SUBJECT: Issuance of Allied Commission Orders for Transfer of Officers and EM between Regions.

TO : All Regional Commissioners.

1. It has come to the attention of this Headquarters that American officers and enlisted men are frequently sent to other Regions without a request being made to Allied Commission Headquarters for the issuance of orders.

2. Orders must be issued by this Headquarters prior to the departure of American personnel on temporary duty (except temporary duty up to 5 days duration) or attachment to other regions; also prior to return of attached personnel. Requests for orders must be made in advance. In cases of emergency departures (caused by operational necessity) this Headquarters will be informed immediately and never more than 48 hours after departure.

3. It must be clearly and distinctly understood that this Headquarters will be promptly informed of any change in status of personnel. Strict compliance with the above is requested.

It is essential that all Regional teams in HANNIBAL be brought to full TO and TE strength immediately. Teams reporting LOMBARDIA now 50 per cent under strength and lacking essential transport. Requested that all officers on temporary duty elsewhere be sent to Regional Hq immediately. Speed of advance makes it imperative to order BERGAMO, MILAN province and MILAN city report IV CORPS at MANTOVA immediately. Balance of LOMBARDIA should be sent forward to MANTOVA no later than April 28. Request assembly of PIEMONTE complete at CHIANCIANO ready to move no later than May 1st.

SUBJECT: Personnel on Loan to AMG 5th Army.

TO : S.C.A.O., AMG 5th Army.

1. I have on numerous occasions, in the interests of avoiding future dislocation and maintaining proper present administration of personnel, reminded you of the terms of the original arrangement whereby certain Emilia Region provincial teams were loaned to you for interim operational use pending their movement into the provinces which they had been designated to administer.

2. It would serve no useful purpose again to recapitulate the many respects in which that original agreement has been violated. Several of these were referred to in my letter of 23 January. The use of teams as teams has never been seriously attempted, and regional administration has accordingly suffered. With the idea that the prime function of the region is to serve the Army, most of these abuses have been patiently borne except for occasional reminders "for the record".

3. One principle which is implicit in the arrangement perhaps above all others, is that Emilia Region officers should not be used in positions of primary responsibility in other regions. This is particularly important in the case of provincial commissioners, who have, even under static conditions, a considerable amount of administrative responsibility which cannot be satisfactorily performed in addition to a full-time, heavy, operational assignment.

4. This principle has also been violated freely, but one recent case is more flagrant than others have been. I refer to the use of Lt. Col. I. de L. Radice as Provincial Commissioner of Florence Province.

5. Lt. Col. Radice has, ever since his loan to you, been used in positions in the city of Florence which have made it very difficult for him to perform satisfactorily even the most basic duties of administration: disciplinary control, the preservation of team integrity and the maintenance of records, supply and transport, without which a team is not a team at all.

6. The consequences, in terms of disciplinary problems, lack of "team sense", and administrative difficulties, have been considerable. As pro tem provincial commissioner of Florence Province any attention by him to these matters will obviously be impossible.

7. The result is a situation unfair not only to me but to Col. Radice himself and, particularly, to Toscana Region, which will one day, deprived suddenly of this officer, be forced to start "from scratch" with a new, inexperienced provincial commissioner.

8. For the reasons stated, I request that Lt. Col. Radice be relieved of his present primary responsibility in Florence Province, and suggest that he be replaced by the officer of Toscana Region who is destined to be provincial commissioner under the regional administration.

1. With reference to Liguria Region's Lia/Hear(32) of 27 FEB 45 (copy enclosed for reference), am I to despatch Major Stephens to join Liguria Region irrespective of his work here in the closing down stage?

Major Stephens is the Regional Commerce Officer (Foreign Exports) and is winding up his commitments and dealing with new procedures which are being evolved in connection with foreign exports. Owing to the arrival of shipping in the near future he does not anticipate being clear of commitments until the latter part of the month. He is telephoning to Commerce Sub-Commission to this effect.

Moreover, in this particular case the move entails closing down a branch Headquarters and instructions received from you are that no action is to be taken until receipt of your directive determining withdrawal of Officers from this Region.

Unless other instructions are issued, Major Stephens will be released as soon as possible after your directive is received.

2. I find it difficult to understand the procedure under which personnel of this Headquarters is placed at 45 hours call from Regional Commissioners without any provisos and irrespective of directives awaited from your Headquarters regarding the withdrawal of Allied Commission personnel from this Island.

In this connection all the British ORs, including my driver,

I find it difficult to understand the procedure under which personnel of this Headquarters is placed at 48 hours call from Regional Commissioners without any provisos and irrespective of directives awaited from your Headquarters regarding the withdrawal of Allied Commission personnel from this island.

In this connection all the British ORs, including my driver, have been put on 48 hours call for the Regional Commissioner Venesia Region (your C-1 (E)/513/1/QR of 22 FEB refers). I trust it will be agreed that it would be impossible for all these ORs to be sent away at this juncture at one and the same time when action as regards withdrawal has so far only been confined to planning and when orders to effect ^{only} ~~1563~~ withdrawal by 1 APR are awaited from your Headquarters.

TO: S.C.A.O., Fifth Army AMG.

1. The Smilia Region copy of your signal 729, 20 January 1945, has been received.
2. It is apparently responsive to a request from Headquarters Allied Commission for certain AMG Fifth Army personnel for use in the south and reads in part as follows: "In place of Captains Lee, Bennett and Jefferson and Lt. Thomson, propose to send Major C.J. Carillio, Major L.C. Dewing, Lt. L.E. Moore and Capt. J.Y. Elliott. These last four are at present not actively engaged and their services can more easily be dispensed with for next two months. As these four are assigned Smilia Region suggest clearance with Regional Commissioner." (underlining ours)
3. The implications of this language necessitate a reminder and restatement of the relation of these officers and other Region Smilia personnel, to AMG Fifth Army, and the essential limitations of this relationship.
4. Shortly after the re-formation of Smilia Region, in accordance with Allied Commission policy and precedent, four Region Smilia provincial teams were sent forward on loan to AMG Fifth Army, to augment its strength and for its use as provincial teams until such time as tactical developments should per it their being sent forward to previously determined locations in the respective provinces of the Region, to which these officers were assigned. Due to a subsequent shift of Army boundaries, the number of provincial teams so loaned was later increased to five.
5. The clear and unambiguous understanding and directive with regard to such teams was that they should be used as teams and that if and when their services were no longer required by AMG Fifth Army they should be returned as teams to the Region for use elsewhere.
6. On numerous occasions in the ensuing months, AMG Fifth Army has proceeded in disregard of this basic understanding and directive in several respects, taking action and assuming administrative and disciplinary jurisdiction not justified by the terms of reference. Among other things, it has:

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a. Operationally, disregarded the unity of provincial teams, and used officers when and where it saw fit, without regard to the maintenance of the integrity of teams;

b. Granted leaves to officers without reference to, or consultation with the Region, with the result that officers could not be reached by Region headquarters for administrative purposes;

c. Taken action toward the promotion of officers without consultation with the Region;

d. In its orders used the word "assigned" in allocating officers to places of duty, overlooking and ignoring the fact that it has no assignment jurisdiction over them; and,

e. Sub-loaned Manila Regional officers to other Regions without reference to, or consultation with, this Region.

7. The matter referred to in point a was mentioned to the Regional Commissioner (as a fait accompli) and stated to be operationally necessary. On that basis it was agreed to, upon condition that officers be kept in sufficiently close contact with their respective Provincial Commissioners for the efficient and effective exercise of administrative and disciplinary jurisdiction. Other enumerated items of departure from the basic agreement have upon occasion been noted and protested, and AMG Fifth Army has agreed to desist from the protested practices. Still other points have been waived or overlooked. Manila Region recognizes that at the present juncture its prime function is to assist the Armlies and there has been no inclination to split hairs, or to make mountains out of molehills.

8. The fact remains that the officers of this Region have been, and continue to be loaned to AMG for its use while it needs them and for no other purpose. When officers are not needed they should be returned to their provincial commissioners who have been properly instructed to communicate that fact to regional headquarters so that effective use may be made of the affected officers elsewhere. They are not AMG Fifth Army's for the purpose of loan to other Regions, release to Allied Commission, or for any purpose other than its own operational use until needed by the Region.

9. Under these conditions the use in the quoted signal of the phrases "propose to send"; "at present not actively engaged"; "services can . . . be dispensed with for next two months" constitute a quite intolerable assumption of dominion and jurisdiction over

the officers in question. Region Emilia had no notice whatever that these officers were surplus to your requirements, and on the very day the quoted signal was transmitted the Regional Commissioner was at Headquarters A.C. seeking additional officers for urgent operational use in Emilia Region.

10. A request which has heretofore frequently been made orally and informally is now repeated in formal and written form. Whenever, in the course of your operations, any officers of this Region are no longer required by you will you please direct them at once to report to their respective provincial commanders, notifying Regional Headquarters of such instructions and of the manner of performance of the officers affected, during their time of service with you.

11. Your failure to do this promptly, consistently, and in good faith, in accordance with the basic plan, will otherwise necessarily have to be made the subject of an application to Headquarters Allied Commission for modification of the existing scheme so as to insure to the Region the degree of control and organizational integrity necessary for effective administration.

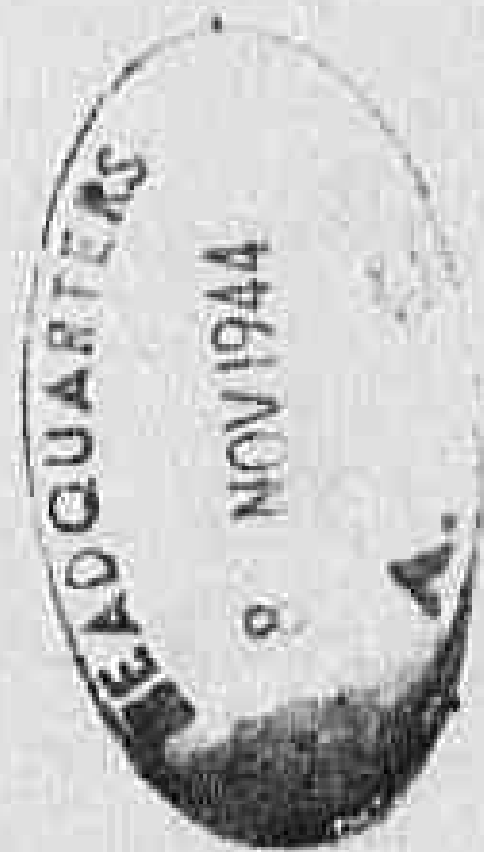

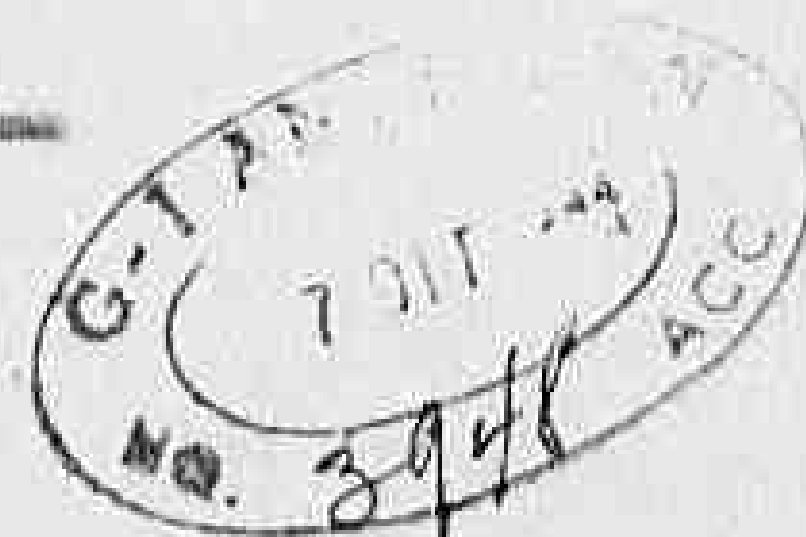
