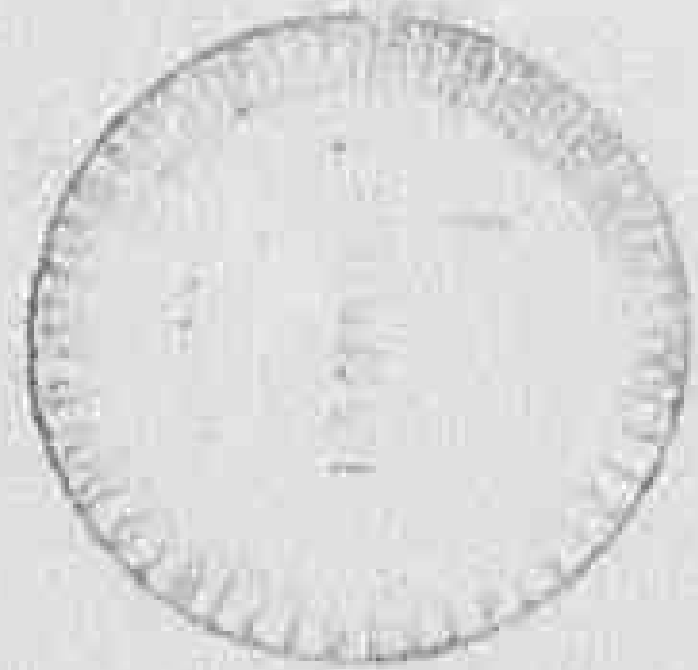

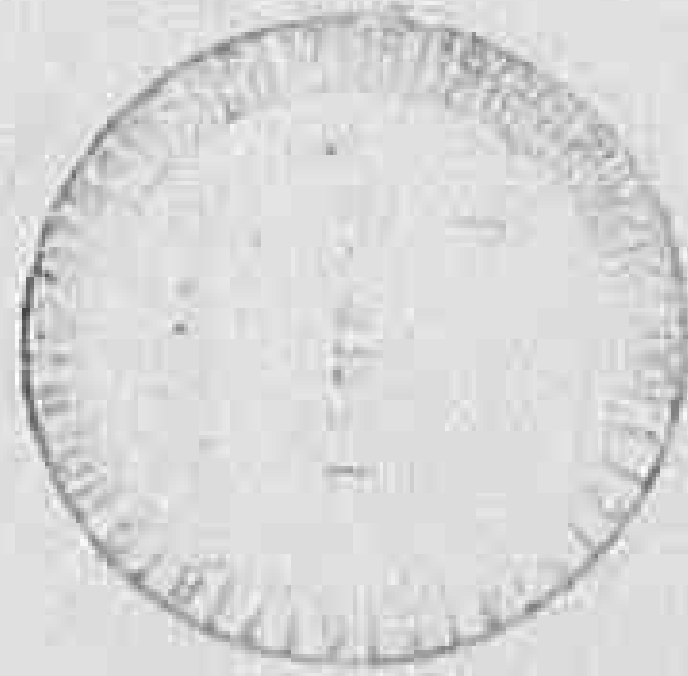

Dear Mr. Brandt:

This note will serve to introduce Mr. Robert Blattner, a representative of the Corn Products Refining Company of New York City, who is proceeding to Milan, Italy, to reopen a wet corn milling plant of that Company.

He had been granted an air priority to fly from the United States to Naples but other arrangements have been made and he is proceeding by boat to Naples. This change in plans entails some delay in his arrival at Milan.

The products of the wet corn milling industry in this country have for the past several years been in high demand and it has been a real problem to meet the needs of domestic users in addition to the large quantities going to the armed forces and to the Lend-Lease programs. It should be a distinct relief to the pressure on American industry if the plant at Milan could be made operative at as early a date as possible.

In view of the fact that air priorities issued in this country relate to travel which is initiated here, there is no way by which we can be of assistance to Mr. Blattner other than to invoke your good offices for a favorable contact with the Air Forces Headquarters. Anything you may be able to do to secure his transportation by air from Naples to Milan will be appreciated, and we believe it will be of distinct advantage to the international programs in which this Branch is engaged.

SUBJECT: RESPONSIBILITIES OF HEADQUARTERS COMMANDANT (B)
FOR AMERICAN TRANSPORTATION.

26

TO : Col. Norman E. Fiske

1. On the afternoon of the 17th of August, a conference was held in my Office to determine the responsibilities of the various administrative officers in this Headquarters.
2. The situation remained very much as it had previously been planned. The only point which involved a great deal of discussion was that of whether or not the transportation should go under the Headquarters Commandant or whether it should be directly responsible to the Executive Officer.
3. Upon careful consideration of this matter, I personally was very desirous of passing this responsibility to the Headquarters Commandant, but after weighing all pro and con of the matter in the discussion, it seemed, in the best interest of the HQ as a whole, to leave the transportation directly responsible to the Executive Officer for the following reasons:
 - a) At the present moment, the Motor Vehicle Transportation Section is made up completely of American personnel and it is thought that it will continue to work much more harmoniously if left that way;
 - b) To insert another officer in the chain of command would result in the following complications:
 - I) Capt. Petruzzai who is doing the work of transportation and seems to have the situation well in hand, would be reporting to another officer, who would simply be taking the credit for work which was not ~~was~~ under his personal attention.
 - II) It is much more efficient and direct to deal with ²the person rather than with two.
 - c) At the present moment, Capt. Petruzzai is personally responsible for the vehicles, having signed the receipts.

It is believed to be a good administrative practise to let the officer who has this momentary responsibility, to decide

1. Col. Harris, Transportation Sub-Commission, Assistant Director, came in to chat with you regarding the transportation policy of this Office. His remarks to me were along the following lines:

He stated that the Regia AU, according to the Di American, has no limitation on the number of vehicles which can be used by us, inasmuch as a table of equipment has not been set up for this Office.

It was stated that it has been the policy of Regione to requisition 3 1/2 vehicles per officer in order to keep the officers mobile and able to do their work.

This also resulted in a beneficial effect of having the officer take a personal interest in the car which was assigned to him, thus saving a great deal of motor maintenance and repairs.

He admitted that the car might be used for recreational purposes and thus gasoline consumed, but he believes that the total effect was most beneficial.

Furthermore it was stated that now that the crisis is past, the general philosophy of AFHQ is to make things as comfortable for military personnel as is possible. Therefore it seems unfair to be too strict with limitations on the AG personnel who are still actively engaged in the performance of duty.

2. Capt. Roberts, who was also present, has volunteered the information that he could obtain good vehicles and he suggested that even though it may be found that the present number of vehicles cannot be augmented, an action be taken to de-requisition the vehicles now on hand and replace them with those which he can get for us.

3. Because this matter seems to be tied in with the general topic of inactivation of Phase 3 which is being discussed in your Conference, I am passing it to you, at this time, for your consideration.
