SUBJECT: Reduction of Regions to Appendix "C" Strength.

TO : Regional Commissioner Region IV
" " " VIII

1. You will prepare and submit to this Headquarters not later than 1 Sept. 1944 a nominal roll of the officers to remain in your Region under the allotment given in Appendix "C" letter this Headquarters 22 June 1944, subject "Future Planning Regional Strengths". For your information, the numbers are as given in the attached extract. C.A.O.s include all Regional and Provincial Headquarters officers who are not Sub-Commission officers.

2. All other officers of your Region not included on the above nominal roll will be earmarked for the northern Regions. They will be moved only when it becomes necessary to fill-up the northern Regions - in other words when the need is greater there than in areas which have been earlier liberated. This may be in the very near future and Regions must be prepared to lose experienced officers.

3. Re-enforcing officers, if and when they become available, will be posted to your Region to re-enforce your Appendix "C" strength in numbers dependent on your needs and the total number of officers received.

4. Regional Commissioners know our personnel problem and your earnest co-operation is requested in making available a fair cross section of your officers for the important Regions in the north.

My dear Kirkwood:

I just returned from a conference in Naples to find your letter with reference to additional passenger carrying vehicles. I have issued orders to G-4 to find five somewhere and get them up to you as soon as possible.

I also found your cable with reference to Supply Officers and have sent a recommendation to the Food Sub-Commission that they get you Major Sykes, Lt. Denning and Lt. Button or at least two of them up from Region VII if they have no others to send you. Major Durham is still sick in the hospital here. I will keep on the trail of Supply Officers for you and get them up as soon as possible.

Reference the stenographer for Hale. Stearns tells me that he has already left for your Headquarters. Stearns is also clearing a clerk-typist for you and will get him up within a couple of days. I am giving him orders that you are to get priority on some enlisted help.

We have had a good break in getting down to our officer strength and I am on the hunt for qualified motor maintenance officers. If we can find any in Replacement Centers or surplus in any organization, we may be able to help you out along that line shortly.

SUBJECT: Motor transport

TO : Executive Commissioner, Hq. AOC

1. The situation on motor transport in this Region is becoming increasingly critical. Six provincial teams are operating under Army AMG, and in only three of them are the Provinces completely in Allied hands. In addition the Fifth Army have asked to have two of the three remaining Provinces ready to move on 24 hours notice, complete in vehicles and personnel.

2. With the usual number of vehicles undergoing repair, there are only 8 motor vehicles available for 24 officers at Region Headquarters. Today, I have requests for 4 of these vehicles for the use of Region Headquarters officers who are going into Florence, either with the spearhead or within 48 hours of the fall of the city. They certainly need transport to do their work. I cannot furnish these vehicles without immobilizing a large part of my headquarters personnel. Sitting in Headquarters they are of no use at all. I have already reduced the initial allotment of transport to the five southern provinces, although two of them are not completely occupied.

3. Request that at least 5 additional passenger carrying vehicles, -- jeeps, PU's, Weapons Carriers, or 15 CWT's -- be furnished this Region until all the provinces of this Region are administered by Provincial Commissioners, so that they may have opportunity to obtain civilian cars.

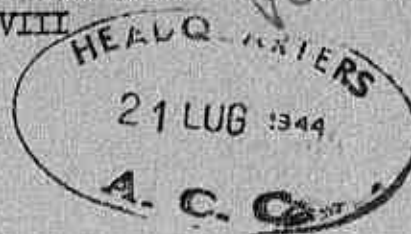

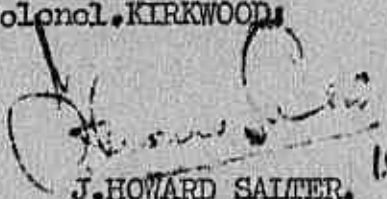
