At 11:45 hours on 29 August 1944, two of my officers (Captain Seguin and Lt. Bernard) saw, from where they were standing in Chieti, a large four engined American airplane crash some 4 or 5 miles away in the vicinity of Torrevecchia Teatino N.E. of Chieti.

Eight men were seen to bail out.

The plane crashed on to the property of Bobora Domenico and the following civilians were hurt.

Sbaralia Rocco
Sbaralia Maria
Sbaralia Melina
Costandina

It is quite probable that this will have been reported to you through the usual channels, but I am sending this information in case you have not been informed.
