If the area is in our hands soon, (as appears likely) an area including the Eastern end of ALVEO DEL IAGO DI FUCINO, East of AVEZZANO and hills near it will be required as a calibrating and training artillery range.

1. 10 A.G.R.A. is being constituted as a reserve and training A.G.R.A. for R.A. units held out of the line in A.A.I. reserve. I am also making arrangements for them to run a calibration and practice range, with the assistance as necessary of the EIGHTH Army R.A. Training Team.

- 2. The present location of 10 A.C.R.A. in the KBOLI area has now become too far in rear of Armies for their task to be carried out efficiently, and I am therefore looking for a suitable area behind KIGHTH Army, to which units can be pulled back without inordinately long moves. Extensive range organisations are not required; what is wanted is somewhere that a flat range is available for calibration purposes, with rather more broken ground available for normal shooting practice.
- There is nowhere that meets this requirement in the area so far cocupied. EIGHTH Army, should, however, shortly have over-run an area which appears from the map to be highly suitable. This is the ALVEO DEL LAGO DI FUCINO, a drained lake bed just East of AVEZZANO (G. 5280). The East end of this bed appears to be less highly populated than the rest and would be a suitable target area, while the hills on either side would be available for the other ranges.
- 4. I shall be grateful if you will note our requirement for this area, so that we may take it over and get the ranges going as soon as possible after capture.
