- c) A list of the vital electrical plants in the region which AOC and the Italian government trust to be protected. Also included in this list are the valuable Montecatini plants in the area.
- d) A list of the important industrial plants of Region XII
- e) A summary of the agricultural problems pertaining to the flooding of the areas of the Po, Adige and Reno rivers.
- f) A list of candidates recommended for administrative jobs in the region.

3. This report has been compiled from the information collected at AOC headquarters in Rome; the sources of the information being Special Forces, OSS, GSDIC, AAI, PMS, AOC Sub-Commissions and the Italian Ministry of Public Works.

TOP SECRETREPORT NO 1REPORT ON PATRIOT ACTIVITIES IN REGION XII1. General

Region XII includes the districts of VENEZIA, VENEZIA, TRIESTE, ALTO ADIGE, FRIULI and ISTRIA. An area of approximately 20,000 square miles with a population (1942) of over 6,000,000 inhabitants. (Of this number less than 1,000,000 are non-Italians). The most densely populated area is found in South - eastern VENEZIA, (800 inhabitants per square mile). The two main industrial areas are:

1. VENEZIA and VENEZIA (textiles) and
2. TRIESTE (shipbuilding)

2. Politics

Politically the inhabitants of Region XII have not shown extremist tendencies. Before Fascism the Catholic Partito Popolare controlled the rural masses. Liberals were influential in the town. Communists are reported strong in the two industrial areas (see para 1). Conflicts arise more from differences in nationalities than from political differences.

3. Patriots

The Patriot Movement is the culmination of a twenty year struggle carried out by underground organizations during the Fascist regime. After July 25, 1943 these organizations came out into the open. Then with the re-establishment of the Fascist regime (Sept. 25, 1943) anti-Fascists and others who had shown sympathy for the allied cause went into hiding. In addition, many officers and soldiers of the Italian Army, who wished neither to join the new Fascist Army nor to be sent to Germany to work, also went into hiding when it became evident that the enemy intended to occupy the country for a short while.

Among those who went into hiding a minority was willing to carry on anti-Fascist and anti-German activities. Old anti-Fascist organizations absorbed many of these volunteers, and new groups were formed, mainly by former officers of the Italian Armed Forces. In the mountain districts members of the Anti-Fascist organizations usually established authority over bands except those formed by the army officers; the former have been given the name of GRUPPO D'AZIONE PATRIOTICA (GAP).

The Italian Patriot movement in Region XII does not include Eastern FRIULI and ISTRIA (where patriots are not numerous, and those existing have joined the Slovene or Croat patriots who recognize the leadership of TITO) or ALTO-ADIGE (where the population is mostly Austrian and there is no mass of Italian Patriot organizations).

WESTERN VENETIA

There appear to be the largest group of bands of the region. There may be as many as 10,000 people, including a number of refugees, disbanded soldiers and entire families from VIENNA. It is not known how many are Patriots. The Patriots occupy the area as far as GORIZIA and VENEZIA. It is reported that the PASUBIO Bands are in relation with Tito.

Between Val del Medini and Altimano di Pied (see 1008 PERCHIE) in the province of TREVISO the presence of 2,000 Patriots is reported, most of them disbanded soldiers of the Italian Army.

In the upper valley around MERANO, TRENTA, SELVA DI SOTTO the presence of fairly large numbers of some of the well organized disbanded soldiers of the Italian Army is reported. It appears that they are not con-

Between Val del Modina and Altipiano di Pina (NE) 1000
PACERNE) in the province of TREVISO the presence of 2,000 Patriots is reported, most of them disbanded soldiers of the Italian Army.

In the upper valley around CHIMMO, TREVISO, SALVA IN GUG-ATA the presence of fairly large numbers of more or less well organized disbanded soldiers of the Italian Army is reported. It appears that they are not controlled by able leaders and because of their lack of discipline, are disliked by the population.

C.A. 4,000 Patriots are reported in the area of TREVISO VITTORIO. (C.O. GELVI, GELVI, PRIMAVERA) Most of them are disbanded soldiers of the Italian Army.

C.A. Several thousand Patriots reported in this area.

C.A. 5,000 Patriots (military) C.A. CARABINIERI O.P.I. reports that on MONTE GRAPPA, after mop-up operations, there are only Germans.

These plants are placed under three priorities. First priority plants are those on which they should concentrate as they are most needed. Third priority are important plants, not as useful as first or second priority, but if they can be saved will be very helpful.

Notes about the Protection of the Electric
Plants of the "Three VENETIAS" (Proper VENETIA,
VENETIA JULIA and THE LINE VENETIA)

1. Hydroelectric Power Stations

Almost all hydroelectric Power Stations are located in the Alps belt and are embodying an important percentage of the Power installations in Northern Italy.

If the efficiency of some of these Power Stations should be secured (see attached list), the question of the power in Central Italy (owing to the numerous existing connections) could quickly improve.

From the point of view of the protection of the plants, the Valleys of the ISERO and ADIGE Rivers are to be considered particularly exposed to destructions, because it seems probable that the main withdrinal roads of the Germans will be these "Verona - Bolzano - Brenner Pass" and "Verona - Bolzano - Merano - Resia".

A stiff resistance, with heavy rearward actions and consequent destruction of roads, railways and industrial plants is expected.

Some noticeable hydroelectric plants, as those mentioned under No 21, - 25 - 26 - 27 - 30 - 34 - 35 - are in the vicinity of the roads the German troops will march along.

2. Thermal Power Stations

The Thermal Power Station of PORTO MARKESE (Venice) is especially interesting, as it can be supplied by sea. Therefore, the protection of this Power Station should be studied with particular care.

3. Transmission Stations

They are almost all exposed, for they are generally located in the vicinity of big towns or industry centres and are so important to justify any effort intended for their protection.

1. This report presents information which may be of value to the patriot's section in preventing damage to essential irrigation and drainage installations in the Po Valley and Northern Adriatic Section.
2. The following is a general outline of the types of problems which should receive special attention; to prevent damage from enemy action.
 - a) Rivers - The beds of several of the larger rivers are from 1 - 8 metres above the level of adjacent agriculture lands and important cities. For example: The Po river between Piacenza and the sea. The important towns of Piacenza and Parma are subject to flooding.
 - b) Land below sea level - Approximately 500,000 ha. of the coast intentionally buried land adjacent to the sea (sea construction (south of Ravenna) to Ortona (north of Trieste) in from 1/10 to 5 metres below sea level and may be subjected to flooding with salt water by a few well placed charges in dykes or embankments.
 - c) Pumps and canals - The major portion of the area is dependent on pumps and canals for drainage. Major pumping stations such as those at Milazzo, (near Naples) and Calicut-Panama are particularly important. These two stations for example drain approximately 80,000 hectares of land.
3. Protection of the types of installations and locations described above is vital since the area involved contains approximately 30% of the major food items produced in all Italy. Also several of the important towns of the area are subject to flooding, if river banks, dykes along the sea or pumping stations are destroyed.
4. The total area referred to specifically above is shown in colours on the attached map. The most critical points of rivers concerned are shown in dark blue. Reclaimed areas subject to flooding by salt water are coloured yellow. The balance of reclaimed areas which are endangered by enemy action are coloured light green. Areas not included in reclamation projects but subject to extreme danger from enemy action are coloured light red.
5. Detailed information on the three types of problems outlined in paragraph 2 is shown in subsections a) b) and c) copies of which are attached.

Installations in the Po Valley and Northern Adriatic Section.

2. The following is a general outline of the types of problems which should receive special attention; to prevent damage from enemy action.

3. Protection of the types of installations and locations described above is vital since the area involved produces approximately 30% of the major food items produced in all Italy. Also several of the important towns of the area are subject to flooding, if river banks, dykes along the sea or pumping stations are destroyed.
4. The total zone referred to specifically above is shown in colours on the attached map. The known critical points of rivers concerned are shown in dark blue. Reclaimed areas subject to flooding by salt water are coloured yellow. The balance of reclaimed areas which are endangered by enemy action are coloured light green. Areas not included in reclamation projects but subject to extreme danger from enemy action are coloured light red.

8. The Cristizis & Liberta Bdes.

These are usually offshoots of GARIBOLDI Bdes which have seceded because of their anti-communist sentiments. They are composed mainly of members of the Action Party. The rest are probably liberals, Right Wing Socialists, Syndicalists or Capitalists.

LOCATION OF PATRIOT BASES.

9. The disposition and strength of the bases is given at Appendix A. The information is the latest available at AOC HQ and will be amended as fresh information is acquired.

PERSONS SUITABLE FOR ADMINISTRATIVE POSTS.

10. The names of persons recommended for administrative posts are given by provinces at Appendix B. These lists are by no means complete, and further names will be issued shortly as an addendum to this report.

INDUSTRIAL PLANTS TO BE PRESERVED.

11. In nearly every case the industries are dependent on electrical power. The preservation of electric power plants is, therefore, of primary importance. The principle power plants are outside EMILIA, but for ready reference are given at Appx. C. At Appx. D is a list of the principle industrial plants in the region.

AREAS LIABLE TO FLOODING.

12. The biggest danger to the civilian life of the region lies in the possibility that the enemy may flood large areas of the PO Valley. A report on these areas together with a map is attached as Appx. E.

Extracts from AOC Agriculture Sub-Commission Report
of 22 Aug 44

Subject : Critical Land Reclamation areas and installations.

1. This report presents information which may be of value to the patriots section in preventing drainage to essential irrigation and drainage installations in the Po Valley and Northern Adriatic Section.
2. The following is a general outline of the types of problems which should receive special attention to prevent damage from enemy action.

(a) Rivers

The beds of several of the larger rivers are from 1 and 8 meters above the level of adjacent agriculture lands and important cities.

For example : the Po river between PIAC ZA and the sea. The important towns of PIACENZA and VERCELLI are subject to flooding.

(b) Lands below sea level

Approximately 500,000 ha. of the most intensively farmed land adjacent to the sea from CESP= NATION (mouth of ALVERA) to GRADO (north of TRIESTE) is from 3/10 to 5 meters below sea level and may be subjected to flooding with salt water by a low well placed charges in dykes or embankments.

(c) Pumps and motors

Subject : Critical Land Reclamation areas and Installations.

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The beds of several of the larger rivers are from 1 and 5 meters above the level of adjacent agriculture lands and important cities.

For example : the Po river between PIAZZA and the sea. The important towns of PIAZZA and PIAZZA are subject to flooding.

(b) Lands below sea level

Approximately 500,000 ha. of the most intensively farmed land adjacent to the sea from GALLARATE (south of RAVENNA) to GALLARATE (north of TRIVIGLIO) is from 2/10 to 5 meters below sea level and may be subjected to flooding with salt water by a low well placed charges in dykes or embankments.

(c) Pumps and motors

The major portion of the area is dependent on pumps and motors for drainage. Major pumping stations such as those at PIAZZA (near MODENA) and GALLARATE (near PIAZZA) are particularly important. These two stations for example drain approximately 20,000 hectares of land.

3. Protection of the types of installations and installations described above is vital since the area involved produces approximately 30% of the major food items produced in all Italy. Also several of the important towns of the area are subject to flooding, if river banks, dykes along the sea or pumping stations are destroyed.

4. The total zone referred to specifically above is shown in colours on the attached map. The known critical points or rivers concerned are shown in dark blue. No claimed areas subject to flooding by salt water are coloured yellow. The balance of reclaimed areas which are endangered by enemy action are coloured light green. Areas not included in reclamation projects but subject to extreme danger from enemy action are coloured light red.

5. Detailed information of the three types of problems outlined in paragraph 3 is shown in Appendices 1, 2 and 3 copies of which are attached. Additional information will be submitted as available to supplement these appendices.
