1. Discharge criteria which will be used for further reduction of army will be based on combination of adjusted service rating score and length of service. This policy will become effective 1 December 45.

2. Criteria effective 1 December 45 will be as follows:

Male officers (excluding medical) dash adjusted service rating 73 or 4 years

3 months service

Wac officers dash adjusted service rating 37

Medical dept officers dash no change for present

Male enlisted dash adjusted service rating 55 or 4 years service

Female enlisted dash adjusted service rating 32.

Male officers (excluding medical) dash adjusted service rating 70 or 4 years service

Wac rpt Wac officers dash adjusted service rating 37 or 3 years 3 months service

Male enlisted dash adjusted service rating 50 or 3 years 6 months service

4. In addition, on and after 1 December 45, all enlisted men who have 3 or more children under 18 years of age dependent upon them for support will become eligible for discharge upon application, irrespective of length of service or adjusted service rating score. Also all married members of the war rpt war (officer and enlisted) who enlisted prior to 12 May 45 become eligible for discharge upon application.
5. Length of service as it pertains to this policy includes total active service (commissioned plus enlisted) since war 16 September 40 and continues to accrue with passing of time. For War rpt War length of service includes service in the WAAG rpt War WAAG.
6. There will be no rpt no consideration of "Military necessity" except for those individuals whose military occupational specialty appears only that of scarce categories (War Department memo 605 dash 45 and 615 dash 45). Personnel whose military occupational specialty appears on these lists may be retained in service for a maximum of 6 months after date of eligibility. Those held under each specialty will be limited to requirements for that specialty selected so as to retain only those least qualified for separation.
7. Officers who become eligible under this policy will be reported available for separation within 60 days of date of eligibility unless they have volunteered to remain in service for any additional period of time under existing regulations or instructions. Enlisted personnel must be declared available for separation 374 immediately upon eligibility unless they have volunteered under provisions of change 2 of readjustment regulations one dash one of have enlisted in regular army.

Provisions under FX 44570 revoked so far as pertains to male and female officers assigned to or in training for Civil Affairs or Military Govt duties (authority is WX 77685) and following substituted.

Male and female officers assigned to or in training for Civil Affairs or Military Govt duties may volunteer to continue on extended active duty with their consent beyond date they become eligible for relief from active duty by agreeing with their commanding officer to continue on active duty until a specific date or for duration of emergency and 6 months, whichever is earlier as volunteer. Date agreed on must be subsequent to date officer becomes eligible for relief from active duty. Statement to be signed will read: "Regardless of any eligibility which I now have or may have in the future for relief from active duty under readjustment regulations, I elect, unless sooner relieved, to continue on extended active duty until (date agreed upon) or for the duration of the emergency plus 6 months, if this occurs earlier."

Para 8. Officers in theater with adjusted service rating scores equal to or above critical scores who desire to remain on active duty and who volunteer under provisions paragraph 4 B, readjustment regulation W 1-5, will be retained in this theater until such time as they become surplus to theater requirements and then returned to UNITED STATES in reception station groups for final decision as to retention or separation from service. After return to UNITED STATES their records may then be referred to other major forces for consideration if officers so desire.

Para 9. Overseas separation of officers will be as prescribed in paragraph 26, readjustment regulation 1-1, for enlisted personnel.

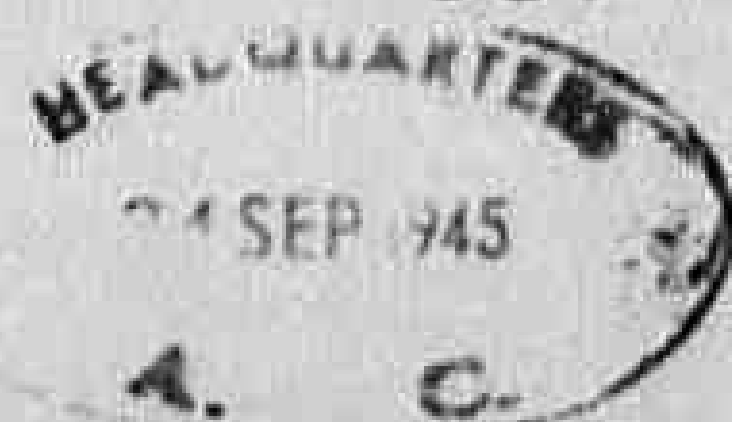

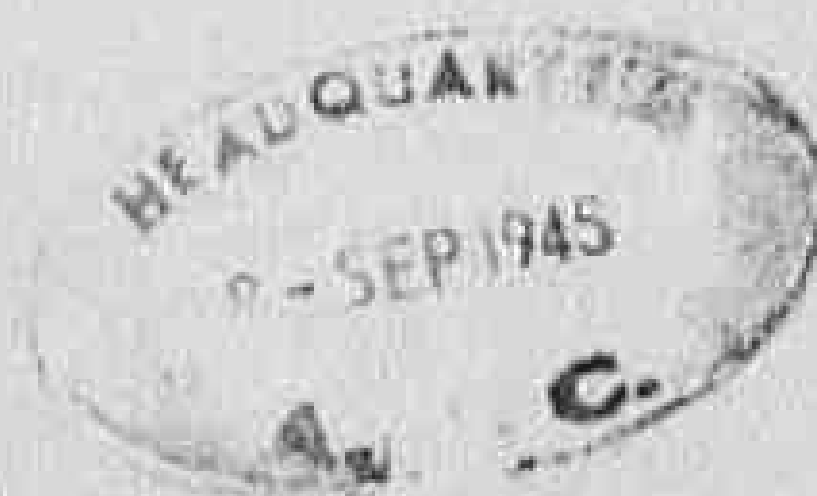

Here follows repeat of AGWAR reference 2728:

"Following approved WD Circular to supersede Section 2 WD Circular 250 of 17 August 45 now in process publication enlisted personnel will be eligible for discharge on account of age provided: they are 38 years of age or over, or they are 35 years of age or over and in addition have completed a minimum of 2 years active military service and their service is honorable, and they apply in writing to their immediate commanding officer for discharge under the provisions of this circular.

Personnel eligible for discharge in accordance with above who apply for discharge will be sent to a separation center, as provided in current instructions, for discharge under the provisions of AR 615-365 (convenience of the Govt) and this circular. Military necessity or other requirements or limitations will not be a bar to discharge; however this authority will not be used in lieu of disciplinary action, nor when discharge under other Army regulations is appropriate, nor when the individual concerned is under medical or surgical treatment.

Commanders will be permitted to retain for 90 days any individual for whom a replacement is not available at the time he or she requests discharge; however, individuals so retained will not be

1. Effective 2 September 45 following paragraphs of Readjustment Regulations 1-1 are rescinded: last sentence 1 B, 2, 6 C and D, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12 A, B, and F, 13, 15, 16, 20 C and D, 24 B and C, 29, 30, 31 and 32. Also delete from paragraph 4 B 1, Readjustment Regulations 1-1, "And the war time scale of punishment applied". 4 B Readjustment Regulations 1-5 is amended to read: "The following statement will be signed by each officer who desires to be retained in the service, and such statement will be entered on his Adjusted Service rating form: "regardless of any eligibility which I may have, now or in the future, for relief from active duty under Readjustment Regulations, I elect irrevocably to continue on extended active duty for the duration of the emergency and 6 months, unless sooner relieved." Authority for above changes is WAR DEPARTMENT radio WX 58979.

2. Adjusted Service Rating scores all EM with present scores 84 or below, enlisted WACS with present scores 43 or below and all officers will be recomputed by application current factors and multiples to reflect additional credits for period 12 May 45 to 2 September 45.

3. EM with present scores 85 and above and enlisted women with scores 44 and above will be given first priority for return and discharge. Recomputation prescribed in paragraph 2 above will not act to disturb this priority.

4. In addition to enlisted personnel 35 years of age or over, enlisted personnel 35 years of age or over who have completed 2 years

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active military service and whose service has been honorable are now eligible for discharge under provisions WAR DEPARTMENT Circular 250 now under revision. See details in curad C 16705.

5. Render following reports to reach this Headquarters not later than dates indicated showing officers and EM separately and enlisted personnel by score and age separately:

A. By 12 September 45, number of personnel with Adjusted Service Rating scores 85 or above and number of enlisted personnel 38 years of age or over in your command as of 1 September 45.

B. By 14 September 45, number of personnel with Adjusted Service Rating scores 80 or above under new computation and number of enlisted persons 35 years of age or over with minimum of 2 years service, as of 2 September 45, exclusive of personnel reported under 5 A above.

6. In selecting personnel for return to UNITED STATES, include fair proportion officers and enlisted personnel, latter to be proportioned by age and scores. When an individual is qualified for separation both by score and age priority will be governed by whichever produces earliest return. Pending further instructions on selection of officer personnel for separation, Readjustment Regulations 1-5 will continue in effect with first priority for return being arduous combat service and second priority length of overseas service. Enlisted personnel eligible for separation because of score may be declared essential only if their MOS appears on WAR DEPARTMENT list of score categories. Personnel whose MOS appears on such list may be retained in service for maximum of 6 months from date on which his score entitles him to separation. Officers qualified for separation who desire to remain for further service may be retained if suitable assignment exists or reasonably presumed to exist.

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7. Effective 2 September 45 new critical score for EM is 80 and for enlisted women 41. Critical scores for enlisted personnel will be progressively lowered from time to time.

8. It is imperative that all EM except volunteers and those in scarce categories mentioned in 6 above, with scores of 85 or above on 1 September be forwarded for shipment before and personnel eligible under new computation are shipped.

9. Vigorous action will be taken, including mandatory personal explanation by company or comparable unit officers to insure complete understanding of the information included herein by all personnel.

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
