Extract of Report on Electrical Plants of Region  
XII on which priority should concentrate your  
efforts to prevent destruction.

In order to assist the patrols a list of electric power plants to be taken first in their efforts to prevent destruction. These plants are placed under three priorities. First priority plants are those on which they should concentrate as they are most needed. Second priority are those plants which should also be protected, if at all possible, as they too are very important. Third priority are largest plants, not as useful as first or second priority, but if they can be saved will be very helpful.

Notes about the Protection of the Electric  
Plants of the "Three VENETI'S" (Prator /ZUCCA,  
VENETIA JUNA and THE TINS VENETIA)

1. Hydroelectric Power Stations

Almost all hydroelectric Power Stations are located in the Alpine  
belt and are embodying an important percentage of the Power installations  
in Northern Italy.

If the efficiency of some of these Power Stations would be secured  
(see attached List), the question of the power in Central Italy (order to  
the numerous existing connections) could quickly improve.

From the point of view of the protection of the plants, the Valleys  
of the IS-BOO and ADDA Rivers are to be considered particularly crossed  
to destructions, because it seems probable that the main withdrawal roads  
of the Germans will be those "Verona - Bolzano - Brenner Pass" and  
"Verona - Bolzano - Merano - Bozca".

A set of resistance, with heavy guard actions and consequent  
destruction of roads, railways and industrial plants is expected.

Some noticeable hydroelectric plants, as those mentioned under  
No 21, - 25, - 26, - 27, - 30, - 34, - 35 - are in the vicinity of the roads  
the German troops will march along.

2. Thermal Power Stations

The Thermal Power Station of PO DO MAGRETO (Venice) is especially  
interesting, as it can be supplied by sea. Therefore, the protection of  
this Power Station should be studied with particular care.

3. Floating Stations

They are almost all exposed, for they are generally located in the 100'z  
vicinity of big towns or industry centres and are so important to justify  
any effort intended for their protection.

Subject : Civilian Land Regulation areas and installations.

1. This report presents information which may be of value to the government's Section in preventing damage to essential installations and buildings installations in the Do Valley and Northern Iberian Section.
2. The following is a general outline of the types of problems which should receive special attention to prevent damage from enemy action.

(a) Rivers

The body of water of the larger rivers are some 1,000 kilometers above the level of adjacent mountains in the sea. The important towns of Potosi, Chuquisaca, and Sucre, are subject to flooding.

(b) Bridges

Approximately 500,000 ha. of the total land area of the District (much of Potosi to Chuquisaca) is from 2,100 to 5,000 meters below sea level, and nearly all major roads connect with passes or mountain roads.

(c) Paths and motors

This report presents information which may be of value to the Director General in preparing a report to represent the situation during consultations in the World Conference on Environment.

2. The following is a general outline of the types of problems which should receive special attention to prevent damage to the environment during installations in the

The lands of several of the larger rivers are prone to flooding and above the level of adjacent settlements are large and important areas. For example : the river between 27.0 and 27.5 km from the sea. The highest tides of 2.50 and 2.70 m. are subject to flooding.

(b) Flood below sea level

Approximately 500,000 ha. of the most intensively farmed land adjacent to the sea are situated (south of Huize) to the DO (North of Muntfort) from 2.40 to 5 meters below sea level and may be subjected to flooding with salt water if a low wall placed across the loss of embankments.

(c) Dams and reservoirs

The major portion of the area is dependent on pumps and motors for drainage. Major pumping stations such as those at TILBURG (near Nootdorp) and CODDINGEN (near Dordrecht) are particularly important. These two stations for example drain approximately 20,000 hectare of land.

3. Protection of all types of installations and installations described above is vital since the areas involved produce approximately 30% of the major food items produced in all Italy. Also several of the important towns of the area are subject to flooding. If river banks, dykes along the sea or pumping stations are destroyed.

4. The total zone referred to specifically above is shown in colours on the attached map. The known coastal points or rivers concerned are shown in dark blue. Residential areas subject to flooding by salt water are coloured yellow. The balance of residential areas which are endangered by enemy action are coloured light green. Areas not included in reclamation projects but subject to extreme danger from enemy action are coloured light red.

5. Detailed information of the three types of produce outlined in paragraph 3 is shown in appendices 1, 2 and 3 copies of which are attached. Additional information will be submitted as available to supplement these appendices.
