SUBJECT: Report for February 1944,

TO : Economic Section:

- 1. Supervised the repair of transmission lines Frattamaggiore in- Z
- 2. Inspected transmission lines, substations and generating stations which have been damaged and made studies for their repair.
- 3. Placed orders for essential supplies required by the electric power system after screening. Expadited delivery where possible.
- 4. Studied the power supply for Rome and made plans for meeting the Rome power requirements.
- 5. Studied the possibility of rehabilitating the power systems of Italy by utilizing the equipment, material and lebor available in Italy, together with the minimum amount of imported supplies. Studies included the situation as it now exists, as it is estimated to be after the further advance of our armies and as it is estimated to be after the termination of the war in this theatre.
