It is in the nature of a District and presumably is given to the Air Force because of the airfields &c in the area.

The area is to be known as The Allied Air Force Area Command. It does not touch civil matters and I presume Region V have already made liaison with this Command. However I am forwarding all documents to Region V for their information.

Very wide powers are given some of which savour of C.A. matters and which I have no doubt the Commander will gladly pass to Region V in due course for action.

SUBJECT: Control of Foggia Enclave.

TO : Commanding Officer, Allied Air Force Area Command, APO 650,
U. S. Army.

THRU : Commanding General, AAF Service Command, MTO, APO 528, U. S. Army.

1. The ALLIED AIR FORCE AREA COMMAND is charged with the administration of the Foggia Enclave. (See attached tracing for area included in the Foggia Enclave), in matters which are a function of town and area rather than of unit or organization, with duties similar to those of a Communications Zone Base Section, except for the handling of supplies and services. It will operate under the general direction of A/FSC/MTO. This authority does not extend to control or jurisdiction of tactical units stationed within the Enclave.

2. Specifically, you will, with respect to the area:

a. Operate the town major system, procuring and assigning facilities and space, other than airdromes, to military units and personnel.

b. Exercise traffic and general disciplinary control in towns and cities and the area in general, and operate an area prison stockade.

c. Prescribe the passive air defense systems in towns and cities within the Enclave.

d. Coordinate general security measures and guard vital points in lines of communication except those specifically assigned to other agencies.

e. Supply civilian labor for military use.

f. Control resources and found-on-ground supplies available for military and/or civilians, subject to the directives of the Allied Force Local Resources (Italy) Board.

g. Prescribe and enforce the necessary sanitary regulations and hygienic measures in civilian communities and farm areas, and effect liaison between separate forces or commands, where overlapping interests exist as regards sanitation.

h. Control activities of service elements of the Italian Army and Italian Air Force under U. S. Command within the Enclave, other than combat operations.

3. You will maintain liaison with the British (Foggia) Garrison Commander, the cooperating agency. Your activities should be closely coordinated with AAF/MTO commands having troops in the area to the end that your primary function of service to these commands will be satisfactorily performed.

4. You may make request upon the Air Force Area Engineer (East Italy) for engineering advice and assistance. In case of emergency you may request assistance from the Twelfth and Fifteenth Air Force Headquarters.

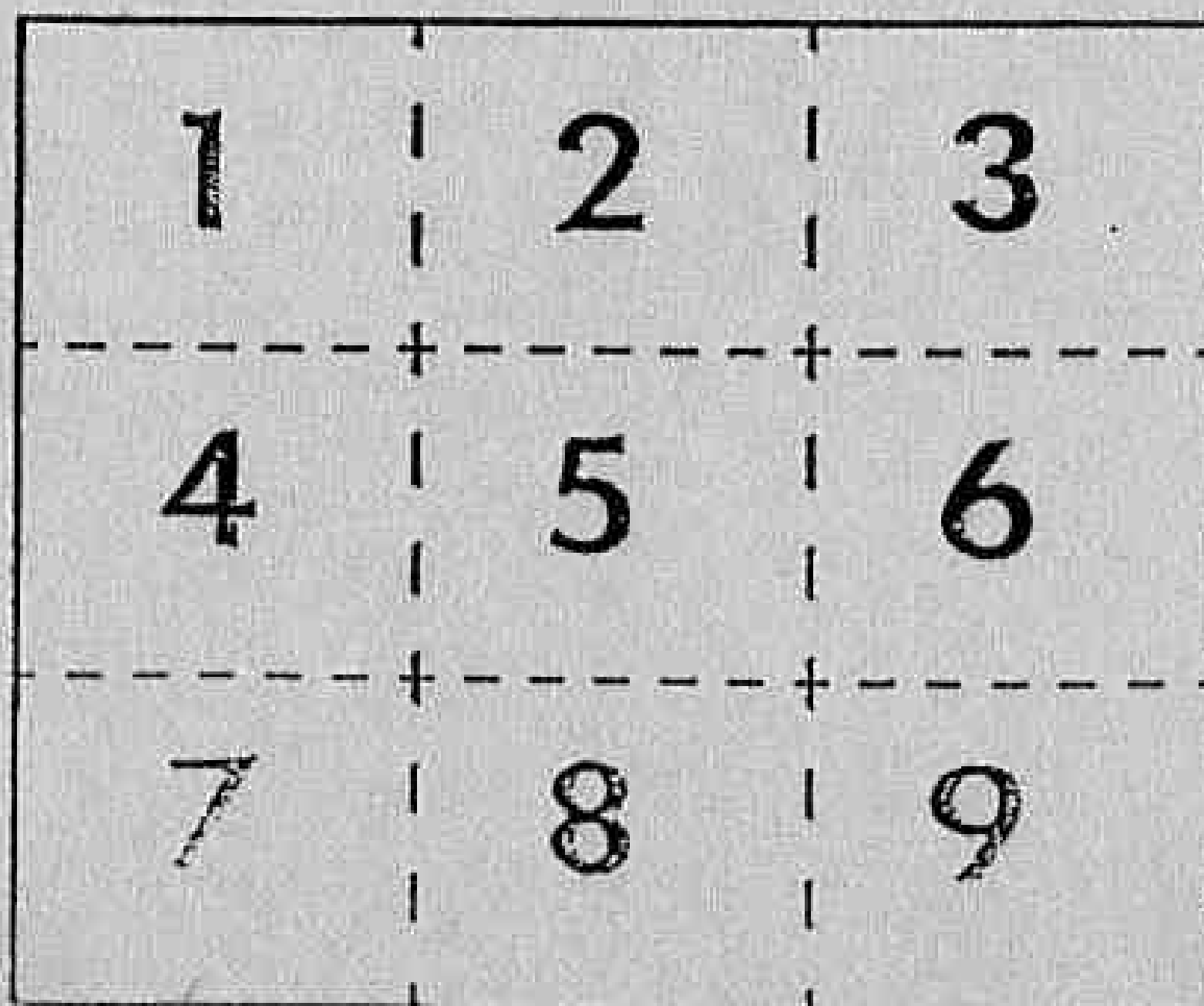
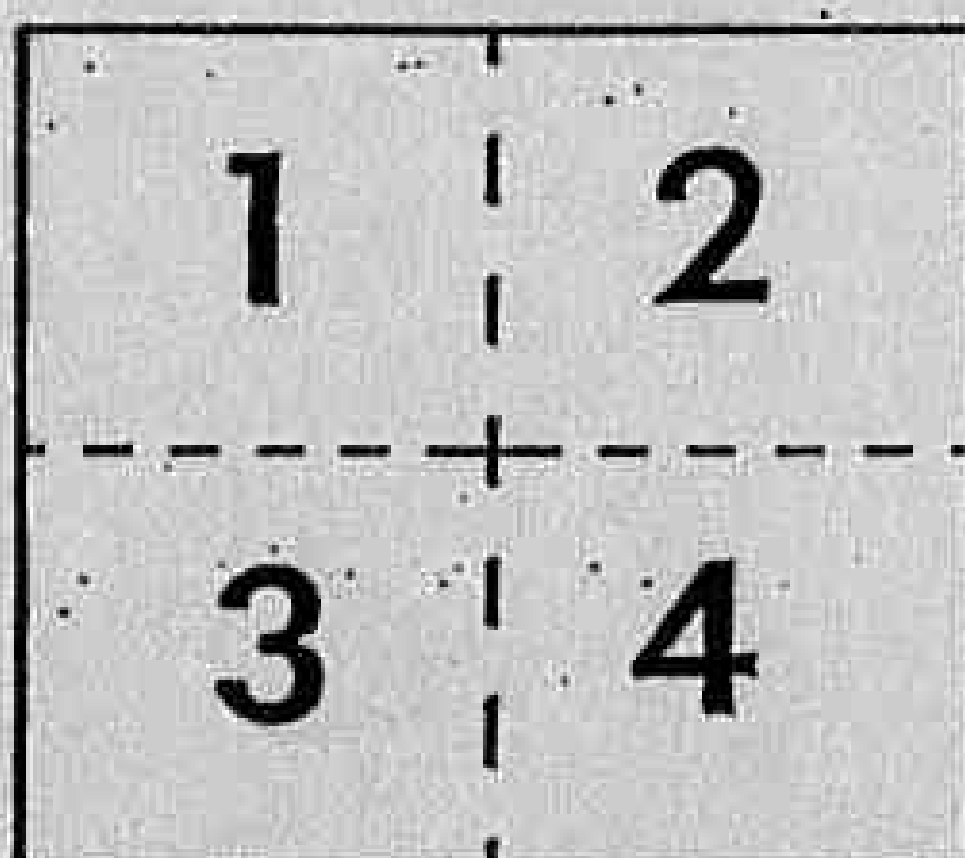

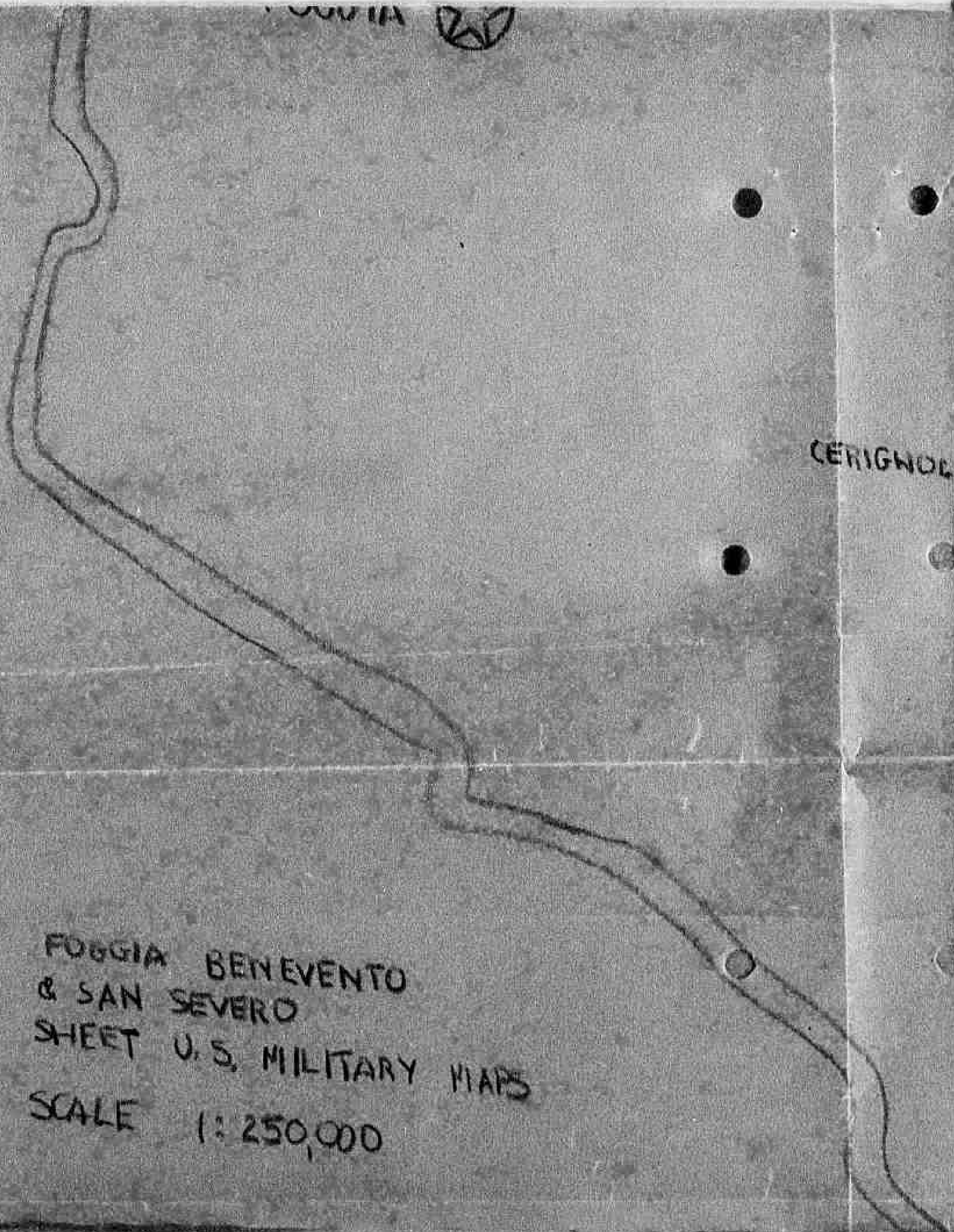
