1. This Section has several U.S. officers with high critical scores who will be leaving about 1 October 45 for the United States for relief from active duty.
2. In order to replace these officers it is necessary to secure two U.S. officers in the grade of Major or Lt. Colonel with the following qualifications. Staff training in either Civil Affairs or Displaced Persons or Economics and Supply functions. Personnel experienced only in Public Safety, Monuments and Fine Arts, Education, Legal and Finance are not desired. Officers should not have a critical score of more than 80 points.
3. It is hoped that Allied Commission may have several qualified and available officers due to turnback of Northern Italy and reduction in staff.
4. As this Section is in urgent need of these two officers, request you advise soonest with names and qualifications of officers you can release and date they will be available.

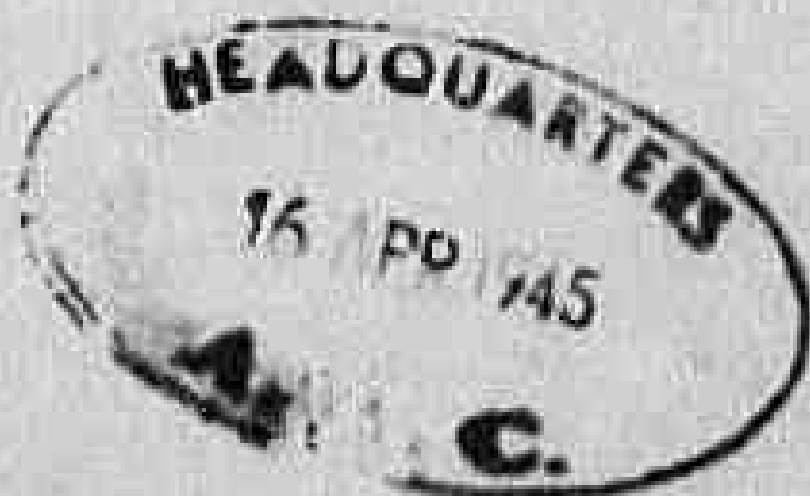

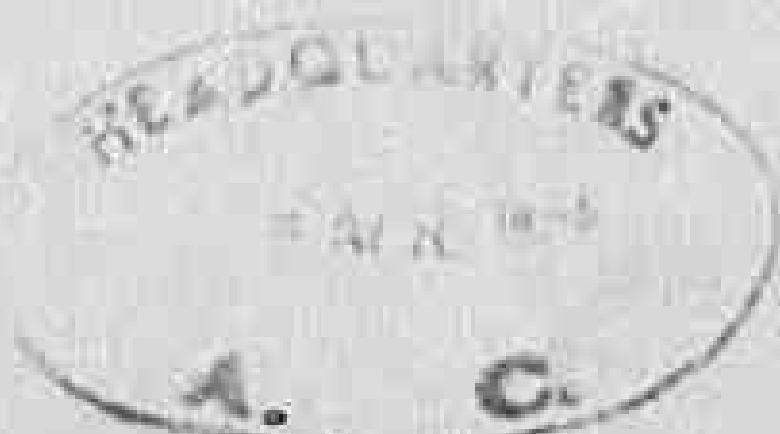

MEMORANDUM:

TO : Colonel Parkin

1. Herewith is file of correspondence re the attendance at a proposed course of studies in personnel utilization and work simplification of Allied Commission officers. The course is to be run by MTOUSA, and expected to last about two weeks. Upon its completion, the officers detailed to it will return to A.C.

2. MTOUSA has previously asked for the names of officers with industrial or engineering backgrounds to be placed on TD there, these officers to remain at MTOUSA for an indefinite period. This matter has been cleared, with the submission of Lt. Colonel Roximer's name. In addition, MTOUSA requested several other officers whose names had not been submitted.

3. General McKinley has discussed this at some length with General Nelson, the Deputy Theater Commander. General McKinley is anxious that advantage be taken of the course by detailing to it the officers whose training along these lines would be of most advantage to the Commission, i.e., those in key administrative positions. In discussing the matter today, General McKinley stated that, should the courses be given, as contemplated, it was in his opinion essential that clearance from the employing activity of the officers to be detailed be regarded as desirable, but not necessary. The very point that the officers in question are holding key jobs points up the value of their attendance at the course. General McKinley further stated that, at present, the course was projected, might not be held, and that as yet no firm date for the opening thereof had been set.

4. Would you discuss, at the next Executive Commissioner's meeting, or with Col. Fiske, in the light of the point that attempts to clear a two-week period of TD for these officers have not met with success, General McKinley's suggestion that the detail of these officers be made a matter of high-level directive, rather than to engage in further attempts to secure consent from their Sections and/or Sub-Commissions.

Dear Colonel Fiske,

With reference to loan of Major Savage to MTCUSA on a 30 to 60 days assignment.

I do not think that this Sub-Commission can be blamed for want of generosity in the past when asked to release officers, but this time I am asked to do something that in all fairness to the Sub-Commission I cannot grant.

I consider that Major Savage in the post of Executive Officer holds one of the key appointments in the Sub-Commission and has been responsible for its smooth working. His tact has been invaluable in handling difficult matters and he has created an atmosphere of confidence among all those who seek his advice.

In this Headquarters there are two officers who are responsible for the working of the Sub-Commission apart from myself, one is Lt. Col. Prizelle who acts as my Deputy when I am away, and the other is Major Savage who is Executive Officer and who has a very full-time appointment. The remaining officers, Lt. Col. McSweeney and Major Rushmore, are respectively occupied with Welfare and Veterinary services and take no part in the actual running of the Sub-Commission.

With the handing over of Italy to the Italian Government the work of this Sub-Commission has, if anything, increased, and I personally handle on an average 100 files weekly, most of which require action, plus 10 odds and ends such as news extracts, sitreps, and other publications.

I have discussed this matter with my own Vice President and he agrees with me that at present nothing should be done to reduce our staff. I should be therefore most grateful if this contemplated move could be cancelled.
