SUBJECT : Release of Attached Officers - Military Government School
trained.
TO : Acting Vice President, Establishment Section.

1. The indorsement signed for General McNarney, which stated that Military Government School trained officers would not be released prior to 15 September and only when approval was granted by the Allied Commission, has been interpreted by Assistant G-1 Headquarters Fifth Army to mean that these officers must be released by the Allied Commission for return to their units which are being redeployed and that they can be retained by us only if we have a position vacancy and that we approve of their transfer.

2. In view of the above interpretation, it was necessary to release to-day two officers attached to Venezia Region. The necessity for releasing these officers was protested by me in a conversation this date with Major Thompson at G-5 AFHQ. Our request for an increase of officer T/O to 600 was reiterated yesterday and to-day and the response received from G-5 was that it was not possible. The informal impression was that we would have to get along with the officers we have. The unstated, but implied idea received from Major Thompson was that it might be more effective if Colonel Fiske spoke to General Spofford upon the General's return to his office on Monday.

3. Until this office receives instructions to the contrary, the only action it can take regarding those attached officers is to release them if and when their units ask for them regardless of the date.

1. Reference is made to your 7018/EC, of 25 May and to signal 8295 (copy of which is attached for easy reference).

2. The following points are pertinent to Lieut. Rancourt's TD with AMG IV Corps:

a. AMG IV Corps requested an experienced hotel man, to run a hotel in Milan.

b. An officer, experienced in such work, had been requested early in the year from the U.S., and it was reported, at the time Lt. Rancourt left Hq, A.C., that this officer had left the Continental U. S. by sea early in April. It was therefore anticipated, at the time of Lt. Rancourt's attachment to AMG IV Corps, that his temporary duty was to be of a duration not exceeding 10 days to two weeks, since, by that time, the arrival of his replacement was anticipated.

c. It has now developed that Lt. Rancourt's replacement, the officer referred to in Par 2 of the attached signal, will not be available as a replacement.

d. Lt. Rancourt has been with IV Corps for nearly a month. (Auth: Par 14, SO 118, dated 28 April 45).

e. Lt. Rancourt's activities in Milan consist of supervising the operation of the Albergo Continentale, the IV Corps Field Officers Hotel. The Continentale is not an AC/AMG hotel. 1506

f. Lt. Rancourt's duties at Hq A.C. consisted in handling American rations, and supervising the operation of the Columbia Club.

g. IV Corps have available personnel trained in hotel management.

3. It now appears that either Lt. Rancourt should be transferred to AMG IV Corps, to continue his work for IV Corps, and that steps should be taken to secure a replacement for him here at Hq. A.C., or that AMG IV Corps should be informed that the shortage of AC/AMG personnel is such that the indefinite loan of Lt. Rancourt, to do a job for which IV Corps, and not Hq. A.C., or AMG IV Corps, should furnish personnel, cannot further be continued.

4. May Establishment Section be informed, please, if Executive Commissioner wishes Lt. Rancourt to remain at his present post.

1. Reference is made to letter, your headquarters, subject, "Issuance of Air Travel Orders - Authority", file Adj: 322.011, dated 25 August 1944.

2. Headquarters Region I, Allied Control Commission (Sicily) is hereby added to the list of headquarters contained in paragraph 4, AFHQ Administrative Memorandum Number 3, dated 10 January 1944 (as amended by AFHQ Administrative Memorandum Number 13), copies attached. Under provisions of that memorandum, Director, Region I, Allied Control Commission (Sicily) is authorized to issue orders directing travel by air within the Mediterranean Theater.

1. The Emilia Region copy of your signal 729, 20 January 1945, has been received.
2. It is apparently responsive to a request from Headquarters Allied Commission for certain AMG Fifth Army personnel for use in the south and reads in part as follows: "In place of Captains Lee, Bennett and Jefferson and Lt. Thomson, propose to send Major C.J. Carillio, Major L.G. Dering, Lt. D.E. Moore and Capt. J.Y. Elliott. These last four are at present not actively engaged and their services can more easily be dispensed with for next two months. As these four are assigned Emilia Region suggest clearance with Regional Commissioner." (underlining ours)
3. The implications of this language necessitate a reminder and restatement of the relation of these officers and other Region Emilia personnel, to AMG Fifth Army, and the essential limitations of this relationship.
4. Shortly after the re-formation of Emilia Region, in accordance with Allied Commission policy and precedent, four Region Emilia provincial teams were sent forward on loan to AMG Fifth Army, to augment its strength and for its use as provincial teams until such time as tactical developments should permit their being sent forward to previously determined locations in the respective provinces of the Region, to which these officers were assigned. Due to a subsequent shift of Army boundaries, the number of provincial teams so loaned was later increased to five. 1482
5. The clear and unambiguous understanding and directive with regard to such teams was that they should be used as teams and that if and when their services were no longer required by AMG Fifth Army they should be returned as teams to the Region for use elsewhere.
6. On numerous occasions in the ensuing months, AMG Fifth Army has proceeded in disregard of this basic understanding and directive in several respects, taking action and assuming administrative and disciplinary jurisdiction not justified by the terms of reference. Among other things, it has:

a. Operationally, disregarded the unity of provincial teams, and used officers when and where it saw fit, without regard to the maintenance of the integrity of teams;

b. Granted leaves to officers without reference to, or consultation with the Region, with the result that officers could not be reached by Region headquarters for administrative purposes;

c. Taken action toward the promotion of officers without consultation with the Region;

d. In its orders used the word "assigned" in allocating officers to places of duty, overlooking and ignoring the fact that it has no assignment jurisdiction over them; and,

e. Sub-loaned Emilia Regional officers to other Regions without reference to, or consultation with, this Region.

7. The matter referred to in point a was mentioned to the Regional Commissioner (as a fait accompli) and stated to be operationally necessary. On that basis it was agreed to, upon condition that officers be kept in sufficiently close contact with their respective Provincial Commissioners for the efficient and effective exercise of administrative and disciplinary jurisdiction. Other enumerated items of departure from the basic agreement have upon occasion been noted and protested, and AMG Fifth Army has agreed to desist from the protested practices. Still other points have been waived or overlooked. Emilia Region recognizes that at the present juncture its prime function is to assist the Armies and there has been no inclination to split hairs, or to make mountains out of molehills.

8. The fact remains that the officers of this Region have been and continue to be loaned to AMG for its use while it needs them and for no other purpose. When officers are not needed they should be returned to their provincial commissioners who have been properly instructed to communicate that fact to regional headquarters so that effective use may be made of the affected officers elsewhere. They are not AMG Fifth Army's for the purpose of loan to other Regions, release to Allied Commission, or for any purpose other than its own operational use until needed by the Region. 1,81

9. Under these conditions the use in the quoted signal of the phrases "propose to send"; "at present not actively engaged"; "services can . . . be dispensed with for next two months" constitute a quite intolerable assumption of dominion and jurisdiction over

the officers in question. Region Bullia had no notice whatever that these officers were surplus to your requirements, and on the very day the quoted signal was transmitted the Regional Commissioner was at Headquarters A.C. seeking additional officers for urgent operational use in Bullia Region.

10. A request which has heretofore frequently been made orally and informally is now repeated in formal and written form. Whenever, in the course of your operations, any officers of this Region are no longer required by you will you please direct them at once to report to their respective provincial commissioners, notifying Regional Headquarters of such instructions and of the manner of performance of the officers affected, during their time of service with you.

11. Your failure to do this promptly, consistently, and in good faith, in accordance with the basic plan, will otherwise necessarily have to be made the subject of an application to Headquarters Allied Commission for modification of the existing scheme so as to insure to the Region the degree of control and organisational integrity necessary for effective administration.



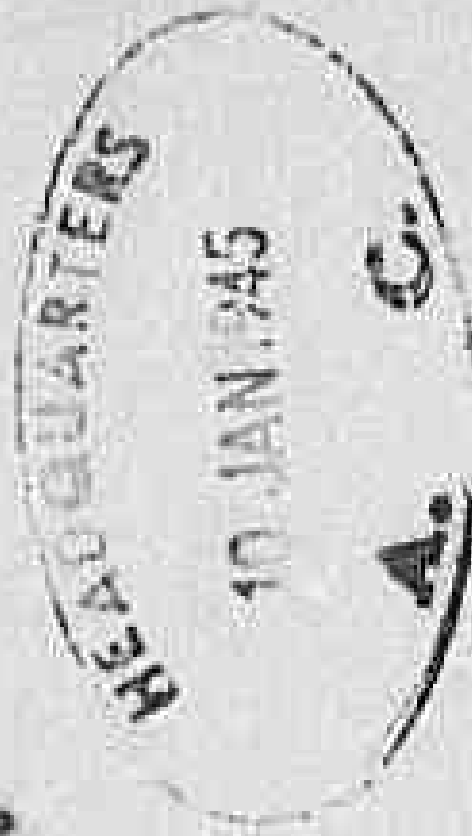
