SUBJECT: De-Fascistization.

TO: Allied Control Commission HQ.,
EC & MC Section.

1. With reference to your telegram 4748, June 3rd, 1944, I append herewith the latest information received from Provincial Commissioners in Region I.

2. CALTANISSETTA.

In Caltanissetta one meeting of the Provincial Commission was held on June 7th. Certain difficulties of interpretation of the December Decree were discussed and a letter was sent to the Government asking for clarification.

A reply has now come and the Commission is ready to meet again to examine about 20 cases for which the necessary information has already been obtained. The Vice-Prefect is however postponing further meetings of the Commission until the issue of a new Decree which is imminent.

3. CATANIA.

The committee to deal with defascistization of officials has been formed and has held its first meeting. It is too early yet to comment on its activities.

4. ENNA.

In Enna province the Provincial Commission for defascistization has examined 6 cases and last week the Prefect signed decrees dismissing from their posts all 8 persons involved; they are all communal officials.

5. MESSINA.

The Prefect of Messina Province has already formed a Pro-
 vincial Commission of 5 persons, to carry out the instructions of
 the new Italian Government in respect of removal of Fascists from office.

A few Municipal and Communal Officials have already been dis-
 missed and replaced by other suitable persons. A complete list of
 all officials in the Province has been prepared, and the above Commit-
 tee are now commencing to thoroughly check the records, characters and

past activities of all persons shown in the list, with a view to their retention in or removal from office.

The Prefect is taking a great interest in this matter and is adopting a firm and impartial attitude in spite of complaints received from persons removed and their friends.

6. PALESTINE AND TRAPANI.

In Palestine Province the members of this committee, constituted under Art. 3 of Royal Law Decree No. 29/3 of December 23, 1943, are as follows,-

1. The Prefect;
2. Dr. Carmelo LAUDANI, Sostituto Procuratore Generale;

The Commission has met twice, the second meeting having been held on 6th June 1944, to consider cases.

8. RAGUSA AND SIRACUSA.

The Defascistization Committee of the Provinces of Ragusa and Siracusa are functioning.

At Ragusa 10 employees have already been suspended, and the cases of 5 will be re-considered at the next sitting.

At Siracusa the cases of 14 Communal employees and 10 Provincial employees have been examined, and of these 8 and 9 respectively have been suspended. The remainder will be re-considered at next meeting.

With regard to teachers, the Provveditore agli Studi at

Ragusa has forwarded the names of 90 to the Ministry.

At Siracusa 30 have been suspended, and the names of a further 70 sent to the Ministry.

As a result of a meeting of the Committee at Ragusa on 1 June 1944, 5 employees of the Comune of Comiso were dismissed and a doctor was given back his job from which he had been dismissed by the Fascist party in May 1937.

I wish to point out that Prefects have received instructions from the Ministry to make reports on the 15th and 30th of each month.

It would therefore appear advisable that Provincial Commissioners should report at similar intervals. In any case with the time lag in obtaining delivery of papers from Provinces it is almost impossible to maintain up-to-date weekly reports.

Close contact is being maintained between this Headquarters and the Italian High Commissioner in connection with this subject. The latter has promised to furnish periodic progress reports which will be forwarded as received.
