MEMORANDUM:

9 October 1945.

TO : Colonel PINE.

The following telephone message was received from Colonel PALAZ, Deputy Regional Commissioner, Lombardia Region, 1530 hours: -

Col. PALAZ is very much disturbed at the position with regard to winter clothing for the public safety agencies in the North. Repeated representations have been made to Hq. A.C. but with only limited results. In consequence, the Polizia Sperimentale (Austria), Carabinieri, Finance Guards and Forest Guards are still in summer uniforms.

If it is necessary to submit regulations, Public Safety Sub-Commission has all the facts and figures necessary and can submit them.

Col. PALAZ further states that ample material (which he believes is blocked by HEMA) is available in and around Milan. Can it be released without delay?

Release Of Tycoon Arouses Milanese

MILAN, July 19—The industrialist, Guido Donegani, recently arrested by Partisans, has been set free "by request of higher authorities," the newspaper Avanti revealed today.

Head of Montecatini, one of the largest industrial combines in Italy, Donegani has been accused by the Committee of National Liberation of North Italy of being a leading supporter of Fascism.

The workers of five Montecatini plants in and around Milan organized a one-hour strike yesterday, Avanti said, to protest Donegani's release and the mysterious disappearance of his daughter from police custody.
