C.C. and attach a draft reply.

SUBJECT: Presidents War Refugee Board -Special Representative for Italy

TO: H.G., Allied Control Commission (Attention: R.C. & M.G. Section)

Reference is made to our cable 60354 of 5 March.

1. The following is a paraphrase of a message received in this Headquarters from Civil Affairs Division, War Department, Washington, D.C., transmitted at the request of the Executive Director of the Presidents War Refugee Board.

Hull, Morgenthau and Stimson consider it necessary that Board appoint full time special representative without delay with Head-quarters in Bari. Representative would investigate for Board possibilities rescue and relief minority groups in enemy occupied territories in areas adjacent to Italy who are in imminent danger of death. Accordingly, it is requested permission be granted for this purpose. If permission granted contemplated that Board, with necessary approval, will appoint as representative John Lawler of United States Coastguards, now with Finance Sub-Commission, A.C.C.

Board informed that permission recently granted IGCR for appointment Resident Representative to Bari. Board considers it necessary send own representative to Bari and Sir Herbert Emerson, Director IGCR, concurs. The two representatives will work closely together on refugee problems."


2. In forwarding above message for submission to the Supreme Allied Commander for his decisions the War Department has made the following comments:

a. This representative would be granted United States diplomatic status.

b. He would be able to negotiate with enemy aliens to effect the rescue of refugees with full immunity from the United. States "Trading With The Enemy Act", and

c. He could delegate the authority and immunity in "b", to subordinates of his chosing.

3. It is requested that you will forward your views and comments on the foregoing in order that we may advise the Supreme Allied Commander. The inaccuracy of statement in para. I above regarding the appointment of the resident representative of the IGCR to Bari has been noted. In reply, it is requested that you will indicate whether you consider that the representative of the War Refugee Board should be appointed to Bari, or should be attached to your headquarters.

4. We should also be glad if you would let us know whether we are right in thinking,

a. That the Resident Representative of the IGCR is attached to Headquarters Allied Control Commission, and that you do not propose to attach him to the Displaced Persons Sub-Commission in Bari.

b. That representatives of the J.D.C. and the American and British Friends Societies whose appointments have been approved are also to be attached to Headquarters, Allied Control Commission for work in conjunction with the Resident Representative of the IGCR.

An early reply, by cable, would be appreciated.



EXECUTIVE ORDER CALLS UPON WAR DEPARTMENT AND OTHER DEEL RIMENTS OR AGENCIES OF THE GOVERNMENT TO ASSIST IN CARRYING OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THE ORDER.

FURTHER DETAILS NOT AVAILABLE THIS PRESENT DUT WE WILL DISCUSS MATTER WITH MALIN OF INTERGOVERNMENTAL REFUGEE COMMITTEE ON HIS RETURN ABOUT OHE FIVE SLANT TWO ZERO, AND INFORM YOU ADDITIONAL PARTICULARS AND DEVELOPMENTS WHEN WE ARE ABLE. AT THIS STAGE CAN ONLY DRAW YOUR ATTENTION TO ONE OBJECT OF THE BOARD AS STATED IN EXECUTIVE ORDER. THAT IS QUOTE TO RESCUE VICTIMS OF EMENY OFFRESSION". FROM DISCUSSIONS WITH SPECIAL REPRESENTATIVE APPOINTED TO NORTH AFRICA IT APPEARS THAT THE BOARD WILL BE CHIEFLY INTERESTED IN PACILITATING EXIT OF VICTORS OF OPPRESSION FROM ENEMY OR ENEMY OCCUPIED COUNTRIES, AND THAT ITS SECRET
