1 G-1 (A) Col Fiske To sum up the situation with respect to the assignment of the eighteen officers from ALOON at large to Venezia Giulia as replacements for those lost by redeployment:

1. On 19 Oct 45 cables (see Inclosure A) were sent to the Regions concerned ordering specific officers to Venezia Giulia. To expedite the transfer, the paragraph number and Special Order number were given so as to permit entries to be made on pertinent records prior to the arrival of the actual order.

2. Par 4 of Special Order 290, 20 Oct 1945 (Inclosure B) ordered the officers to proceed without delay.

3. Subsequently we rescinded so much of par 4 as pertained to the following officers:

- a. Major Berhan - Initiated request for relief from active duty under Section V, WD Circular 290 (over 50 years of age)
- b. Capt Gruelle - This office was informally advised that those officers were going to sign Class B certificates. When it

became apparent that they had changed their minds and had elected to be redeployed on their point score, it was deemed inadvisable to transfer them since they both were eligible for the next redeployment group.

4. On 26 October, acting on a letter from the Regional Commissioner of Liguria, Brig Carr directed that Major Olerum was not to comply with orders to proceed to Venezia Giulia (see Inclosure C). However, G-1 American was not informed of this until 30 October. Legal Sub-Commission was able to furnish a British Legal officer to replace Major Olerum and Major Olerum was ordered by cable on 30 Oct to proceed to Venezia Giulia (see Inclosure D).

5. On 29 October another cable was sent directing immediate compliance with previous instruction and requiring date of departure of officers concerned. (see Inclosure E)

It must be realized that with the greatly reduced number of officers now serving in the Northern Regions, each officer must perform several jobs and is charged with considerable property responsibility in most instances. The turn over of property and funds and the indoctrination of a successor would explain a certain amount of the delay as would the widely separated areas in which the officers were serving and the difficulties of communication.

In confirmation of telephone conversation with General LEONARD. I am very concerned at the Allied Military Government Officer situation in VERONA AREA. 18 US officers have been withdrawn today without replacement and I understand replacement may not be available for some time. I am told that a further 23 US officers are liable to be withdrawn within the next week. Replacements for all officers withdrawn are urgently required otherwise Allied Military Government can not continue to function effectively. It is also most important that replacement should be by US and not British officers otherwise the proportion of US to British will fall still lower which would be most undesirable from every point of view. I should be grateful if urgent steps could be taken to maintain Allied Military Government in VERONA AREA at full officers strength and to bring the proportion of US and British officers to as nearly as possible a fifty fifty basis.

A. The JUGOSLAV system of National Committees in general should be discontinued throughout the entire territory. You should reinstall the Italian system. In villages and cities which are predominately Yugoslav you may retain a token Yugoslav administration and may use a National Committee in an advisory capacity. The foregoing is your guide for administering Allied occupied VENEZIA GIULIA.

B. You will make it clear to the Yugoslavs that during the period when the Allies hold the trusteeship of Allied occupied VENEZIA GIULIA they will use Italian Laws purged of measures which are Fascist supplemented by such AMG orders and proclamations as are necessary. AMG will take no action which will prejudice the position of either of the disputing parties.

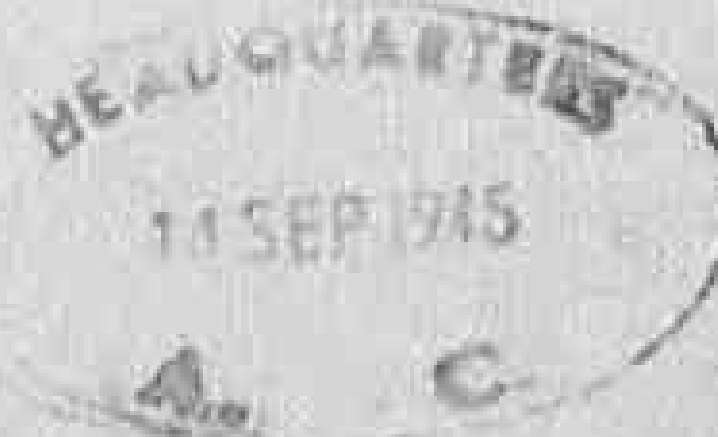

My obligation to produce British American personnel parity here long agreed by all others concerned intensified by explicit personal instructions from Supreme Allied Commander yesterday. This possible within reasonable period only if for present all replacements and new postings American. This already agreed with you in principle but in practice replacements still predominantly British. Each of these sets us back 2 paces on path to parity, and must regretfully decline to receive officers if continues. Only permissible present exception to all American rule is British personnel necessary to maintain parity in key positions as well as straight numbers and these should be sent only after personal consultation with SCAO. For example, must refuse absolutely to have both Chief Legal and Finance Officers British. With increasing numbers of officers available should be no difficulty about this. As one who has long worked successfully and happily with British personnel am sure no one will misunderstand my position on this matter, which is one of greatest operational importance.

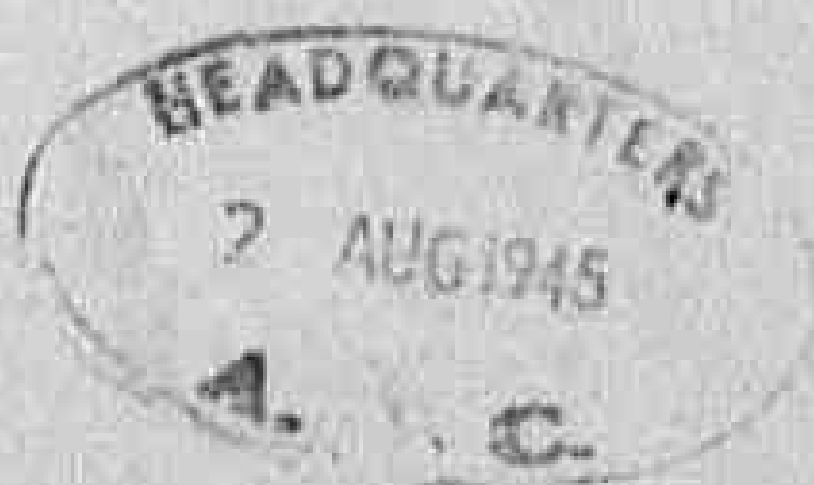

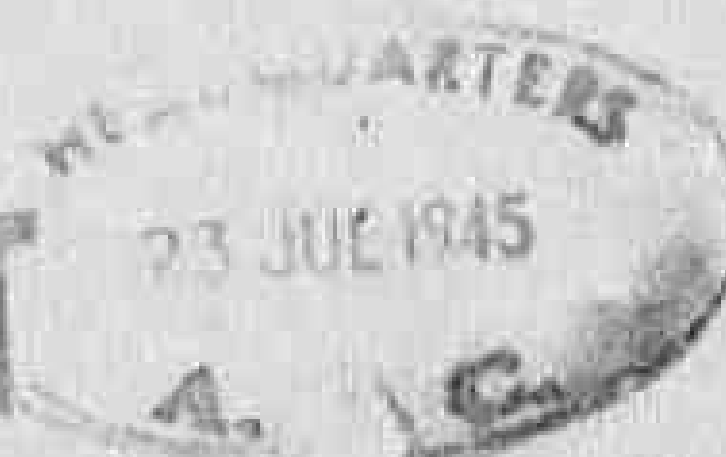

Your message 1695 dated 10 July refers. Following information submitted for period 78 (18?) June 1945 to 30 June 1945. (a) number men AWOL; none. (b) number venereal disease cases; none. (c) number convictions by courts-martial, General, Special, and Summary; none. (d) number punishments under Article of War 104; none.

Activated in TRIESTE immediately after the entry of Allied troops, personnel of this unit were, in collaboration with British officers and other ranks, assigned the mission of establishing effective Military Government in the occupied portion of VENEZIA GIULIA. The permanent sovereignty of the territory involved was uncertain, the area was still partially occupied by resentful Yugoslav troops, and the population included a very considerable number of persons unsympathetic to the occupation and to Allied Military Government. By the exercise of unflagging effort, firm judicious action and a high degree of restraint, tact and diplomacy in the face of ~~monstrous~~ extremely aggravating circumstances, this mission was successfully accomplished during the ensuing 12 days. Large bodies of indigenous, semi-hostile militia and irregular troops were dissolved. Institutions and organizations inconsistent with impartial Military Government were abolished. Dissident and subversive elements were imprisoned or removed; unprejudiced officials were found and appointed, and a scheme of Military Government specially adapted to the peculiar conditions involved was devised and put into effect. One of the most difficult assignment ever given to a Military Government unit, was, without opportunity for adequate preparation, and in spite of extremely limited personnel, satisfactorily accomplished.
