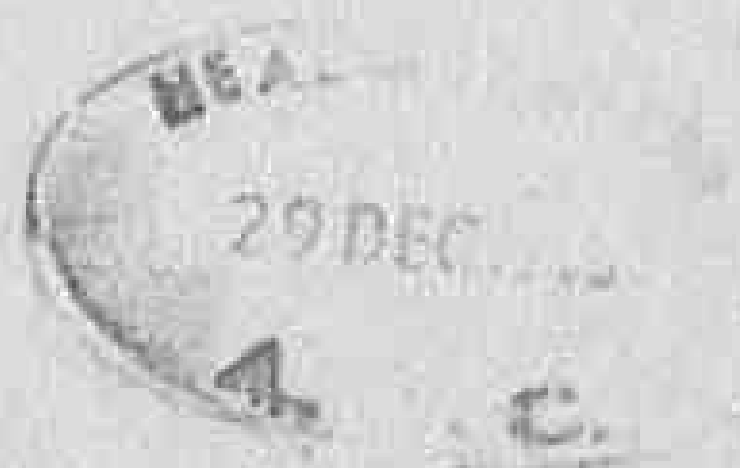

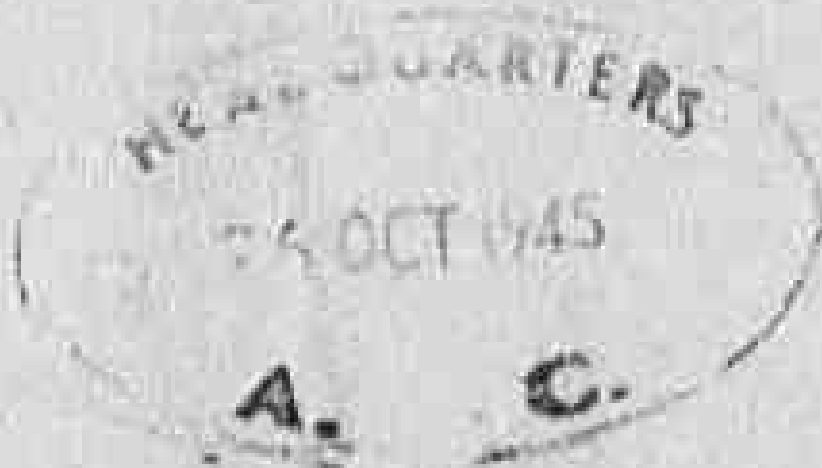

During the past six months the accounting staff (officers and men) has been reduced from 46 to 26. At the present time this latter number cannot keep abreast of the work, either in the Supply Accounting Unit or in the Financial Accounting Unit.

2. The most disturbing aspect of the situation, however, is the further staff reduction that will follow within the next six weeks as the result of releases and LRP for British officers and Other Rates, and the reduced service point requirements for U.S. Enlisted Men.

4. Accounting is a function that necessarily lags behind other activities. As an example, we are now receiving an increasing number of claims as the result of two years operations of AG/ANG. Furthermore, the supply accounting functions will continue with the 100 million dollar P.R.A. program, through 31 December 1945.

5. This office requires an additional staff of 25. There is immediate need for 5 officers (with senior accounting experience) and 8 enlisted men (with clerical - bookkeeping experience). From previous correspondence with A.P.M.S. G-3 Section, we had expected to receive 12 civilian employees, due to arrive in the latter part of September. It is now understood from G-5 (Financial Advisor) that there is some doubt whether the civilian personnel will be assigned to the Allied Commission.

6. There is only one qualified accountant in the Finance Divisions of the four northern regions and Venezia Giulia. He is presently engaged upon supply accounting duties in A.M.C. Venezia Giulia. Therefore the

personnel requested in this memorandum must be transferred from other Sub-Commissions of A.C. to the Finance Sub-Commission, or recruited from outside A.C./M.C.

7. It is therefore urgently requested that every effort be made to assign to Finance Sub-Commission immediately five qualified officers and eight qualified M/Cs. Unless this is done, supply accounting work will fall increasingly in arrears, as the supply and financial accounts are being maintained upon direct orders from the Combined Chiefs of Staff, we shall have to advise the Combined Chiefs of Staff that we have insufficient personnel to carry out their instructions, if the officers and M/Cs requested in this memorandum are not forthcoming by 15 October.

1. In continuance our policy to return management of industry to Italians steps were taken in April 1945 to hand back control certain steel and other industries. In order to assist Italians certain officers of AFHQ were loaned to ALLIED COMMISSION for this purpose. This cable concerns 1 of these officers Brig D L ANDERSON.

2. ANDERSON was filling appointment director engineer stores this Hq; Although it cannot be confirmed by those who made arrangements it seems clear that intention was that ANDERSON should continue to be borne on W.E. AFHQ while on loan to AC until a vacancy in AC occurred and that head of engineer stores section should be downgraded to Colonel as anticipation was that work of that Section would be decreased. Position was therefore that W.E.F. 16 April 45 ANDERSON while continuing fill vacancy of AFHQ W.E. was performing duty with AC and his section at AFHQ was headed by his deputy.

3. Experience however has shown that this arrangement unjust since responsibilities attaching to directorate of engineer stores have been in no way reduced owing to delay in the assumption of control of industry by Italian Govt. Further on 20 August 1945 WEC AFHQ reviewing this we recommended abolition appointment deputy W.E.F; 1 August 1945 and retention Brigadier Director as considered

Already considered possibility of absorbing ANDERSON in an existing Brigadier's appointment in AC but all of them were filled during the period in question.

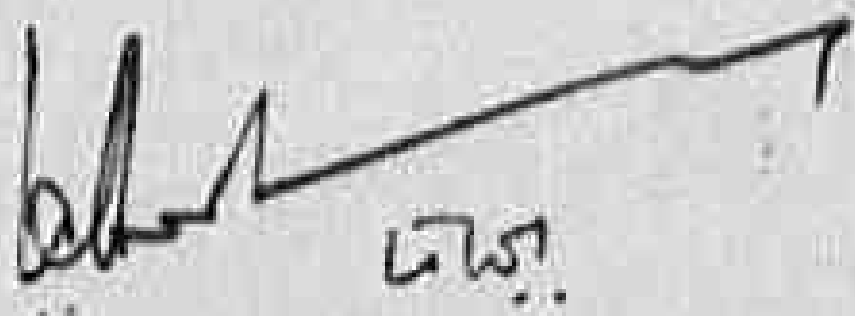

1. The present deficiency in British Clerks is 25% and is steadily rising. OZE cannot supply reinforcements commensurate with losses due to PYTHON, RELEASE, etc.
2. Increased demands by VEREZIA GIULIA Region, D.P. & R. S/C, W.M.D. & I.P.W. S/C & Finance S/C have made the position still worse.
3. The attitude of G-1(B) mentioned in para 2 of attached letter from Finance S/C was due to the above factors, and the knowledge that this S/C with a ceiling of 26 clerks, actually held 40.
4. The 2 cases referred to in para 2 cannot be traced. No clerks have been withdrawn from Finance S/C.
5. Opl, Small referred to in para 3 of attached was an RASC Clerk in Toscana and until assigned to this HQ on closure of Toscana, G-1(B) was not aware that he had been assisting with accounting work in the Region. He is now i/o casualties in Officers' Records, a department already 2 under strength, and in which work is at present so much in arrears that night work is necessary to bring records up to date.
6. It is appreciated that many Sub Commissions are under strength in clerical personnel and every effort is being made by this Branch to obtain the posting to AC of such few clerks as are available.

SUBJECT : Personnel for tallying incoming cargoes.
TO : Executive Commissioner

1. As you are aware considerable pressure has been brought to bear by Washington for the tallying of incoming cargoes by agents of WSA/MWT supervised by AC. This Sub-Commission has on various occasions pointed out that no AC personnel is available for this work. Tallying by WSA/MWT agents will shortly begin and it is essential for Transportation Sub-Commission to find personnel in connection with this work required by Washington.
2. Finance Sub-Commission has had a number of EM/OR who are trained in supply work but who are being used for other purposes in Regions or who have been transferred to other duties on the closing down of Regions. The Finance Sub-Commission has great difficulty in retaining the use of these EM/OR's as G-1 is inclined to adopt the attitude that Finance is already overstaffed with EM/OR's. In two cases recently Finance have been unable to retain accounting clerks who have been transferred to other duties. The whole position is incongruous in view of our requests to Washington for increased accounting staff to carry out their requirements.
3. We should be obliged if pressure can be brought to bear to obtain the assignment of the undermentioned EM/OR to Transportation Sub-Commission (Ports and Warehouse Division) for the work referred to above. All these EM/OR are or were previously employed on accounting work in Finance Sub-Commission or Regions.
