1. 1. You will prepare and submit to this Headquarters not later than 1 Sept. 1944 a nominal roll of the officers to remain in your Region under the allotment given in Appendix "C" letter this Headquarters 22 June 1944, subject "Future Planning Regional Strengths". For your information, the numbers are as given in the attached extract. C.A.O.s include all Regional and Provincial Headquarters officers who are not Sub-Commission officers.

2. All other officers of your Region not included on the above nominal roll will be earmarked for the northern Regions. They will be moved only when it becomes necessary to fill-up the northern Regions - in other words when the need is greater there than in areas which have been earlier liberated. This may be in the very near future and Regions must be prepared to lose experienced officers.

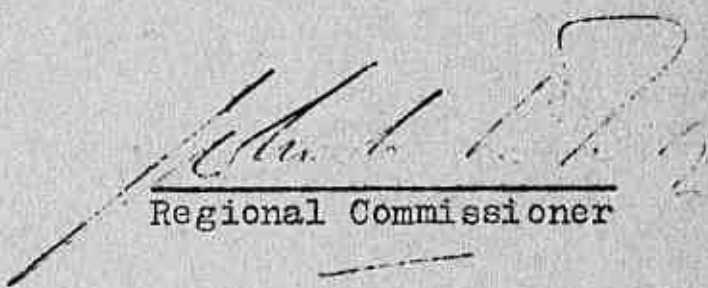

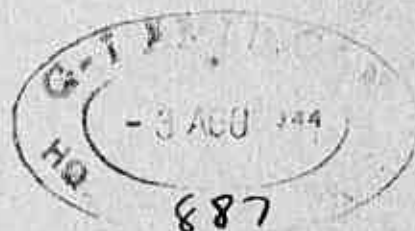
