TO : Colonel C. M. Parkin.

1. Following is proposed 2nd indorsement to attached correspondence:
2. The entire basic communication is a complaint on a rating which was given over a year ago and apparently it is a matter of judgment. The procedure used in putting the rating on the Form 66-1 of a field-grade officer is as follows: the head of a sub-commission, region, or what-not, renders an efficiency report on each field-grade officer (this was true in 1943). The regional headquarters copies the rating from the efficiency report on the Form 66-1. The efficiency report is then forwarded to the Adjutant General or through channels. No copies of the efficiency report are retained. This is in accordance with existing Army Regulations. Therefore, it is impossible for this headquarters to determine just who did rate Colonel Jenny "very satisfactory" for that period. Par. 8 d, Section II, AR 600-185 states: "The office of the Adjutant General is the official repository for all efficiency reports, and an officer may be granted permission to examine his own efficiency reports for his information and guidance." May I emphasize the last phrase - "for his information and guidance". In my opinion, the interpretation of this section of Army Regulations precludes the opening of the case in point.
3. Reference Par. 2, there seems to be a sharp difference of opinion between the subject officer and his superior inasmuch as Colonel Jenny charges that "whoever rated me at that time had absolutely no knowledge of what I was doing or else no such rating as 'V.S.' could have been given". This is a most serious charge against a superior officer since, the reporting officer, when he signs the efficiency report, states: "I certify that to the best of my knowledge and belief all entries made hereon are true and impartial and are in accordance with AR 600-185". Colonel Jenny is attacking the integrity of his superior officer, the only reason being that he thinks he is better than his superior officer thinks. If Colonel Jenny is so cognizant of the reason for the reported hold-up of his promotion, all he has to do is to read the regulation regarding promotion in this theater and he will find that he was not eligible for promotion until about four to six weeks before he was actually promoted.
4. In conclusion, reference Par. 4 of the basic communication, I strongly recommend that the rating stand, that the matter be closed, and that Colonel Jenny be reprimanded for his improper and inconsiderate criticism of higher authority.

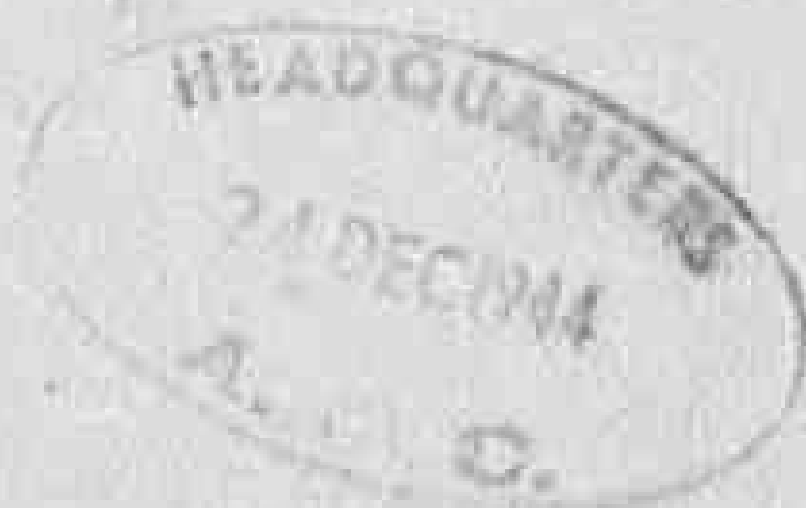

1. On 23 November 1944 HQ Allied Commission declared that you were surplus to its organization. This declaration was made with the expectation that you would be placed on inactive service - this on account of your wife's serious and protracted illness. Consideration was also given to the fact that you approached G-1 American in June 1944 and stated your case but did not press for relief in that a replacement could not be secured at that time to fill your assignment as Liaison Officer, Advanced HQ Allied Armies in Italy.
2. Your efficiency rating is reflected by the records. Moreover, on 15 June 1944, 20 October 1944 and 9 November 1944, you were recommended for promotion to Major. These recommendations were returned unapproved for the reason that promotions were either temporarily frozen or the T.O. presented no vacancies.
3. Your assignments have been almost entirely in connection with staff work. The representation which you gave this HQ for 5 months as Liaison Officer with HQ Allied Armies in Italy was most satisfactory; subsequently as Staff Officer assigned to the Office of the Chief of Staff, your duties were most ably executed.
4. You were relieved of your post at HQ AAI by a Major and your present relief from the Office of the Chief of Staff will be made by an officer of the rank of major.
5. The Commission regrets very much that circumstances have led to this separation as your work here was considered of high value.
