SUBJECT: Establishment of Greek Consular Agents in Italy.

Upon receipt of letter MEM: 001.110-1 of 5 May 1944 the Greek Representative to the Advisory Council for Italy was informed that the Supreme Allied Commander had agreed to the establishment of Greek Governmental Agents who would perform the functions of a Consul in Bari and Palermo, and later in Naples also.

2. A communication has now been received from the Greek Delegation stating that the below mentioned persons of the staff of this Delegation have been appointed as their governmental agents in Italy:

M. Georges Calcutais, Secretary of Legation, is expected to arrive in Italy in about a fortnight to fill the office of Governmental Agent in Bari;

Captain Nicholas Michas, already in Naples (Piazza della Borsa No. 14, Apartment 22, Telephone 03018) is to fill provisionally the same office in that town.

The Plenipotentiary Representation of the U.S.S.R. to the Advisory Council for Italy has the honour to inform you about the following changes and new appointments in the Soviet Representations to the Advisory Council for Italy, and to the Allied Control Commission, made by decisions of the Government of the U.S.S.R.

1. Ambassador N. Andrei VISHINSKY, the Vice-President of the Council of the People's Commissars of the U.S.S.R., and the Deputy of the People's Commissar for Foreign Affairs of the U.S.S.R., is relieved from the duties of the Plenipotentiary Representative of the U.S.S.R. to the Advisory Council for Italy.

2. Ambassador M. Alexander E. BOGOMOLOV is appointed the Plenipotentiary Representative of the U.S.S.R. to the Advisory Council for Italy.

3. Major-General A. F. VASILIEV, the Expert for Military Affairs of the Plenipotentiary Representation of the U.S.S.R. to the Advisory Council for Italy, is appointed the deputy of the Plenipotentiary Representative of the U.S.S.R. on the Advisory Council for Italy.

4. Major-General SOLODOVNIK M. S. is relieved from the duties of the Soviet representative on the Allied Control Commission.

5. Major-General SUSLOPAROV is appointed the Representative of the U.S.S.R. on the Allied Control Commission.
