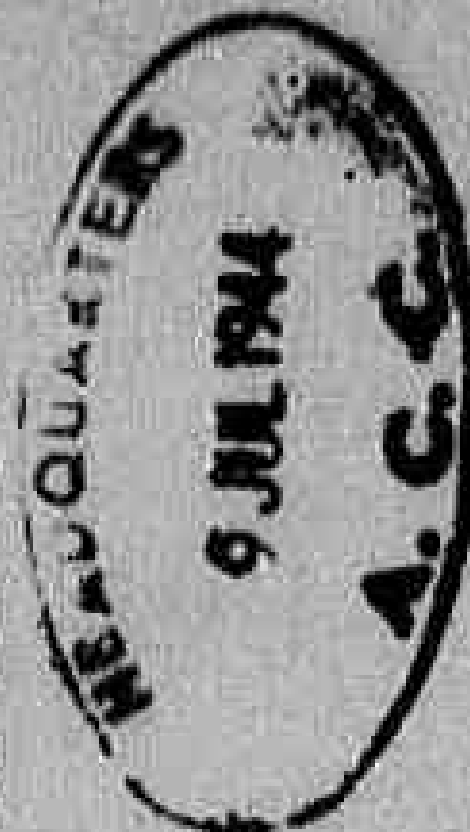

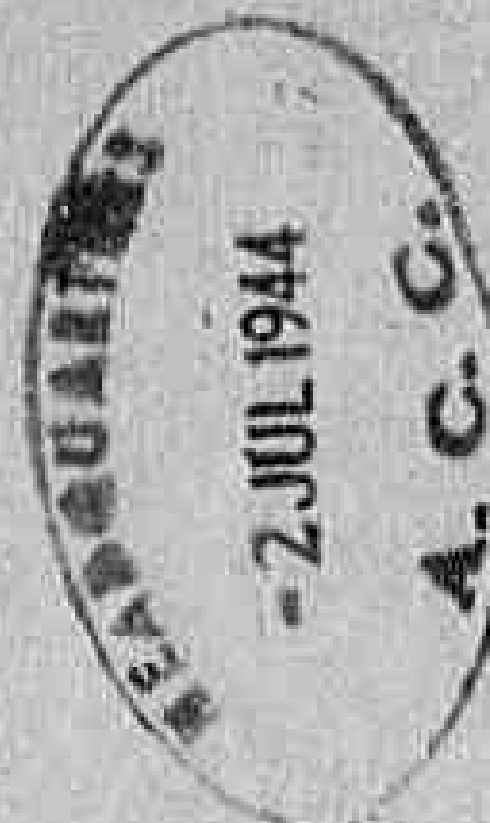

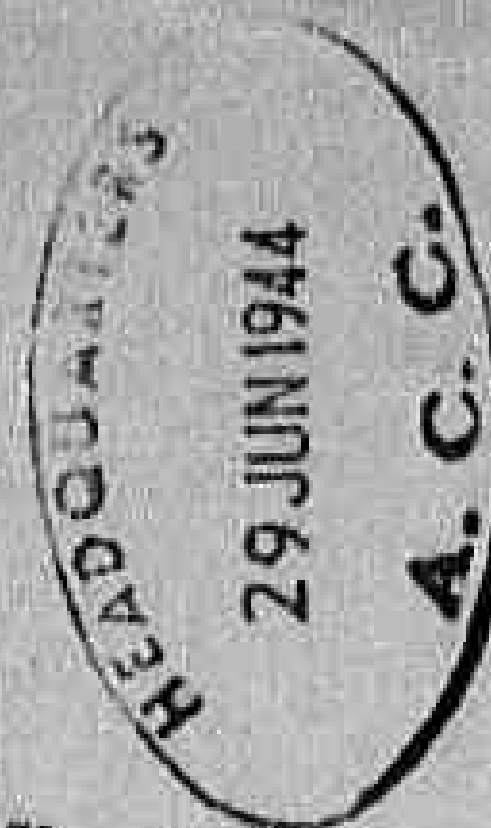

a) Partisan trainees (para 3(4)) these figures should be submitted by Z Military Mission, who are now responsible for them.

b) Should 'Displaced Persons other nationals' (paras 3(5) and 3(6)) be interpreted to mean 'Ex Internees of the Italian Government'?

c) If this interpretation is correct are figures required of these 'Ex internees by nationalities and by camp locations?

d) Again if this interpretation is correct it is submitted that all persons handled by the sub-commission other than Yugo-Slavs and 'Ex Internees' might be referred to as 'Displaced persons, other nationals' are figures required of these last by nationalities and camp locations?

SUBJECT: Displaced Persons - Yugoslav Refugees

TO : Headquarters, Allied Control Commission, APO 394.
(Attention: R.C. and M.G. Section)

Reference is made to a Sitrep as at 1200B 6 May by the Displaced Persons Sub-Commission, under their message reference 5228/32-1 of 12 May. *file 117*

1. It is particularly requested that the provisions of our memorandum MGS 383.7-2 of 25 April, especially as contained in para 3, may be complied with. Sitrep by the Displaced Persons Sub-Commission, to which reference is made above, omits to give details of the total number of Yugoslav Partisan refugees evacuated to Mideast up to the date of despatch of the cable, despite the assurance given in your 4160 of 2 May.

2. There would also be advantage from the viewpoint of this Headquarters if weekly Sitreps from the Displaced Persons Sub-Commission could adhere to a standard form. It will be seen from para 'A' of the Sitrep under reference that 576 refugees are shown as being in a camp at Castro, whereas previous reports have indicated that only Partisan trainees, who are not properly to be regarded as refugees, were held in that place. Similarly, 853 refugees are shown as being accommodated in the Ferramonti ex-Internee Camp, whereas previous reports confirm our understanding that the inmates of this camp are in fact ex-internees and are not to be confused with refugees. A further point is that under para 'D' of the same Sitrep Yugoslavs, classified by nationality, are given as 3,236, a figure which does not agree with any of the other figures for Yugoslavs elsewhere in the report.

3. Although the matter is one for your decision it is suggested that in the future these Sitreps might take the following form:

Para 1. Yugoslav Refugees (a) by camps (b) total held in camps.

Para 2. Yugoslav Refugees excluding above (a) in hospitals (b) total hospitalised.

- Para 5. Displaced Persons other nationals (a) by camps and with totals each camp, i.e., TC Bari, Ferramonti, and Palermo which heretofore omitted (b) total all camps.
- Para 6. Displaced Persons other nationals in hospitals (a) by hospitals (b) total.
- Para 7. Received during week (a) Yugoslavs by categories and gross total (b) other nationals similarly.
- Para 8. Gross total all establishments.
- Para 9. Evacuated during week (a) by nationalities (b) gross total Yugoslav Partisan refugees evacuated to date.

4. The problem of refugees in its ^{wider} aspects is now under consideration at this Headquarters. It is requested, therefore, that the matter may receive your early attention, and that the Sitrep as on 13 May and due for submission about 18 May should, if possible, take the revised form suggested. As the matter is of some urgency a copy of this memorandum is being forwarded direct to the Displaced Persons Sub-Commission, who will no doubt await your instructions before taking any action in this matter.

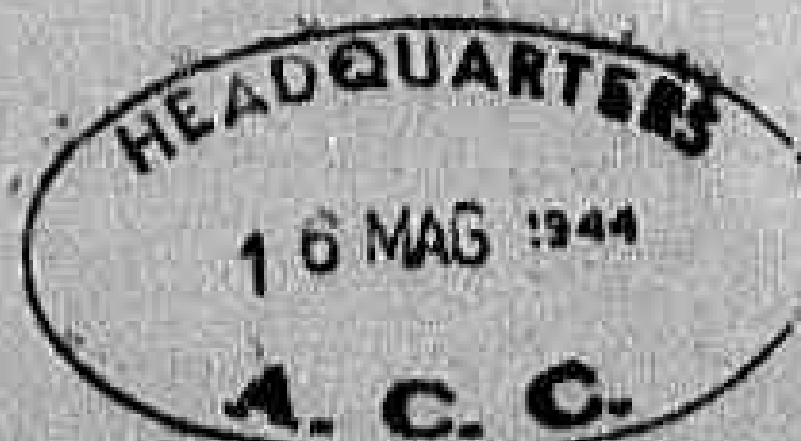
