Subject: Regional Commissioner, Sicily, RTC 829.12 of
11th May 1944. - Lighthouse Service.

The whole matter of Lighthouses in Italy and maintenance of spare parts was brought to the notice of C. in C. Mediterranean on 10th March 1944 in which it was suggested that F.O.T.A.L.I. and F.O.W.I.T. should report which lighthouses they would require to maintain on their coasts and that he should take up the matter of supplies with A.F.H.Q. as there was little chance of any being available in Italy.

Paragraph 12 is therefore strongly concurred in and Regional Commissioner's letter will be forwarded to him for necessary action.
