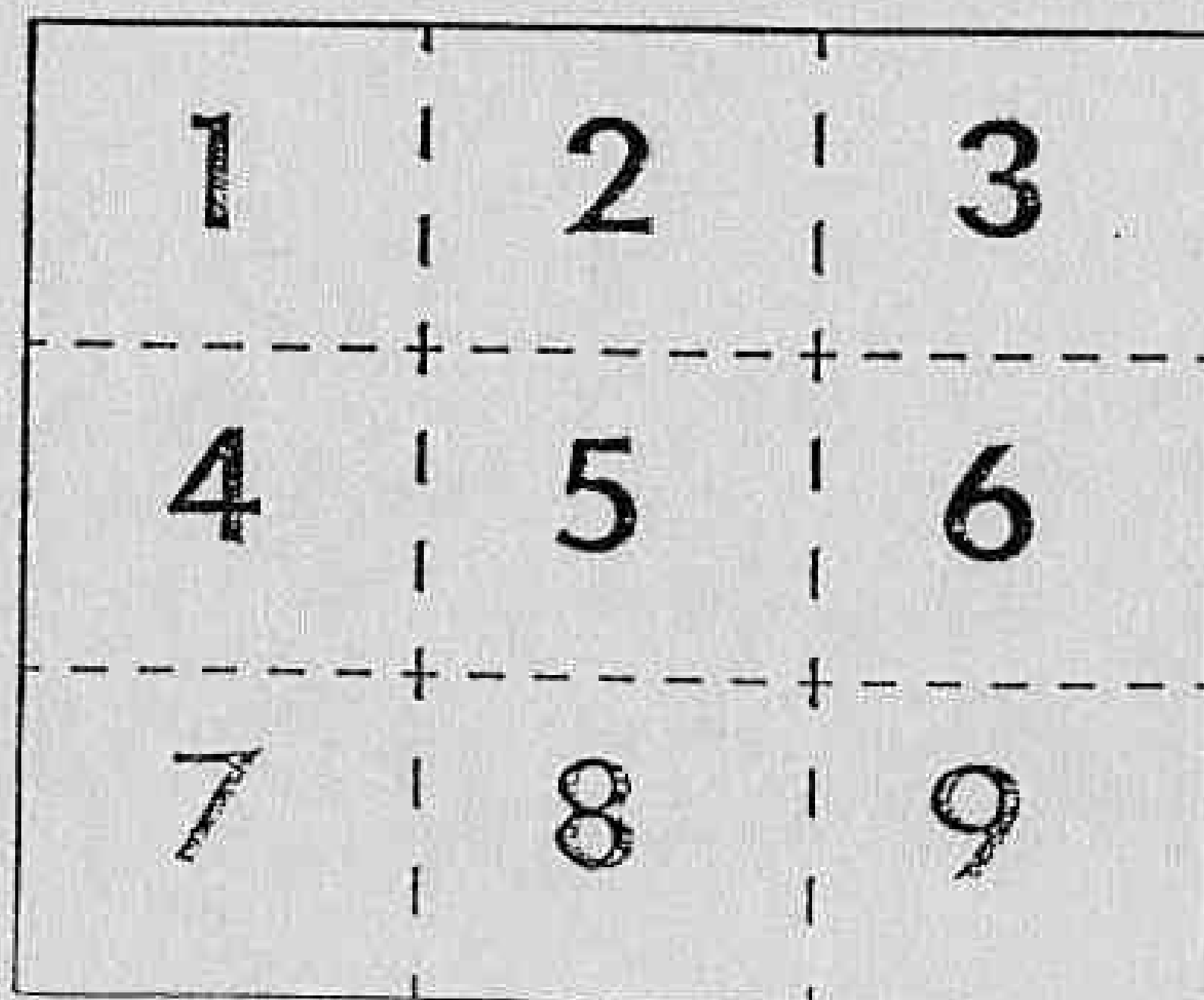
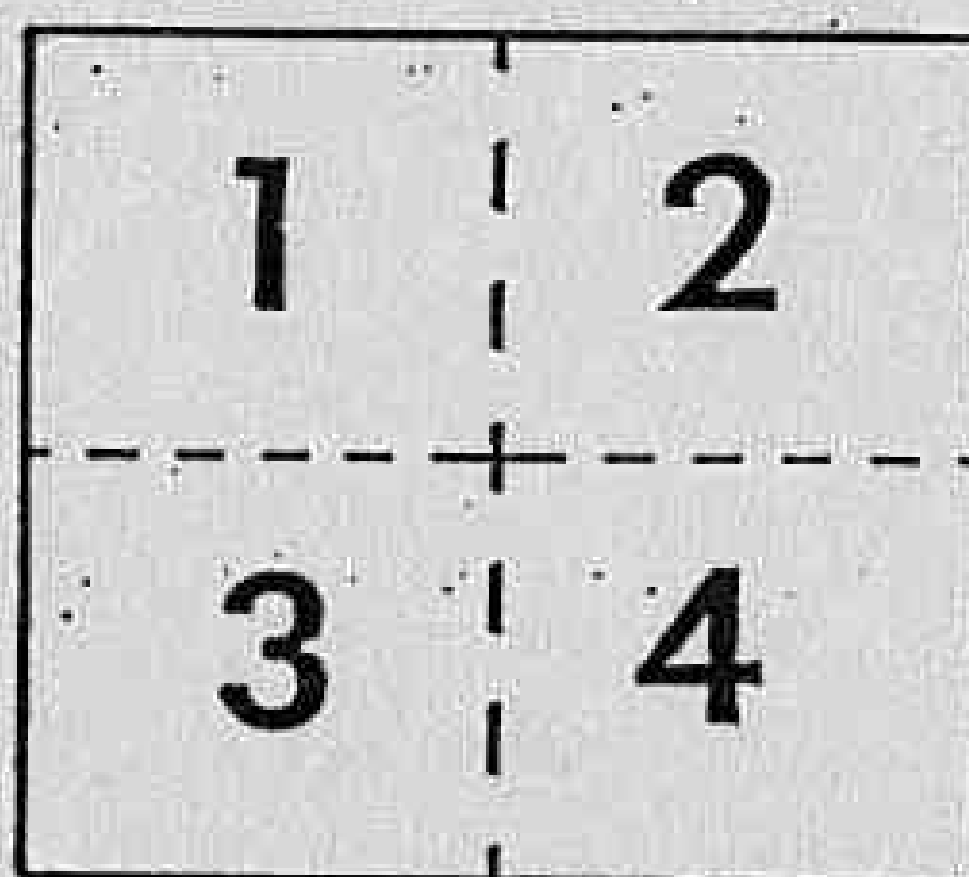

TO : Headquarters,
Allied Control Commission.

1. I have to refer to your signal NO. 1000 of 27 July 44 and to say that Agricultural Memo No. 82020 has not been received at this H.Q.; but that signal No.211 of yesterday's date was sent on the assumption that 32020 was meant.

2. Attention is invited to the three different instructions received here for collecting mail sent from Headquarters, Allied Control Commission and despatching mail thereto. According to these, this H.Q. must arrange to send to Bari, Taranto and Crotone : the latter for air mail, the orders sent in A.P.O. 394 letter Adj: 311.4 dated 9 June 44 not having been cancelled so far as is known.

3. A courier leaves this H.Q. every Monday and Thursday for H.Q. Region III by whose courtesy the onward despatch is undertaken. In a similar way letters for this H.Q. are received by H.Q. Region III and given to the courier returning here. Lack of reliable transport and shortage of drivers makes it out of the question to run a service to more than one place. It is requested, therefore, that communications be sent c/o H.Q. Region III, and not to Bari or Taranto as is being done at present. It might be added that some letters sent to Taranto before any notification had been received here that this was being done, were sent or by train and took five days to get here.

4. With regard to the last sentence of your a/m signal, reports, of course, can be sent on specified days. To be of any value, however, a report must attain some degree of accuracy, and this cannot be guaranteed if it must be rendered on fixed days owing to the extremely poor internal communications in Calabria. The telephone system is not good to say the least, and telegrams often take two or three days.

5. While everything is done to supply all information for which requests are made, it is essential to any appreciation of the position in Region

While everything is done to supply all information for which requests are made, it is essential to any appreciation of the position in Region VII to realise that there are no Provincial Commissioners and only one Provincial Officer: in other words that we have been cut to the bone in the matter of staff.

Subject: Reorganization of Region VII.

To : Regional Commissioner, Region VII.

1. The speed with which the armies have moved within the last two days and the possibility of continued rapid movement make it urgent that you complete plans for the reorganization of Region VII as discussed with me during the Regional Commissioners Conference. As I stated in the cable to you, you with a minimum staff from Region VII should be prepared to move within five days' notification from this Headquarters.

2. We are setting up a small Regional Headquarters here with Col. Pennyquick temporarily in charge. He will set up a minimum Headquarters and a skeleton organization for the first two provinces as soon as we can get the officers together. Supply officers for the Region will be sent forward to AMG 5th Army for training during the move across Region IV.

3. Col. Pennyquick will not be the permanent Regional Executive as he will be moved later to one of the ACC Regions. The permanent Executive has not yet been decided, but you should count on bringing Major Salter, Capt. Andrews, and Lt. Opulente with you.

4. As you well realize the time will depend entirely on the speed of progress by the Army. If the advance up the west coast is rapid which it may be, we will have to be prepared.

SUBJECT: Accounting.

TO : Regional Commissioner, Region VII.

1. Reference your RVII/RS/210 dated 11 May 1944.
2. Additions to the staff of the Chief Accountant during the last few days now make it possible to provide a Supply Accountant from this Headquarters and he should have reported to your Headquarters by the time this reaches you.
3. For the reasons given in my previous letter, however, I cannot appoint another officer to act as Regional Chief Accountant. As however the work involved will be very small the officer to be assigned as Supply Accountant should also fulfil the functions of Regional Chief Accountant and should be carried on the strength of the Finance Division. This is admittedly a departure from normal procedure, but I feel that the work involved in handling both the Supply and the Financial Accounts of Region VII is well within the capabilities of one officer.
4. As already explained, the Sub-Accountants in Region VII draw their funds from AFA Bari and their accounts must therefore be incorporated with those of AFA Bari. Although AFA is not a Regional organisation but is directly dependant from Headquarters, each branch of AFA prepares its own accounts and your Supply Accountant in his capacity of Chief Accountant should therefore send his monthly accounts direct to AFA Bari for incorporation in their books. The Accountant has been duly instructed before reporting to you as to the exact procedure to be followed.
5. Supply Accounts should be submitted monthly direct to the Chief Accountant, HQ. A.C.C. The Accountant has also received instructions on this matter before reporting and will be further instructed by Major Hall before taking over from him.
